Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy New Year! The day on which we ring in 2022 practically coincides this year with the Solemnity of the Epiphany, the “manifestation” of Jesus Christ to all the nations—represented by the three mysterious magi bearing gifts for the newborn King. The Gospel of St. Matthew tells us that three non-Jews had the courage to read the stars, according to their pagan custom, and then seek out this extraordinary birth for themselves.

Among the New Year’s resolutions we ought to make this year is to dare to live this same bold and courageous faith to welcome Jesus into every corner of our lives, including the family issues, the repetitive sins, and our world-weariness as a result of the many challenges to our Catholic Christian faith that we never thought possible.

T. S. Eliot has a wonderful poem about the journey of the magi that comes to mind every Epiphany. In it he writes eloquently about how the magi, so overwhelmed by their visit to the Babe of Bethlehem, experienced a kind of death to all they held important. They returned to their countries by a different route, no longer content with things as they were. Will you and I allow the Christ Child, the Word-made-flesh, to so impact our lives in 2022 that we can never be the same?

☞ BLESSING OF HOMES ☞

The Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, January 2, is a time of the year when we traditionally bless our homes and ask the Lord's blessings on our families for the coming year. This year our Parish will continue this beautiful tradition if you call the Parish Office and request one of the friars to come. If you choose not to have one of the friars come, we invite you to bless your home with the blessed chalk and incense that will be available after the Masses this weekend. We ask that you follow the ceremony outlined below in blessing the home.

Blessing Ceremony

- ☞ A Christmas Carol is sung.
- ☞ Read from the Bible John 1:1-16.
- ☞ The head of the household prays, "The three Wise Men, Kasper, Melchior, and Balthazar, journeyed to Bethlehem to find the Christ Child, and followed the star to God's Son, who became man. May the peace of Christ rest in our home; may our home be a dwelling of the Lord's mercy, love, joy, peace, and forgiveness. May all who enter our home experience Jesus Christ in all that we say and do. We ask this through Christ our Lord."
- ☞ Another member of the family marks the doorpost with the blessed chalk - 20+C+M+B+22 - and then carefully burn the blessed incense.
- ☞ A closing Carol is sung.



The meaning of the doorpost markings 20+C+M+B+22: The letters are the initials of the traditional names of the Three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. These letters also abbreviate the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house." And of course, the beginning and ending numbers are the year.

STYCZEN 2, 2022 - TRZECH KROLI

Św. Jan Paweł II w Liście do dzieci „Tra pochi giorni” pisał:

„W okresie Bożego Narodzenia stajenka betlejemka ze żłóbkiem Dzieciątka zajmuje centralne miejsce w Kościele. I wszyscy do niej spieszą w duchowej pielgrzymce, tak jak pasterze w Noc Narodzenia. Potem trzej Mędrcy przybywają z dalekiego Wschodu, idąc za światłem gwiazdy, która im pokazała miejsce, gdzie złożony był Odkupiciel świata. Wy też w tym czasie dążycie do tych stajenek, aby wpatrywać się w Dziecię położone na sianie, żeby wpatrywać się w Jego Matkę oraz w świętego Józefa, który był na ziemi opiekunem Odkupiciela (...). Jeśli dzisiaj piszę o tym wszystkim do was, drogie dzieci, to czynię to dlatego, że i ja sam byłem przed wielu laty takim samym dzieckiem jak wy. Również i ja przeżywałem wówczas radość Bożego Narodzenia tak jak wy, a kiedy zajaśniała gwiazda betlejemka, spieszyłem się do stajenki razem z moimi rówieśnikami, ażeby przeżyć na nowo to, co wydarzyło się 2000 lat temu w Palestynie (...). Oto stanął wśród nas, jako nowo narodzone Dziecię, Syn Bożego upodobania. A wokół Niego dzieci wszystkich narodów ziemi odczuwają na sobie miłujący wzrok Ojca niebieskiego i radują się, że je miłuje. Człowiek nie może żyć bez miłości. Jest wezwany do miłości Boga i bliźniego, ale żeby prawdziwie miłować, potrzebna jest mu ta pewność, że Bóg go miłuje”.



Ks. Marek Rybiński, młody misjonarz zamordowany w Tunezji 18 lutego 2011 roku, napisał książkę „Zapiski tunezyjskie”, która mówi o zwycięstwie życia nad śmiercią, miłości nad nienawiścią. Jest milczącym świadectwem Miłości, która w Betlejem zstąpiła na ziemię. W książce tej znajdziemy świadectwo nawróconego muzułmanina, wypowiedziane na konferencji dla tunezyjskich księży. Wierzył on w Boga, którego nazywał Allahem, a jednak wyruszył na poszukiwanie Boga, pragnąc bardziej zażyłej i bardziej ludzkiej relacji z Nim. Podobnie jak trzej królowie, którzy wierzyli w Boga, a jednak wpatrywali się niebo i czekali na pełniejsze objawienie się Boga. Pojawiła się gwiazda na niebie, którą za natchnieniem Bożym odczytali, jako znak prowadzący na spotkanie z Bogiem. Dla nawróconego muzułmanina taką gwiazdą stała się „Biblia”. A zatem posłuchajmy jego świadectwa:

„Jednego brakowało mi w islamie – byłem wysoko postawiony w hierarchii religijnej, szukałem całym sercem Boga, ale ciągle dla mnie Bóg był kimś niepoznanym. Moja wiara zabraniała mi Go poznać. Nie znałem swojego Boga i to doprowadzało mnie do depresji. Nie chciałem całkowitego poznania, ale chciałem tej możliwości ciągłego poszukiwania i zgłębiania, pragnąłem Boga bliskiego i kochającego, który byłby mi przyjacielem i towarzyszem”.

Takiego Boga zaczął szukać. Ktoś mu poradził, aby zapoznał się bardziej z chrześcijaństwem, a na pewno odnajdzie bliskiego Boga. Przez sześć lat szukał Pisma św. w arabskim języku. „Biblia” stała się tą gwiazdą, która doprowadziła go do Jezusa.

Pan Bóg daje łaskę nawrócenia, ale oczekuje od nas abyśmy idąc za naszą gwiazdą betlejemską, prowadzącą do Chrystusa wskazywali ją także naszym bliźnim.

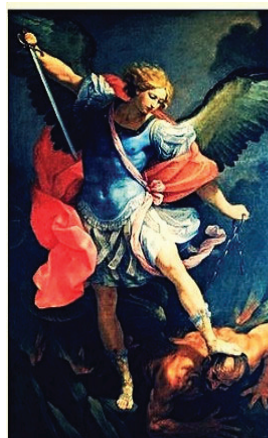
