

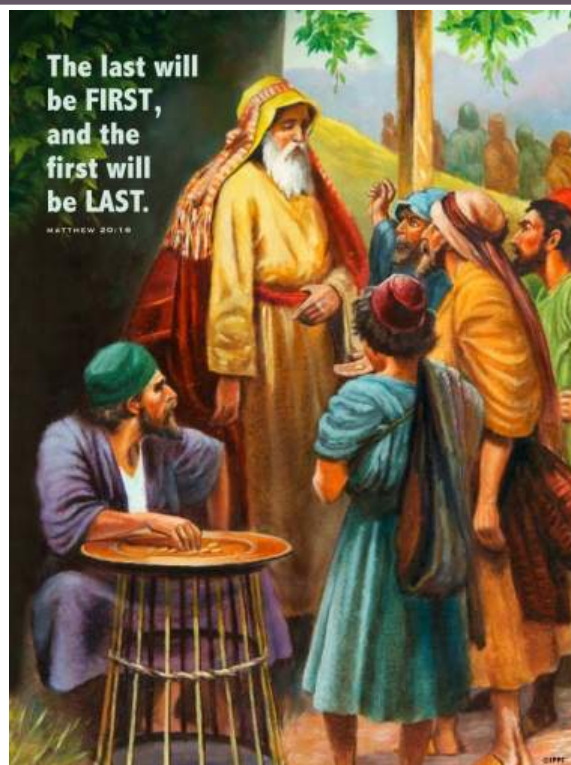

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! There is a story told about St. Teresa of Avila (feast day: October 15th), the great sixteenth-century reformer of the Carmelites, that goes something like this. St. Teresa was traveling from one monastery to another in a violent rainstorm. At one point she slipped and fell right into the mud. Her prayer went thus: "If this is how you treat your friends, Lord, it's no wonder you have so few."

That bit of saintly humor came to mind as I was considering this Sunday's gospel and Jesus' parable. We may be inclined to tell God that His ways are unfair. The parable violates our sense of justice. The wealthy landowner pays a full day's wages not only to those who did a full day's work but also to those who labored only one hour. Even the workers in Jesus' parable protest. The story, however, is not about best business practices but about the kingdom of God. Jesus goes in search of the lost sheep of the house of Israel, but Gentiles and those outside the Law who are intent on gospel conversion of life are gaining entrance with the same reward.

Jesus' parable points out that everyone who accepts the call to repentance and enters the kingdom receives the same generous, full measure of gifts from God. The Lord does not treat the human heart according to the criteria of our narrow human judgments but according to His limitless generosity and mercy. Our heavenly Father is infinitely more than just a really nice version of you and me: "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord" (Isaiah 55:8). How do I need to let God be God?

BIULETYN Parafialny

We fragmencie Ewangelii Łukasza, przeznaczonym na dzisiejszą niedzielę, Jezus Chrystus ostrzega nas przed dobrze znanym grzechem zazdrości. Jeden z właścicieli winnicy aż pięciokrotnie wychodzi na rynek, aby nająć robotników do pracy przy winobranii. Chociaż robotnicy ci przystąpili do pracy w różnym czasie, to wieczorem, przy wypłacie wynagrodzenia, otrzymali tyle samo jak ci, którzy pracowali od rana. Spróbujmy wyobrazić sobie radosne twarze ze szczęścia jednych, a smutne od zazdrości twarze drugich. Chodziło tu o zbytnią hojność pana wobec tych, którzy później przystąpili do pracy w winnicy.



Czym zatem jest zazdrość? Z jednej strony jest to smutek z powodzenia bliźniego, a zarazem radość z jego nieszczęścia. Ktoś kupił taniej mieszkanie, inny otrzymał lepszą posadę – komuś udało się wygrać konkurs. A ktoś stojący z boku, taki na pozór niezainteresowany, na to nie może patrzeć, bo go bolą oczy i kłuje serce. Takie obrazki z życia dzieją się każdego dnia, wystarczy tylko trochę rozejrzeć się wokół siebie, by dostrzec złość, wrogość, nienawiść. W kategoriach moralnych jest to jeden z grzechów głównych, ponieważ rodzi inne grzechy. Ale czy ktoś jeszcze o tym pamięta? Czy to, że ktoś się dorobił, komuś się powiodło to coś złego? Dla zazdrośnika – jak najbardziej. I nie do zrozumienia. Zazdrośnik pragnie bowiem zła dla innych, a dla siebie pożąda cudzego dobra. Podłożem zazdrości jest stawianie siebie w centrum, niezdolność pragnienia dobra dla innych, niezdolność miłowania. Zazdrość polega więc na pragnieniu wciąż więcej i nieosiąganiu nigdy zadowolenia.

Współczesnych ludzi bardzo pobudza zazdrość i zachęca do niej, przedstawiając chore ambicje jako zdrowe współzawodnictwo. Jak więc odróżnić zdrowe ambicje, pozytywną motywację, pracowitość, od zazdrości? To chyba nie będzie trudne, jeśli dobrze znamy siebie. Jeśli realizujemy swoje pomysły, plany, marzenia, jeśli nasze działania są zgodne z naszym systemem wartości – nie grozi nam chora zazdrość. Po prostu szkoda nam będzie sił i czasu. Ale jeśli nagle zorientujemy się, że motywem naszych działań jest chęć dorównania komuś, pokonania go, zdobycia więcej – mimo że tak naprawdę wcale tego nie potrzebujemy, to już chora zazdrość.

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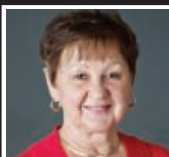
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
