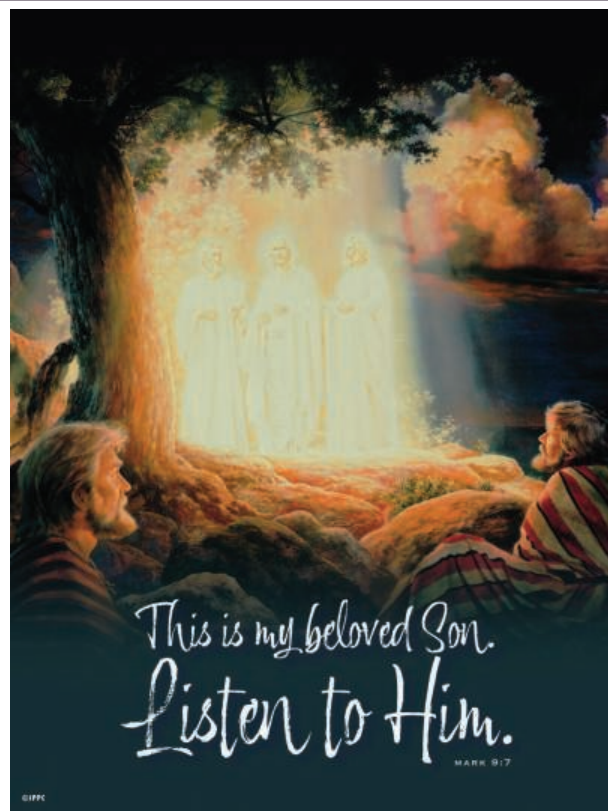

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! On this Second Sunday of Lent, we are treated to the gospel of the transfiguration of Jesus, that revelatory experience witnessed by three of Jesus' disciples and reported by Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Once again, I am grateful to Bishop Robert Barron for an insight that helped me to think about the transfiguration in a new way.

In a recent talk on the essentials of Catholicism, Bishop Barron spoke of the fact that we do not believe in a God who is in competition with our humanity. This, in fact, represents conventional wisdom and characterizes much talk of God in our secular age: If God exists, then I am not free. What the transfiguration demonstrates, however, is that a more explicit experience of Jesus' divinity makes his humanity more radiant and beautiful. What a revelation! Our humanity is not diminished or put in constraints the closer we come to God; instead, our humanity is purified and made more radiant as we surrender to God's grace and presence in our lives. Christianity is not a religion of saying no to everything but of allowing the Lord to beautify and make our human lives shine as they discover their true origin and purpose in God.

This Sunday is a good time to ask ourselves whether our Lenten prayer, penance, and almsgiving are helping to make our lives shine and become more beautiful in the presence of the God who loves us and those whom we encounter along our Lenten journey to Easter.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Boskie piękno odbija się w Osobie Jezusa w tajemnicy przemienienia, „które według tradycji miało miejsce na górze Tabor. Chwała Bóstwa rozświetla oblicze Chrystusa, kiedy Ojciec uznaje Go wobec porwanych zachwytem Apostołów, wzywa ich, aby Go słuchali i przygotowuje do przeżycia z Nim bolesnego momentu męki, aby doszli z Nim do radości zmartwychwstania i do życia przemienionego przez Ducha Świętego” (RVM 21). Zatem podnosi się zasłona zwyczajności i Jezus przez chwilę ukazuje się takim, jakim jest On naprawdę. Widzimy Jego ludzką naturę w blasku Boskiej chwały. Potwierdza w ten sposób wyznanie Piotra. Wskazuje także, że aby „wejść do swej chwały”, musi przejść przez krzyż w Jerozolimie. Mojżesz i Eliasz widzieli chwałę Boga na Górze; Prawo i prorocy zapowiedzieli cierpienia Mesjasza. Męka Jezusa jest właśnie wolą Ojca – Syn działa jako Sługa Boży. Obłok wskazuje na obecność Ducha Świętego: Ukazała się więc cała Trójca: Ojciec w głosie, Syn jako człowiek i Duch w świetlistym obłoku (por. KKK 555).



Jeśli wpatrujemy się w życie Jezusa, to dostrzegamy, że na początku Jego życia publicznego był chrzest, a na początku Paschy – Przemienienie. Przez chrzest Jezusa ukazała się tajemnica naszego pierwszego odrodzenia, czyli nasz chrzest. Przemienienie „jest sakramentem powtórnego odrodzenia”, które zapowiada nasze zmartwychwstanie. Już teraz uczestniczymy w Zmartwychwstaniu Pana przez Ducha Świętego, który działa w sakramencie Ciała Chrystusa. Przemienienie daje nam przedsmak chwalebnego przyjścia Chrystusa, „który przekształci nasze ciało poniżone na podobne do swego chwalebnego ciała” (Flp 3, 21). Przypomina nam również, że „przez wiele ucisków trzeba nam wejść do Królestwa Bożego” (Dz 14, 22) (por. KKK 556).

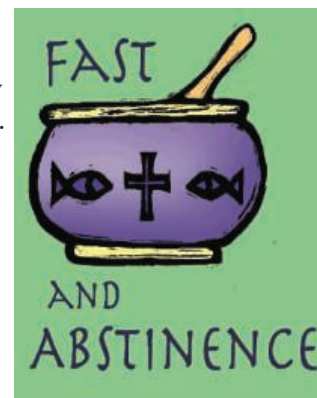

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- ◆ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ◆ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age and does not cease.
- ◆ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.

◆ Please note: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from these Lenten obligations.

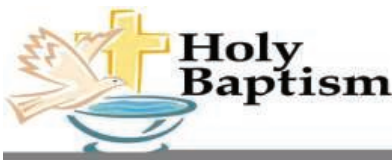

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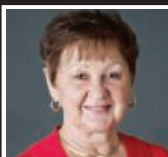
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
