

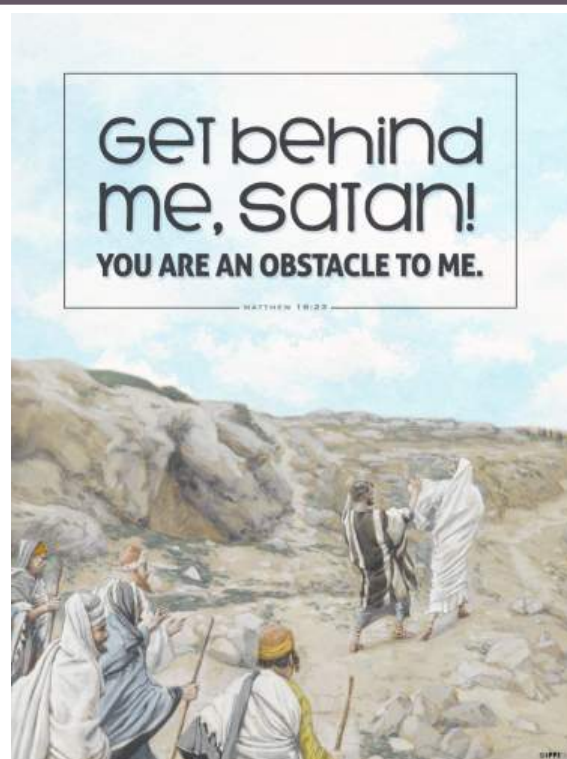

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! Labor Day weekend is the traditional end of summer for our country. If students have not returned to school already, they certainly will this week. Longer family vacations are generally over. Back to work....

Just like the origins of many national holidays, Labor Day was born from struggle, and specifically, the demands of workers for better wages and working conditions. Historians disagree over which person or persons were responsible for Labor Day, but the first Labor Day parade took place in New York City on September 5, 1882. Individual states celebrated days dedicated to workers in this early period, but it was not until June 28, 1894, that President Grover Cleveland made Labor Day a federal holiday.

Even though we might prefer to think about the menu for the barbecue, this holiday also provides an opportunity to reflect on the nature of work and its place in our lives as Catholic Christians. Our Catholic tradition has a rich body of teaching on the nature of work and the demands of justice that arise from it. (See, for example, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, nos. 2426-36.) As computers and self-service replace people and human interaction, the question of work and its dignity is even more critical for us. Ideally, work is viewed as a share in the creative activity of God and should build us up rather than break us down. If you are already retired, for what aspects of your work are you grateful? If you are still working, how does your work contribute to the human family and the created order of which God has made us stewards?

BIULETYN Parafialny



"Uwiodłeś mnie, Panie, a ja pozwoliłem się uwieść; ujarzmiłeś mnie i przemogłeś. (...) I powiedziałem sobie: Nie będę Go już wspominał ani mówił w Jego imię! Ale wtedy zaczął trawić moje serce jakby ogień, nurtujący w moim ciele. Czyniłem wysiłki, by go stłumić, lecz nie potrafiłem".

Chcemy spojrzeć dziś na próbę wiary na przykładzie proroka Jeremiasza, człowieka niezwyklej inteligencji i wrażliwości. Przeżywał chwile rozpaczy, zwątpienia, czuł się opuszczony przez Boga, od którego spodziewał się skutecznej pomocy. Bóg swoim autorytetem nakłonił Jeremiasza do podjęcia się misji prorockiej. Prorok otwarł swą duszę przed Bogiem i przedstawił Mu liczne trudności związane ze swą prorocką posługą. Bezpośrednim powodem Jego przygnębienia i pretensji do Boga była postawa słuchaczy, którzy okazywali dezaprobatę, a także pogardę wobec Jego przepowiadania. Jego nawoływania do wierności Bogu nie odnosiły skutku.

Ileż to prób przeżywamy w naszym życiu duchowym, nieraz wydaje się, że Bóg doświadcza nas ponad siły. Czy jednak tak rzeczywiście się dzieje? Wiara wymaga nie tylko wiedzy, ale i prób, by mogła zostać oczyszczona z tego, co niedoskonałe, słabe. Wiara jest drogą, na której spotykamy nie tylko wiele dobra, możliwości rozwoju, ale też wiele zła, ludzkiej krzywdy i bezradności. Żeby zrozumieć nasze doświadczenia, dramaty, krytyczne sytuacje czy okresy życia warto sięgać po Pismo Święte – Księgę słowa samego Boga.

Ważnym krokiem jest uświadomienie sobie przez człowieka, który przeżywa problem z wiarą, że wiara jest decyzją. A więc nie zależy od tego, co przeżywam w dłuższym lub krótszym czasie, tylko od tego, do czego jestem przekonany. Ta decyzja opiera się na poznaniu Boga i na świadectwie innych ludzi. Poznać Boga można, czytając Pismo Święte, i słuchając ludzi, którzy głoszą słowo Boże. Dodam jeszcze, że poszukiwanie prawdy polega na szukaniu osoby czy wspólnoty, której świadectwo wiary jest wiarygodne i przedstawianiu jej własnych wątpliwości. Inną możliwością jest szukanie odpowiedzi na wątpliwości w książkach.

Poznanie Boga wymaga wysiłku. Człowiek, którego wiara słabnie, przeżywa kryzys, powinien bardzo mocno modlić się o dar wiary. Zatem recepta na kryzys wiary sprowadza się do tego, aby: nie wpadać w panikę, postępować w zgodzie z sumieniem, szukać prawdy i prosić o dar wiary.

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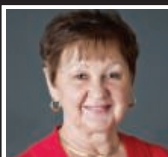
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
