## BIULETYN Parafialny

Rafał Blechacz to jeden z najlepszych pianistów świata. Od wygrania w 2005 r. Międzynarodowego Konkursu Pianistycznego im. F. Chopina jego kariera artystyczna stała się pasmem wyjątkowych sukcesów. Występuje w najsłynniejszych i najbardziej prestiżowych salach koncertowych, jest zapraszany na najlepsze festiwale muzyczne. Jego koncerty bardzo często kończą się owacją na stojąco. A po nich ustawiają się gigantyczne kolejki miłośników muzyki, którzy czekają nawet dwie godziny, aby zdobyć jego autograf. W 2014 r. otrzymał nagrodę Gilmore, uznawaną za pianistycznego Nobla. Ma 32 lata i jest jednym z najbardziej rozpoznawalnych polskich artystów na świecie. Słynie z pracowitości i wykorzystywania czasu do maksimum. Zapytany, ile czasu poświęca na ćwiczenie gry na fortepianie, odpowiada, że każdego dnia średnio około 6 godzin. Artysta ma głęboką świadomość, że Pan Bóg jest najważniejszą płaszczyzną jego życia.



Tylko trwanie w łączności z Jezusem daje obfite owoce pomnażania talentów. W czasach Jezusa „talent” był jednostką wagi odpowiadającą mniej więcej trzydziestu kilogramom złota lub srebra. Współcześnie to słowo nabrało innego znaczenia – jest rozumiane jako „wybitne uzdolnienie specjalne do poczynania twórczych lub odtwórczych” (W. Kopaliński, Słownik mitów i tradycji kultury, 1165). Znaney przedmiotu są zgodni, że Jezus nie mówi o talentach tzw. naturalnych, ludzkich, ale o darach szczególnych. Chodzi więc nie o to, co jest specyficzne człowiekowi, ale to, co jest właściwe Jezusowi, a co dotyczy „nowego” człowieka i co możemy nazywać darami Ducha Świętego. Te zaś są po prostu zadaniami powierzonymi człowiekowi. Te dary, ta odpowiedzialność właśnie stanowią o pełni życia, są miarą królestwa Bożego.

Usłyszane Słowo Boże udziela nam lekcji mądrości, pragnąc odpowiedzieć na pytanie: jak mam przeżyć ten czas. Dialog pomiędzy trzecim sługą a panem jest kluczem do odgadnięcia znaczenia całej przypowieści. Sługa ani myśli ponosić jakieś ryzyko, rozwijać jakąś inicjatywę, być aktywnym. Schował bezpiecznie to, co zostało mu powierzone, i czuje się usprawiedliwiony, bo odda tyle, ile otrzymał. Strach przed zdaniem sprawy z otrzymanego daru sparaliżował go, zabił w nim wszelką inicjatywę, fantazję i aktywność. Schował się jak żółw w skorupie i ani myśli się wychylać. Zabrakło mu maksymalizmu dla królestwa.

**CATHOLIC SPIRITUALITY IN DIALOGUE WITH SECULAR CULTURE** - Join us in a discussion with Dr. Carolyn Jacobs about the role of spirituality in an increasingly secular culture, and what role institutions like Elms College can play. Dr. Jacobs spent 35 years on the faculty at the Smith College School for Social Work, and was director of "Contemplative Clinical Practice: An Advanced Certificate Program in Spirituality and Social Work Practice." She is also on the Elms College Board of Trustees. She has written extensively on the topic of spirituality in social work. Her discussion will examine how we, in a sociological sense, can tap into our rich, intellectual tradition and the teachings of Jesus to re-ignite our shared purpose and sense of community and to push back against the age of moral relativism, hyper-consumerism, and the shallowness of the ego-laden alter of "me, myself and I"? The discussion is planned for **Thursday, December 7** at 4:30 p.m. in Alumnae Library Theater, Elms College. This lecture is free and open to the public.



**ADVENT TALK & BOOK SIGNING EVENT** - The Star of Bethlehem: What Did the Magi See? The imagery of the Christmas story traditionally shows a giant star hovering above the stable in Bethlehem guiding the wise men to pay homage to the infant Christ. Do the clues lie in an ancient coin? 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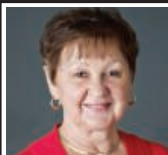
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
