

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! Every time Lent rolls around, the question arises concerning what to give up or what practice to take on during this special season of penance. Each Lent I am reminded of a conversation I had with a parishioner in New Jersey during my first couple of years of priesthood. This parishioner was a widow and lived alone. She shared that she planned to give up coffee and chocolate during Lent. No problem. However, this lady then mentioned that she was being hounded by bill collectors. (The conversation took place long

before the days of online bill paying.) I could not understand why she was not able to pay her bills because she had adequate financial means. When I questioned her, the answer came: she hated to open her mail, and the bills just piled up past their due dates! I strongly suggested that her Lenten practice should be to open her mail every day and then celebrate with some coffee and chocolate.

The lesson has stayed with me. In our Lenten observance, we should not miss the obvious. Is there a behavior akin to this aversion to mail that is staring you in the face as Lent begins? Maybe it is time to face the lack of a regular prayer life, the unreconciled relationship, the lack of forgiveness for a wrong committed long ago, the addiction (pornography, alcohol, drugs, food, or gambling), or even unopened mail. The Lord Jesus desires a deep personal relationship with us and is willing to heal the wounds that hold back our hearts from giving him our all. May our Lenten practices further our ongoing conversion and bring us joyfully into Easter and beyond.

"Nie samym chlebem żyje człowiek, lecz każdym słowem, które pochodzi z ust Bożych" (por. Mt 4,4b). Słowo Boże wprowadza nas w scenerię Wielkiego Postu. Ukazuje pojedynek Jezusa z Szatanem, czyli przeciwnikiem, który na każdym kroku będzie sprzeciwiał się Jezusowi. "Diabeł tak kusi Jezusa na pustyni: Pokaż mi coś, wykaż się, żeby zasłużyć w moich oczach na tytuł Syna Bożego" (Michał Zioło OCSO).

Walka dobra ze złem trwa także dziś. Obejmuje ona zarówno zmaganie się z naszymi własnymi skłonnościami do grzechu, jak i odrzucenie Szatana i jego uwodzicielskich postępów (KKK 2752). Tę prawdę dobrze ilustruje film Patryka Vegi pt. "Oczy Diabła" (2021). Znany reżyser udostępnił w sieci szokujący dokument o handlu dziećmi w Polsce i na terenie innych państw Europy. Rozmawiał m.in. z matką, która chciała sprzedać swoje dziecko i z handlarzem. Vedze udało się uratować dziecko, które chciała sprzedać kobieta. Oddała je pod opiekę katolickiej organizacji zajmującej się adopcją dzieci. Pod koniec filmu reżyser wygłasza znamienny monolog z głębokim przesłaniem. "Człowiek z diabłem nie ma żadnych szans. Bo diabeł jest milion razy od nas inteligentniejszy. Mamy do czynienia z potworną, manipulacyjną, bezlitosną siłą. Ale gdy człowiek jest blisko Boga, to diabeł nie ma żadnych szans. I wówczas ryczy wściekle jak lew, bo wie, że już przegrał".



- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age and does not cease.
- ◆ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.

Please note: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from these Lenten obligations.
