

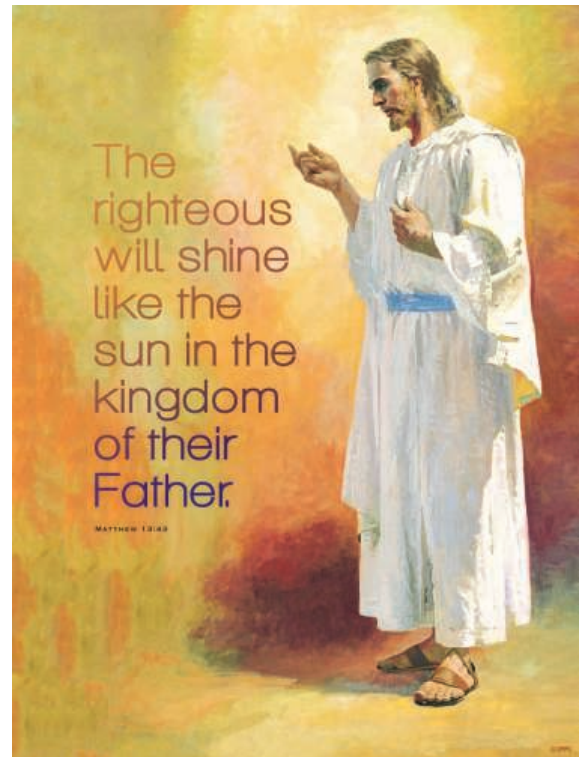

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! We all have our moments of frustration with our world, whether that be the wider culture or the more limited environment over which we have more influence. As a friar-priest I often hear questions that start like this: "Why doesn't God do something about...?" You can fill in the blank with any number of discouraging statistics, incurable diseases, or public figures.

We can readily imagine the surprise and even dismay of Jesus' first disciples when they learned about letting weeds and wheat grow together until a future harvest time decided by God and God alone. Biblical scholars often point out that in the first century A.D., it was sometimes hard for farmers to tell the good crops from the ones to be pulled up and burned. True. The parable, however, conveys something simpler: judgment belongs to God alone. You and I are called to entrust ourselves to the patience and compassion of God who allows this earth to be a mixture of sin and grace until the new heavens and new earth are born in their fullness as the sheer gift of God's goodness.

We know that at least one or two of Jesus' apostles probably had revolutionary leanings. They did not want to hear anything about the kingdom of God working slowly like yeast or sprouting mustard seeds. They would have preferred a quick overthrow of the Roman Empire. Patience, patience, and more patience.

If we are honest with ourselves, the weeds and wheat are inside us. It does little good to make new rules that invite new loopholes or change structures still operated by unconverted human hearts. When we do embrace our need for daily conversion, change often comes as slowly and imperceptibly as watching grass grow or letting yeast do its thing. Let us pray this weekend that we yield to the power of God's grace and allow it flourish in His time, not our own.

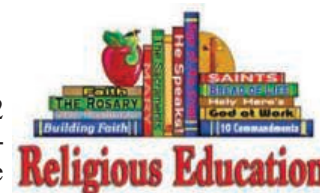

BIULETYN Parafialny



Świat domaga się od chrześcijan aktywności. Mówi o konieczności prowadzenia różnego rodzaju dzieł miłosierdzia, o przedszkolach i szkołach, o domach pomocy społecznej. Wiele takich form aktywności można by wymieniać. Stąd rodzi się często stwierdzenie, że chrześcijanie tracą czas na modlitwę, tracą pieniądze na kościoły i ich wystrój, tracą siły na liturgię i adorację. Złośliwi twierdzą, że modlitwa jest marnotrawstwem energii i czasu. A wiara przecież bez modlitwy usycha i staje się martwa, jak kwiat bez wody. Chrześcijanin, wbrew przekonaniom panującym we współczesnym świecie, ma być przede wszystkim człowiekiem głębokiej modlitwy. Z tego dopiero wypływa gotowość do działania i aktywności.

Dzisiejsza liturgia, zwłaszcza drugie czytanie, zachęca nas na nowo do tego, abyśmy uczyli się żyć modlitwą; byśmy stawali się świątynią Ducha Świętego, w której nieustannie rozbrzmiewa modlitwa. Św. Paweł doskonale zdaje sobie sprawę, że modlitwa nie jest dziełem prostym ani łatwym. Ale wtedy [] sam Duch przyczynia się za nami w błaganiach, których nie można wyrazić słowami (Rz 8,26). A zatem, nie musimy obawiać się niedoskonałości naszych modlitw, gdyż Duch Boży, który mieszka w naszych sercach, sam wstawia się za nami. On uświęca trud naszej modlitwy i włącza ją w odwieczną modlitwę Syna Bożego.

Jeden z Ojców Pustyni wyznaje: [] wydaje mi się nic nie wymaga takiego wysiłku jak modlitwa. Ilekroć bowiem człowiek chce się modlić, zawsze nieprzyjazne duchy starają się powstrzymać go od tego, wiedząc, że nic im bardziej nie stoi na przeszkodzie jak modlitwa płynąca do Boga. Każdy inny trud bowiem, który podejmuje człowiek o religijnym sposobie życia, choćby znoszony był długo i wytrwale, zakończony jest jakimś wytchnieniem. Modlitwa natomiast ma to do siebie, że wymaga wielkiego wysiłku i walki aż do ostatniego tchnienia (Apoftegmaty).

SAKRAMENT NAMASZCZENIA CHORYCH – Począwszy od dzisiejszej niedzieli i w każdą czwartą niedzielę miesiąca będziemy udzielać Sakramentu Chorych po każdej niedzielnej Mszy św. (włącznie z sobotnią Mszą wigilijną). Namaszczenie nastąpi po zakończeniu hymnu Mszy św. Kapłan pozostanie w sanktuarium i zaprosi tych, którzy potrzebują sakramentu, aby podeszli do pierwszych ławek na nałożenie rąk, modlitwę i namaszczenie świętym olejem.

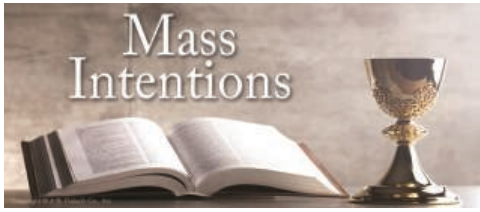

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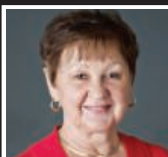
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
