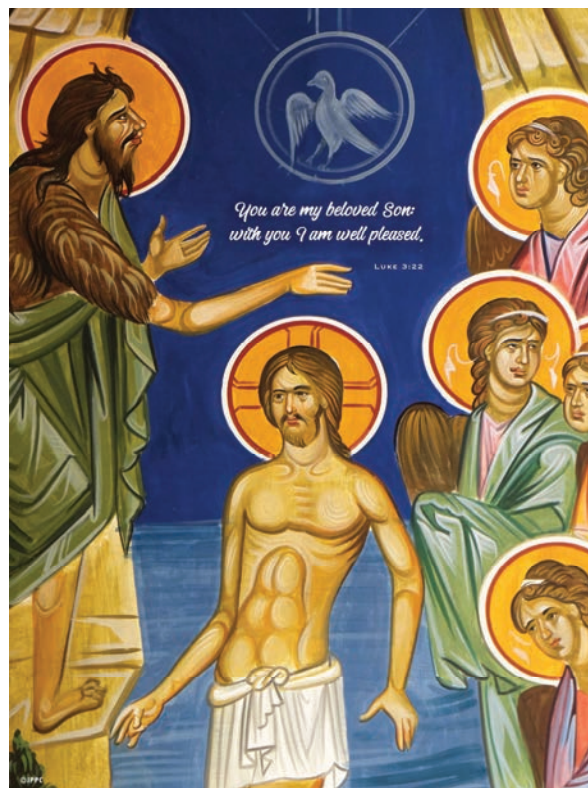

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

STYCZEN 9, 2022 - CHRZEST CHRYSUSA

Papież Jan Paweł II w czasie swej pielgrzymki do Polski odwiedził miejsce swego chrztu i w homilii nawiązał do tego tymi słowami:

„Kiedy patrzę wstecz, widzę jak droga mojego życia poprzez środowisko tutejsze, poprzez moją rodzinę prowadzi mnie do jednego miejsca; do chrzcielnicy w wadowickim kościele. Przy tej chrzcielnicy zostałem przyjęty do łaski bożego synostwa i wiary Odkupiciela mojego, do wspólnoty Jego Kościoła. Chrzcielnicę tę już raz uroczyście ucałowałem w roku tysiąclecia chrztu Polski jako ówczesny biskup krakowski. Potem uroczyście po raz drugi na 50 rocznicę mojego chrztu jako kardynał, dzisiaj po raz trzeci ucałowałem tę chrzcielnicę, przybывая z Rzymu jako następca św. Piotra.”

Droga wiary Papieża rozpoczęła się w tej wadowickiej chrzcielnicy.

W chrzcielnicy, a raczej w tajemnicy chrztu kryje się potężna siła, która dla wierzącego jest niewyczerpanym źródłem inspiracji i mocy w kształtowaniu dojrzałej osobowości i uświęcenia się.

A zatem skąd jest ta moc?

Na mocy chrztu świętego, każdy z nas ma udział w misji prorockiej Kościoła, na mocy której mamy głosić Ewangelię, upominać i wzywać do nawrócenia. Pierwszym miejscem pełnienia misji prorockiej jest nasza rodzina. Gdy widzimy, że któryś z członków naszej rodziny przecina gałąź łączącą go z Bogiem, mamy przed tym ostrzegać, upominać. Nie można dla świętego spokoju lekceważyć nawet najmniejszego łamania bożych przekazów. Bo ten święty spokój zaowocuje w przyszłości burzą i upadkiem. Nieraz trzeba wywołać w domu niepokój, o którym Chrystus mówi: „Nie sądzicie, że przyszedłem pokój przynieść na ziemię. Nie przyszedłem przynieść pokoju, ale miecz. Bo przyszedłem poróżnić syna z jego ojcem, córkę z matką, synową z teściową; i będą nieprzyjaciółmi człowieka jego domownicy”. Chrystusowa burza, niepokój rodzą prawdziwy i stały pokój i prowadzi do zbawienia

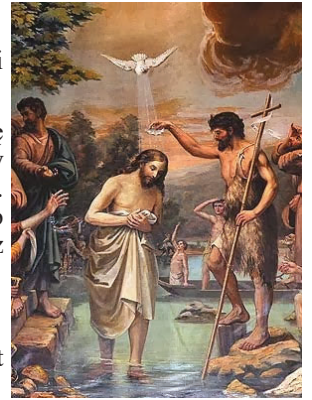
„Kiedy cały lud przystępował do chrztu, Jezus także przyjął chrzest. A gdy się modlił, otworzyło się niebo i Duch Święty zstąpił na Niego w postaci cielesnej niby gołębia, a z nieba odezwał się głos: ‘Tyś jest mój Syn umiłowany, w Tobie mam upodobanie’”.

Katechizm Kościoła Katolickiego mówi: „Owoc chrztu lub łaski chrztu jest bogatą rzeczywistością, która obejmuje przebaczenie grzechów pierworodnych i grzechów osobistych, narodziny w nowe życie, w którym człowiek staje się przybranym synem Ojca, członkiem Ciała Chrystusa i świątynią Ducha Świętego”. Chrystus był bez grzechu takiego chrztu nie potrzebował, a zatem, dlaczego go przyjął? W odpowiedzi posłużyć się słowami George Cairda: „Jezus przyszedł wtedy, aby zostać ochrzczone, nie z powodów prywatnych, ale jako człowiek z publicznym powołaniem. Jan Chrzciiciel wezwał cały Izrael do skruchy, a wraz z Izraelem Jezus musi odejść. Jezus mieszkał wśród grzesznego ludu i nie mógł się od nich odłączyć. Przeciwnie, musi być w pełni utożsamiany z nimi w ich ruchu ku Bogu”.

„Czy wyrzekasz się grzechu, aby żyć w wolności dzieci Bożych? Czy wyrzekasz się wszystkiego, co prowadzi do zła, aby cię grzech nie opanował? Czy wyrzekasz się szatana, który jest głównym sprawcą grzechu? Czy wierzysz w Boga, Ojca wszechmogącego, Stworzyciela nieba i ziemi? Czy wierzysz w Jezusa Chrystusa, Jego Syna jedyne, Pana naszego, narodzonego z Maryi Dziewicy, umęczonego i pogrzebanego, który powstał z martwych i zasiada po prawicy Ojca? Czy wierzysz w Ducha Świętego, święty Kościół powszechny, obcowanie świętych, odpuszczenie grzechów, zmartwychwstanie ciała i życie wieczne?”

Oczywiście to wyznanie w naszym życiu ma przybierać formę czynu.

Św. Jakub mówi: „Tak też i wiara, jeśli nie byłaby połączona z uczynkami, martwa jest sama w sobie”.

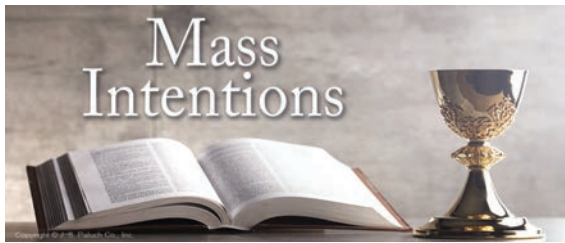

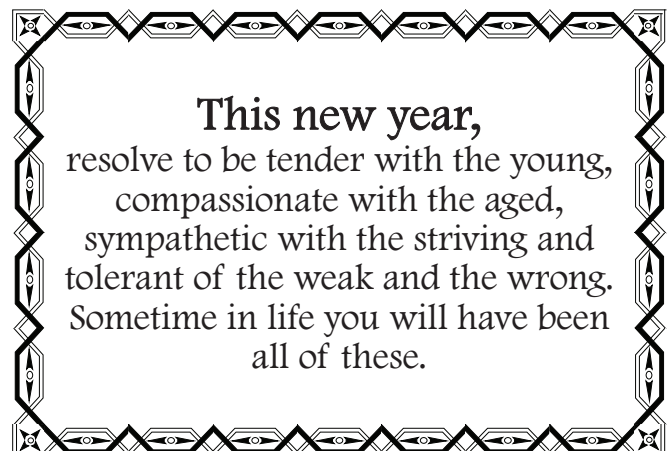

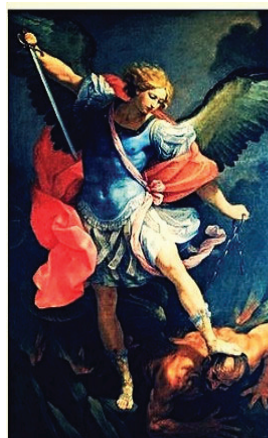
