Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This weekend as we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, I thought I would share with you a quotation I received in one of my daily email subscriptions. The words are from the Venerable Servant of God Fulton J. Sheen: "Notice...that only two classes of people found their way to Christ when he came to this earth: the very simple, and the very learned—the shepherds who knew that they knew nothing, and the wise men who knew that they did not know everything; never the man who thought that he knew." How wise these words are!

I do not encounter too many people who think they know everything. However, a similar state of mind is manifested when we come to Mass Sunday after Sunday and even approach the manger with the entrenched notion that nothing in my life will change: physical or spiritual problems, prayer life, family strife, financial challenges, strained relationships, loneliness, problems in the church and society, etc. We can easily slip into the anxiety and melancholy that seem to be ever on the rise. Is not the expectation that nothing will change somewhat similar to thinking that we know everything?

Allow Jesus Christ to surprise you in 2024 with the supernatural gifts and the peace that only he can give. Let the Infant Jesus draw you in as he did the simple shepherds and the humble magi, who returned to their fields and native countries forever changed.

### ☞ BLESSING OF HOMES ☞



The Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, January 7, is a time of the year when we traditionally bless our homes and ask the Lord's blessings on our families for the coming year. If you wish to invite one of our parish priests for a house blessing, please contact the parish office or ask a priest directly. If you choose not to have one of the friars come, we invite you to bless your home with the blessed chalk and incense that will be available after the Masses this weekend. We ask that you follow the ceremony outlined below in blessing the home.

#### Blessing Ceremony

- ☞ A Christmas Carol is sung.
- ☞ Read from the Bible John 1:1-16.
- ☞ The head of the household prays, "The three Wise Men, Kasper, Melchior, and Balthazar, journeyed to Bethlehem to find the Christ Child, and followed the star to God's Son, who became man. May the peace of Christ rest in our home; may our home be a dwelling of the Lord's mercy, love, joy, peace, and forgiveness. May all who enter our home experience Jesus Christ in all that we say and do. We ask this through Christ our Lord."
- ☞ Another member of the family marks the doorpost with the blessed chalk - 20+C+M+B+24 - and then carefully burn the blessed incense.
- ☞ A closing Carol is sung.

**The meaning of the doorpost markings 20+C+M+B+24:** The letters are the initials of the traditional names of the Three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. These letters also abbreviate the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house." And of course, the beginning and ending numbers are the year.

# BIULETYN Parafialny

*Przed Jezusem biją czołem  
– składają ofiary.  
Trzykroć szczęśliwi Królowie  
któż wam nie zazdrości?  
Cóż my damy, któż nam powie...*



Przeżywana uroczystość Trzech Króli ma wybitnie symboliczny charakter: Mały obywatel Betlejem, ubogiej miejsciny judejskiej, narodzony w największej pokorze, staje się darem dla wszystkich: Maryi, Józefa, pasterzy, a przez tajemniczych gości z innych krain – Jezus staje się darem ofiarowanym każdemu człowiekowi. W złożonych przez mędrców ze Wschodu darach: złota, kadzidła i mirry widzimy symbol miłości, modlitwy i cierpienia. Kto bowiem szczerze poszukuje prawdy, dowodzi swojej tęsknoty za dobrem, wiary otwartej na światło z wysoka i odwagi w dążeniu do celu.

André Frossard, dziennikarz, wychowany w domu, w którym nie stawiano nawet problemu Boga, nagle, mając dwadzieścia lat, nawraca się. Dosłownie w ciągu kilku minut doznaje dotykającego działania Łaski. Napisze potem: „Wyszedłem stamtąd po dziesięciu minutach, tak bardzo zaskoczony tym, iż stałem się niespodziewanie katolikiem, jak byłbym zdumiony odkrywając, iż jestem żyrafą lub zebra po wyjściu z ogrodu zoologicznego. [...] była to chwila oszołomienia, która trwa do dziś dnia”. Słusznie jednak sceptycy takich nawróceń uważają, że mimo wszystko są one jakoś przygotowane. Więcej, można by powiedzieć, że przez odrzucenie Boga z życia problem wiary staje się bardziej żywy, zwłaszcza wtedy, gdy zachodzi jakieś dramatyczne wydarzenie.

W poznaniu muszą się znajdować znaki, poprzez które następuje zjednoczenie, jak gwiazda, która doprowadziła mędrców do Betlejem. Reszta była już sprawą wiary. Każdy z nas jest wezwany, do każdego są skierowane są znaki i dary. Wychowany w szczelnym ateizmie Frossard napisze po swoim nawróceniu: „Nad wszystkim, ponad ogromnym światem i w nim samym króluje obecność Tego, którego imienia nie potrafię wymówić nigdy więcej bez uczucia lęku, że zranię Jego dobroć; w obliczu Niego odczuwam szczęście, że jestem dzieckiem, któremu przebaczone wszystko i które budzi się, by poznać, że wszystko jest darem”.

Jest to jedno z najstarszych świąt które było już obchodzone w III wieku na pamiątkę opisanego w Ewangelii św. Mateusza hołdu, jaki Trzej Królowie, Trzej Mędrcy ze Wschodu złożyli Dzieciątku Jezus. Pierwsi chrześcijanie w tym właśnie dniu świętowali Boże Narodzenie.


