BIULETYN Parafialny



Znane w całym świecie i zatwierdzone przez Kościół w 1930 roku objawienia fatimskie rozpoczęły się adoracją Trójcy Świętej, której Anioł nauczył pastuszków: „Trójco Przenajświętsza, Ojcie, Synu i Duchu Święty. W najgłębszej pokorze cześć Ci oddaję, ofiaruję Tobie Przenajdroższe Ciało i Krew, Duszę i Bóstwo Pana naszego, Jezusa Chrystusa, obecnego na ołtarzach całego świata, jako wynagrodzenie za zniewagi, świętokradztwa i obojętność, którymi jest On obrażany. Przez nieskończone zasługi Jego Najświętszego Serca i przez przyczynę Niepokalanego Serca Maryi, proszę Cię o łaskę nawrócenia biednych grzeszników”.

Anioł w Fatimie widzi Trójcę Przenajświętszą w Eucharystii. Kieruje się ku Trójcy Przenajświętszej, kiedy kieruje się ku Eucharystii. Anioł wie, że tylko Syn Boży ma ciało, krew i dusze ludzką. Wie, że ani Ojciec, ani Duch Święty nie stali się ludźmi, ale wie, że Jezus jest nieoddzielny od Ojca i Ducha Świętego. Naucza człowieka, jak wielbić Trójcę Przenajświętszą adorując Eucharystię.

Dzięki modlitwom Anioła objawienia fatimskie wskazują nam Boga, który jest Ojcem, Synem i Duchem Świętym. Boga, który jest wspólnotą miłości. Miłość to klucz do zrozumienia orędzia przekazanego w Fatimie: miłość, która przebacza i która wzywa do nawrócenia, miłość uczyniona z miłosierdzia. Podczas wizji w Tuy siostra Łucja zrozumiała, że została jej przekazana „tajemnica Trójcy Przenajświętszej i [otrzymała] natchnienie na temat tej tajemnicy, której [jej] jednak nie wolno wyjawiać”. Trójca Święta to najważniejsze z fatimskich słów. Orędzie fatimskie pokazuje tajemnicę Boga kochającego człowieka i tajemnicę człowieka uwikłanego w dramat samotności.

Pozostajemy świadomi, że nasze mówienie o Trójcy Przenajświętszej jest w gruncie rzeczy dramatycznym „jękaniem się”, jak stwierdził św. Grzegorz Wielki. Ale bez niego w świecie brakowałoby czegoś ważnego. Trójcę Świętą wielbimy, gdy z wiarą czynimy znak krzyża, rozpoczynając czy kończąc modlitwę. Uwielbiamy Ją, gdy wychodząc z Eucharystii, stajemy się świadkami miłości Boga, która w nas jest; kiedy łączymy, a nie dzielimy; kiedy przebaczamy, zasiewamy miłość, a nie ziejemy nienawiścią czy stajemy się pokazowo pobożni.

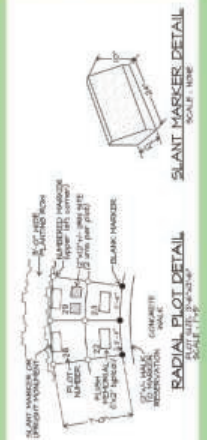

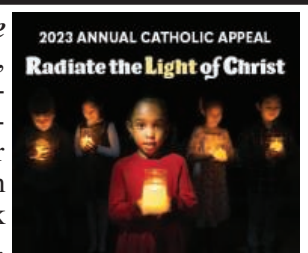

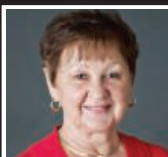
