Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things to you! The consoling words of Jesus in this Sunday's gospel are often heard during funeral Masses because they speak so gently and powerfully to troubled hearts and promise the faithful Christian a divinely built dwelling in the life to come. While this is the traditional interpretation of the passage, some scholars who have delved deeper into the Gospel of John suggest that the imagery Jesus uses here is much more intimate. Jesus is speaking not as a divine architect or carpenter on our behalf but as the Bridegroom who is preparing a dwelling for his spouse, the church.

We're told in the gospels that St. Joseph did the same for the Mother of God. When Mary was betrothed to Joseph, the couple was already married in Jewish tradition. However, the husband had up to a year to provide a suitable dwelling for his bride. Jesus is most likely speaking of the same reality here. Not only does Jesus provide a future dwelling for his faithful disciples, but he desires the same intimacy with our souls as a bridegroom with his bride. Throughout the Gospel of John, Jesus longs for this life of intimacy to begin even now as we come to know him in prayer, in listening to his word, in receiving his very self in the Eucharist, and in living his compassion and mercy in our service to others. Jesus has called the church to be his bride. Don't settle for less.

BIULETYN Parafialny

W wywiadzie książkowym dziennikarza Petera Seewalda z Benedyktem XVI pod tytułem „Światłość świata” (2011), autor snuje taką refleksję na temat emerytowanego wtedy papieża: „A gdy się go słucha i siedzi obok niego, czuje się nie tylko precyzję jego myślenia i nadzieję, która pochodzi z wiary, ale też w specyficzny sposób dostrzega się widzialny blask, światłości świata, oblicza Jezusa Chrystusa, który chce spotkać każdego człowieka i nie wyklucza nikogo”.



Św. Piotr w drugim czytaniu przypomina nam: „Wy zaś jesteście wybranym plemieniem, królewskim kapłaństwem, narodem świętym, ludem Bogu na własność przeznaczonym, abyście głosili dzieła potęgi Tego, który was wezwał z ciemności do swojego przedziwnego światła” (1 P 2,9). Tak więc chrześcijanin podąża z ciemności grzechu i śmierci do światła Chrystusa; w kierunku Tego, który jest „drogą, prawdą i życiem”. Światło poranka wielkanocnego jest pięknym symbolem tego zwycięstwa.

Takim światłem na drogach naszego życia jest wiara. Dlatego, jak zauważa papież Franciszek, „pilne staje się odzyskanie światła (...), bo kiedy gaśnie jej płomień, wszystkie inne światła tracą w końcu swój blask. Światło wiary ma bowiem szczególny charakter, ponieważ jest zdolne oświecić całe życie człowieka. Żeby zaś światło było tak potężne (...) musi ostatecznie pochodzić od Boga” (Lumen fidei 4). Na czym polega rola wiary? Papież wyjaśnia, że „wiara nie jest światłem rozpraszającym wszystkie nasze ciemności, ale lampą, która w nocy prowadzi nasze kroki, a to wystarcza, by iść. Cierpiącemu człowiekowi Bóg nie daje wyjaśniającej wszystko argumentacji, ale swoją odpowiedź ofiaruje w formie obecności, która towarzyszy historii dobra, łączącej się z każdą historią cierpienia, by rozjaśnić ją promień światła. W Chrystusie Bóg zechciał podzielić z nami tę drogę i ofiarować nam swoje spojrzenie, byśmy zobaczyli na niej światło” (LF 57).

Jezus, który poniósł śmierć na krzyżu i zmartwychwstał, jest kamieniem węgielnym pod budowę nowej świątyni, jaką jest lud Boży. Dla niewierzących jest natomiast kamieniem, o który się potkną. „Na Nim cały Kościół się wspiera i z Niego czerpie swą moc, aby opierać się różnym przeciwnościom i dziejowym burzom” (ks. Stanisław Hałas). Tak więc ochrzczeni, czyli ludzie z ciemności do światła, są powołani do składania duchowych ofiar ze swojego codziennego życia. Mają też wprowadzać Chrystusa w każde środowisko, a więc uświęcać świat, w którym żyją. I to jest szczególne zadanie ludzi świeckich. To właśnie świeccy – jak ktoś powiedział – „odprawiają Mszę św. w świetle wtedy, kiedy pozwalają Chrystusowi w sobie i przez siebie działać w każdej rzeczywistości stworzonej, we wszystkim, czego dotyczą, poczynając od tych najprostszych spraw, jak jedzenie i picie”. Kapłańskie posłannictwo ludzi świeckich, wynikające z chrztu, polega na przemienianiu świata na chwałę Bożą, czyli czynieniu z każdej rzeczywistości, która jest świecka, przestrzeni Bożej. Można bowiem jeść i pić na własną zgubę i zgorszenie innych, a można to czynić na chwałę Bożą.
