

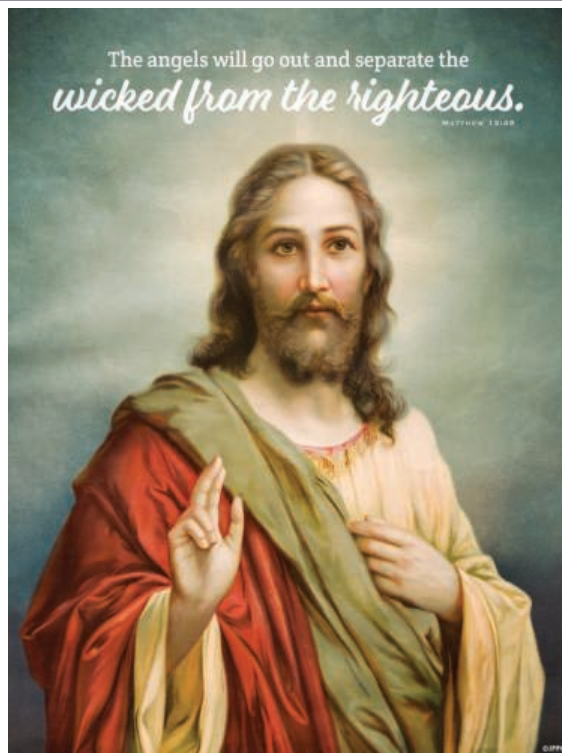

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! Judging from the energy, excitement, and tears during the Steubenville East Conference last weekend in downtown Springfield, especially during the procession with the Blessed Sacrament, one would never think that youth are more and more absent from churches. Record numbers are expected to attend World Youth Day in Lisbon this week. The search for God is definitely happening among young people.

Statistics alone, however, can be discouraging. According to a CARA study (Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate), already several years old, young Catholics can start abandoning their faith by the age of 10 (23%). Two-thirds do not identify themselves as Catholic by the age of 17. The reasons for this are legion: a Western culture based on pleasure and profit; the end of Christendom and erosion of basic morality; social media and the digital age as replacements for prayer and connection with God (and with each other); woke ideologies hostile to religion in general and Christianity in particular; the disintegration of the family—to name a few. What to do?

In an age of rampant individualism and personal tastes—think of how many varieties of just one product there are in a grocery store—there is no magic bullet. Some youth seek validation of their lifestyles with little cost to themselves while others would pack a church to attend the 1962 Mass in Latin. Reaching out, inviting, maintaining communication, practicing genuine listening—these are all good starts. Perhaps the best evangelization is a joyful, fulfilled Christian life. Youth seek authenticity and evidence of a genuine relationship with Jesus Christ. The more we build one another up, grow in our faith, and allow Jesus to bring the grace of conversion into every aspect of our lives, the more we attract others who will want what we have. This is the treasure and the pearl of great price that cause others to fall into the net of the kingdom of heaven.

Wielkie było zdziwienie św. Edyty Stein, kiedy pewnego dnia, zatrzymała się na chwilę w pustym kościele i stała się przypadkowym świadkiem rozmowy prostej kobiety z Bogiem. Ten dialog bliskich sobie osób bardzo poruszył Edytę, która nie wiedziała, że można w ten sposób przeżywać bliskość Boga. To zdarzenie wywarło wielki wpływ na jej ostateczną decyzję o przyjęciu chrztu w Kościele katolickim. Ani bowiem wiedza filozoficzna, ani mądrość traktatów teologicznych nie stały się dla Edyty miejscem dla tak osobistego doznania Bożej obecności. To była chwila łaski.



Królestwo Boże jest najwyższą wartością, której zdobyciu trzeba podporządkować wszystkie inne wartości. Pokazuje to przykład Edyty Stein i wielu ludzi, których ślady stóp przetrwały. Ewangelia nie pozostawia żadnych wątpliwości i decyzja jest jasna: liczne są skarby, ale jest jeden Skarb, istnieje wiele pięknych pereł, ale jest tylko jedna Perła. I tylko dla tego Skarbu oraz tej Perły warto i trzeba sprzedać wszystko, jak zrobili to ludzie z Ewangelii. Jest to konsekwencja tego, iż ☐Bóg nie może dawać siebie po kawałku, tylko wszystko naraz albo nic☐ (Mistrz Ekhart, Kazanie 77). I jedyny możliwy typ transakcji z Panem Bogiem to ☐wszystko za wszystko☐.

Jeśli mielibyśmy tę przypowieść zastosować do naszej wakacyjnej sytuacji, to sądzę, że Chrystus apeluje do każdego z nas, aby raz jeszcze oddać Mu wszystko. Przybyliśmy tu z różnymi doświadczeniami życia, pełni wdzięczności, świętujący niedzielę, zadowoleni z rodzinnych spotkań, wyjazdów poza miasto. Ale może przyszliśmy też utrudnieni i obciążeni codziennością, obawami zamachów terrorystycznych, ciągłych niepokojów związanych choćby z mizernym wynagrodzeniem za ciężką pracę. Przyszliśmy z całym ogromnym bagażem naszych wielorakich doświadczeń, sukcesów, niekiedy zranień, z planami i nadziejami. Wszystko to trzeba oddać Chrystusowi. Oddać wszystko, aby móc na nowo zachwycić się Chrystusem – Niewypowiedzianą Perłą, jak nazywa Go starożytna tradycja.

ŚWIĘTO MATKI BOŻEJ ANIELSKIEJ - 2 sierpnia w kościołach franciszkańskich obchodzone jest patronalne święto Matki Bożej Anielskiej Porcjunkuli. Porcjunkula z łacińskiego oznacza małą częsteczkę, skrawek gruntu. Nazwa odnosi się do kapliczki pod wezwaniem Matki Bożej Anielskiej, będącej dzisiaj najmniejszym sanktuarium świata, którą Św. Franciszek w XIII wieku otrzymał w darze od benedyktynów i odbudował własnymi rękami. Św. Franciszek z Asyżu gorąco prosił Pana Boga o łaskę zbawienia wszystkich ludzi. Jak głosi legenda, pewnej nocy objawili mu się Jezus i Maryja w otoczeniu aniołów, dając obietnicę, że kto z wiernych chrześcijan nawiedzi kapliczkę Porcjunkuli pw Matki Bożej Anielskiej od zachodu słońca 1 sierpnia do zachodu słońca 2 sierpnia - Uroczystość Matki Bożej Anielskiej, ten dostąpi łaski odpustu zupełnego, to jest odpuszczenia win za wszystkie swoje grzechy, pod warunkiem, że wcześniej szczerze się z nich wyświadczy, otrzymując ważne sakramentalne rozgrzeszenie. Ponieważ trudno było wiernym z odległych stron świata dotrzeć do kapliczki, Kościół zatwierdził, że Odpustu Porcjunkuli mogą dostąpić wszyscy, którzy we wskazanym czasie nawiedzą dowolny kościół franciszkański, przy którym pełnią posługę duchową zakonnicy franciszkańscy. Papież Paweł VI rozciągnął przywilej uzyskania odpustu zupełnego na cały Kościół. Skorzystajmy z tej niezgłębionej ☐skarbnicy Bożego Miłosierdzia☐, by uzyskać za przyczyną Matki Bożej Anielskiej i Św. Franciszka odpust zupełny, czyli darowanie kary doczesnej za popełnione grzechy.

By uzyskać wspomniany odpust, należy jednak spełnić następujące warunki, a więc:

- pobożnie nawiedzić kościół,
- odmówić w nim Modlitwę Pańską oraz Wyznanie Wiary,
- przystąpić do spowiedzi świętej,
- przyjąć Komunię świętą,
- pomodlić się w intencji Ojca Świętego

Francis's request was somewhat radical because such plenary indulgences were attached to acts like pilgrimages or volunteering for the Crusades. Although limited to include from noon on August 1st to midnight on August 2nd, the indulgence continues to be granted to this day, not only to those who visit the Portiuncula in Assisi, but to anyone who visits any church where Franciscan Friars live and minister. To receive this indulgence (for yourself or for someone else – living or deceased), in addition to the church visit, one must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within several days of August 2nd, go to Mass and receive the Eucharist, recite the Our Father and Apostles Creed, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

August 2nd is also the patronal feast of the Province of Our Lady of the Angels, the geographical region/jurisdiction—stretching from Ontario to Florida--of the friars who serve you here at St. Stanislaus. Please ask Our Lady of the Angels to intercede for all those considering a vocation to the Franciscan life. Our Lady of the Angels, pray for us! Happy Feast!

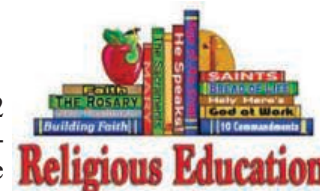

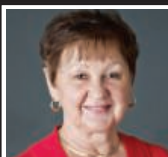
