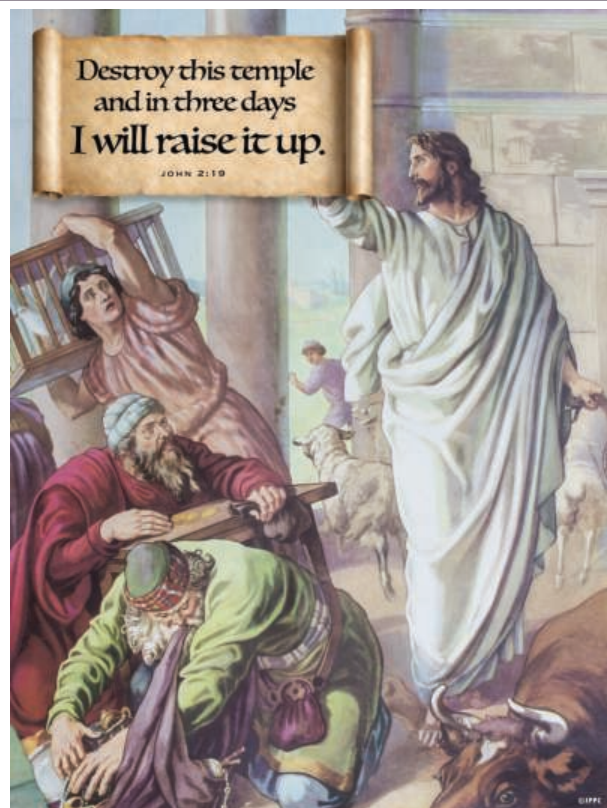

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! The first reading for this Third Sunday of Lent is the proclamation of the Ten Commandments or "Decalogue," the cornerstone of Judeo-Christian morality. It should be noted that all the commandments are not of equal length. In fact, the longest commandment is the first: the prohibition of worship of other gods and of idolatry. If we don't get the first commandment right, then our lives will be lived in vain.

It's unlikely that any of our brothers and sisters worshipping with us believe in many gods, but idolatry is another matter. You and I can often make God in our own image, or worse, substitute money, power, or prestige for belief in the one, true God revealed on Mount Sinai and made flesh in Jesus Christ. We need not forge a golden calf as did the Israelites (Exodus 32), but we can easily allow many things other than God to hold dominion over our thoughts and actions.

One of the goals of Lent is to allow Jesus to drive out all that is not of God from the living temples of the Spirit that we are. We no longer need ascend a fiery, quaking mountain to encounter God as did Moses. In Jesus we encounter the human face of God and an infinite ocean of love and mercy that cleanses and fills us.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Dzisiejsze słowo warto zacząć od refleksji ks. Piotra Pawlukiewicza, który powiedział kiedyś m.in.: „Można w życiu nie grzeszyć, chodzić do kościoła i być abstynentem, i modlić się rano i wieczorem. Ale lejjee, Panie Boże, to ja będę trzymał. Problem nie leży w tym, co ja robię. Problem leży w tym, kto decyduje. Można żyć bardzo pięknie, ale kto decyduje? Kto jest Panem tego życia?”.



„Tak Bóg umiłował świat, że dał swojego Syna Jednorodzonego; każdy, kto w Niego wierzy, ma życie wieczne” (por. J 3,16). Jak wierzyć w Jezusa, który zapowiada swoją mękę i zmartwychwstanie... w XXI wieku brzmi to nienowocześnie.

Ojciec posyła nam – całkowicie za darmo – swojego Syna. A jedynym motywem Jego działania jest miłość do stworzenia, a zwłaszcza do człowieka. I jeśli słyszymy dziś: na świecie nie ma nic za darmo, to mamy przykład, że jest inaczej. Jezus pragnie być Panem naszego życia, bo przecież należymy do Niego przez chrzest.

Drogą, która prowadzi nas do Chrystusa, jest wiara. Temat wiary jest żywo obecny również w książce pt. Wady i cnoty (2021). To wywiad-rzeka ks. Marco Pozzy z papieżem Franciszkiem. Wśród wielu cennych spostrzeżeń zatrzymajmy się nad fragmentem, w którym znajdujemy papieską refleksję na temat wiary wystawionej na próbę przez wątpliwości. „Diabeł wkłada w ciebie wątpliwości, kolejne zasiewa życie, a następne tragedie: dlaczego Bóg na to pozwala? Ale wiara bez wątpliwości nie rozwija się. (...) Pomyślmy, że bycie opuszczonym przez Boga stało się doświadczeniem wiary, które miało wielu świętych, a także jest udziałem wielu ludzi dzisiaj, kiedy czują się pozostawieni przez Boga, nie tracąc przy tym wiary. Strzegą daru: w tej chwili nic nie czuję, ale strzegę daru wiary. Chrześcijaninowi, który nigdy nie przeszedł przez te stany duszy, czegoś brakuje, ponieważ oznacza to, że jest zadowolony. Kryzysy wiary nie są przejawami jej braku. Przeciwnie, ujawniają one potrzebę i pragnienie, aby coraz bardziej zagłębiać się w tajemnicę Boga. Wiara bez tych prób każe mi wątpić, czy jest to prawdziwa wiara”.

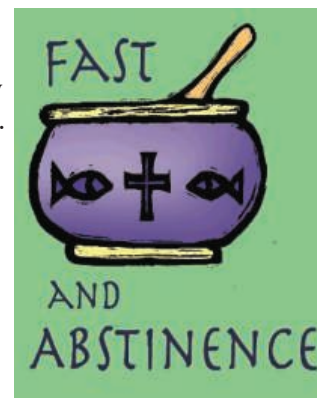

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- ◆ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ◆ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age and does not cease.
- ◆ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.

◆ Please note: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from these Lenten obligations.

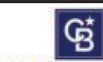

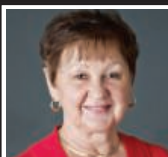
