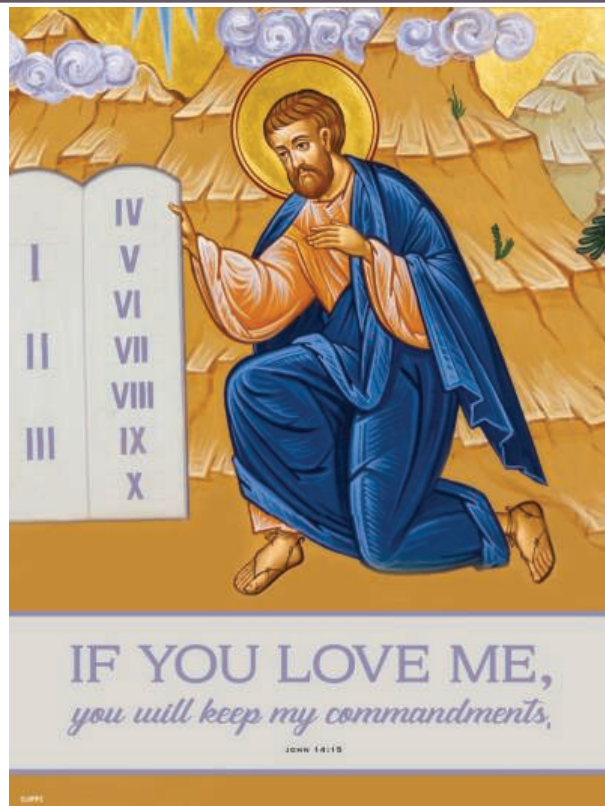

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things! I always find very challenging these words from the Apostle Peter we hear in the second reading this Sunday: "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence...." The first challenge is that Peter presumes we're a people of hope because of the Easter promise we've been celebrating these weeks. Do we radiate that hope in our daily lives? Hope is sometimes confused with optimism, the attitude that everything will always turn out well. We know that things don't always turn out well, at least in the short term. Hope, however, is a virtue rooted in the fact that suffering and even death never have the last word in our lives. Are we a people of hope?

The second challenge comes in the call to be evangelizers, people who spread the Good News with gentleness and reverence. In a polarized world where we hear voices raised in anger and protest over anything and everything, being people of conviction and faith who are both gentle and reverent is really something countercultural. St. Peter warns that we could suffer the same fate as our Lord. The Lord, however, promises that we can be secure in the divine life that dwells in us—a life which no one can take away.

BIULETYN Parafialny



W czasie obrzędu bierzmowania biskup, kreśląc na czole kandydata znak krzyża olejem krzyżma, wraz z imieniem wypowiada następujące słowa: „przyjmij znamię Daru Ducha Świętego”. Przyjmujący sakrament odpowiada: „Amen”, czyli „niech się tak stanie”. Przez sakrament bierzmowania Duch Święty daje wierzącym moc, aby mogli „wiarę swoją wyznawać, bronić jej i według niej żyć”. Przychodzący Duch obdarza nas siedmioma swoimi darami, którymi są: mądrość, rozum, rada, męstwo, umiejętność, pobożność i bojaźń Boża. „Chrystus, Syn Dawida, posiada je w całej pełni” (KKK 1831). My również je otrzymaliśmy. Są one „trwałymi dyspozycjami, które czynią człowieka uległym, by siedł za poruszeniami Ducha Świętego” (KKK 1830). Dary te stają się również dla nas zadaniem, które mamy z radością wypełniać każdego dnia.

Sytuacja przekazania Ducha Świętego w sakramencie bierzmowania przypomina wydarzenie, które znajdujemy w dzisiejszym pierwszym czytaniu. „Kiedy Apostołowie w Jerozolimie dowiedzieli się, że Samaria przyjęła słowo Boże, wysłali do niej Piotra i Jana, którzy przy-szli i modlili się za nich, aby mogli otrzymać Ducha Świętego. Bo na żadnego z nich jeszcze nie zstąpił. Byli jedynie ochrzczeni

w imię Pana Jezusa. Wtedy więc nakładali apostołowie na nich ręce, a oni otrzymywali Ducha Świętego”.

Podobnie dzięki namaszczeniu przez Ducha Świętego Jezus stał się Chrystusem. I każdy z nas przez chrzest, a zwłaszcza przez bierzmowanie uczestniczy w życiu Chrystusa dzięki Jego łasce, upodabnia się do Chrystusa. Każdy z nas, zwłaszcza gdy systematycznie uczestniczy w Eucharystii, pozwala, by życie Jezusa Chrystusa zakorzeniło się w nim coraz głębiej.

Miłość zobowiązuje do wzajemności. Jednak w życiu bywa bardzo różnie. Papież Benedykt XVI w zwraca uwagę na następujący problem: „Zdarza się, że po przyjęciu bierzmowania wielu młodych ludzi oddala się od wiary. Są też i tacy, którzy nawet nie przyjmują tego sakramentu. A przecież właśnie przez sakramenty chrztu i bierzmowania, a następnie nieprzerwanie przez Eucharystię Duch Święty czyni nas dziećmi Ojca, braćmi Jezusa, członkami Jego Kościoła, zdolnymi dawać prawdziwe świadectwo o Ewangelii i zaznawać radości, jaka płynie z wiary” (Orędziu na XXIII Światowe Dni Młodzieży).

Warto dziś zapytać siebie: Czy w środowisku, w którym żyję, jestem człowiekiem zdominowanym instynktami i emocjami, który chce więcej mieć, posiadać zamiast bardziej przemieniać siebie w ducha miłości? Czy dbam o duchową głębię, czas na modlitwę i wrażliwość na piękno serca? Czy szukam ciszy i skupienia, by wśród wielu głosów usłyszeć głos Boga i słowa, których potrzebuję?



HISTORIA DNIA MATKI - Początki tego święta sięgają już czasów starożytnego Egiptu, wtedy czczono boginię Izydę, którą uważano za idealną matkę i żonę. Inne początki święta sięgają czasów starożytnych Greków i Rzymian. Kultem otaczano wtedy matki - boginie, symbole płodności i urodzaju. Grecy składali ofiary bogini Rei, a Rzymianie bogini Cybele, a uroczystości nazywali Świętem Radości. Dzień Matki w Polsce pierwszy raz był obchodzony w 1914 roku w Krakowie.

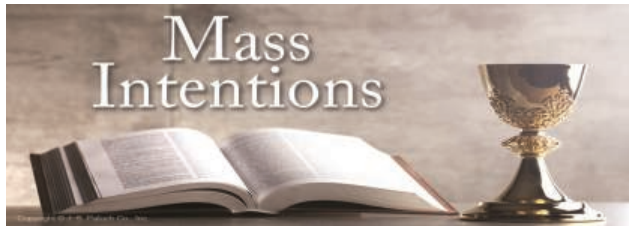

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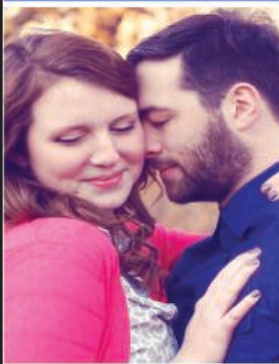
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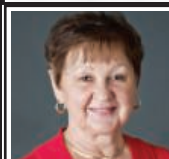
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
