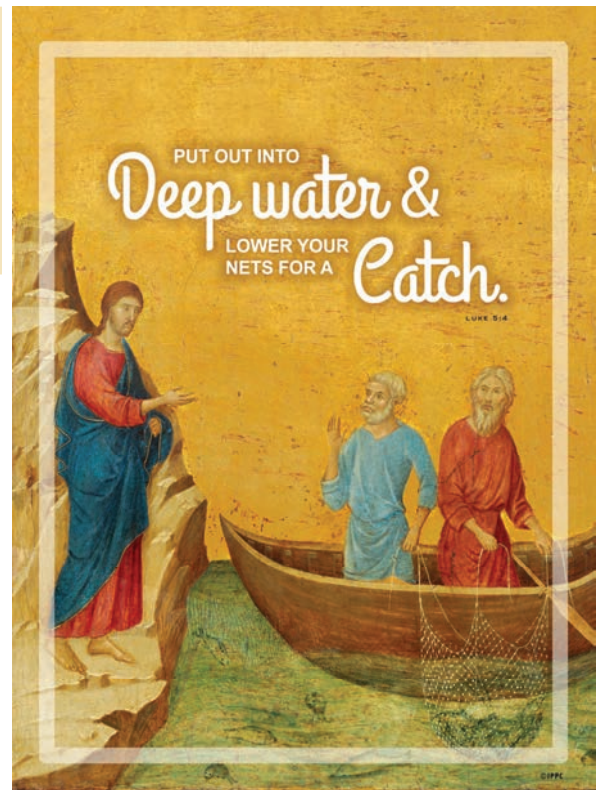

Peace and all good things! As I was listening to the news recently and heard that the State of the Union address had been scheduled for 2022, it gave me the idea to gather us as a parish family for the "State of the Basilica." This would be an event in which I would share with you the overall situation of the Basilica--assessing what I have experienced so far and proposing what we might work on as a community of faith for the future. The time together would include a presentation of the financial state of the parish, school, and cemetery.

After consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council, this "State of the Basilica" will be scheduled for the weekend of **March 12 - 13**, the Second Sunday of Lent. There will be two options offered for your convenience: immediately after the 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass on Saturday, *or* immediately after the 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday. Both sessions will be held in the upper church. I look forward to your presence and participation!

World Day for Consecrated Life: This Sunday, February 6th, has been designated as the World Day for Consecrated Life. As we give thanks for the brothers, priests, and sisters in consecrated life who have served and continue to serve throughout the world and right here in Chicopee, I ask you to encourage vocations among the young people you know, especially vocations to the Franciscan way of life. As always, please keep the friars and sisters in your prayers as we try to be faithful to the Gospel life to which we have been called.

BIULETYN Parafialny

6 LUTEGO - V NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

W marcu 2011 roku, w szwedzkim mieście Tumba, przypadkowo, podczas prac remontowych pracownicy odnaleźli ciało starszego mężczyzny. Przedstawiciel firmy remontowej Thomas Martinsson powiedział: „Dwóch moich ludzi weszło do mieszkania i znaleźli martwego człowieka. Zadzwonili do mnie i odkryliśmy, że leżał tam już od dłuższego czasu”. Policjanci przypuszczają, że zmarł on trzy lata temu. Znalezione nieodczytany mail z 2007 roku, a jedzenie w lodówce było datowane na początek 2008 roku. Zniknięcia mężczyzny nie zauważyli sąsiedzi, a może zauważyli, ale nie obchodziło ich, co się z nim dzieje. Pławili się we własnym dobrobycie. Zmarły miał także rodzinę. Miał syna, który przez trzy lata nie zainteresował, co się dzieje z jego ojcem. Zmarły miał wszystko. Wystarczającą emeryturę, świadczenia socjalne, pełna lodówkę. Nie miał tylko najważniejszego. Zabrakło miłości, bez której zbudowanie „raju” jest niemożliwe.



Młody krakowski student, który świetnie spełniał się jako literat, artysta i aktor usłyszał wezwanie: „Wypłyn na głębię”. Pozostawił wszystko i wstąpił do seminarium duchownego. Jak młody kapłan zdobywał dusze ludzkie i odkrywał przed nimi niezgłębianą mądrość bożą. Czynił to także w czasie wakacyjnych wypraw kajakowych. Na jednej z nich dotarło do niego wezwanie do wypłynięcia na jeszcze głębsze wody. Ksiądz Karol Wojtyła został wezwany do prymasa Stefana Wyszyńskiego, który poinformował go o nominacji na biskupa. W książce „Wstańcie, Chodźmy!”, papież napisał: „Kiedy wszedłem do gabinetu ks. Prymasa, usłyszałem od niego, że Ojciec Święty mianował mnie biskupem pomocniczym arcybiskupa Krakowa (...). Słyszając słowa Księdza Prymasa zwiastujące mi decyzję Stolicy Apostolskiej, powiedziałem: ‘Eminencjo, ja jestem za młody, mam dopiero 38 lat. Ale Prymas na to: ‘To jest taka słabość, z której się szybko leczymy. Proszę się nie sprzeciwiać woli Ojca Świętego’. Więc powiedziałem jedno słowo: ‘Przyjmuję’(...) Po zakończeniu tej tak ważnej w moim życiu audiencji zrozumiałem, że nie mogę w tej chwili wracać do przyjaciół na kajaki; musiałem naprzód pojechać do Krakowa i zawiadomić księdza arcybiskupa Eugeniusza Baziaka, mojego ordynariusza (...). Następnego dnia zgłosiłem się zatem do księdza arcybiskupa na ulicę Franciszkańską 3 i wręczyłem mu list od Księdza Prymasa.

David J. Wolpe opowiada taką historię. Przed Bogiem stoi załamany człowiek z powodu zła i niesprawiedliwości na świecie. Woła on do Boga: „Drogi Boże, Ty widzisz, ile na świecie jest zła, cierpienia, beznadziei, niesprawiedliwości i nienawiści. Dlaczego nie przysyłasz nam pomocy, aby to wszystko przemienić”. Bóg odpowiada: „Ja już posłałem pomoc, posłałem ciebie”.

11 lutego obchodzony będzie **ŚWIATOWY DZIEŃ CHOREGO**. Ustanowił go Jan Paweł II dnia 13 maja 1992 r. Wyzaczył wówczas jego datę na 11 lutego - wspomnienie Matki Bożej z Lourdes. W Dniu Chorego w wielu kościołach jest udzielany Sakrament Chorych. **Sakrament namaszczenia chorych** to znak sakramentalny zostawiony przez Chrystusa jako narzędzie uświęcenia naszego cierpienia. Przez ten sakrament Chrystus chce nam pokazać, że cierpienie nie musi człowieka niszczyć, może go doskonalić. Św. Marek wspomina, że uczniowie Chrystusa namaszczały chorych i uzdrawiali. A św. Jakub mówi o tradycji pierwszych pokoleń chrześcijan: „Choruje ktoś wśród was? Niech sprowadzi kapłanów Kościoła, by się modlili nad nim i namaścili go olejem w imię Pana. A modlitwa pełna wiary będzie dla chorego ratunkiem i Pan go podźwignie, a jeśli by popełnił grzechy, będą mu odpuszczone” (Jk 5, 14-15).

Dziś obchodzimy Światowy **DZIEŃ ŻYCIA KONSEKROWANEGO** -ustanowiony przez papieża Jana Pawła II w 1997 r. Celem tego dnia jest szczególna refleksja nad darem życia poświęconego Bogu, dziękczynienie i modlitwa za konsekrowanych.

Wszystkim, którzy oddali swoje życie Chrystusowi i weszli w szczególną relację miłości przez czystość, ubóstwo i posłuszeństwo, a zwłaszcza Ojcom pracującym w naszej parafii i Siostram zakonnym składamy najlepsze życzenia, światła Bożego Słowa i mocy Chrystusa na każdy dzień posługiwania i pamiętamy o nich w naszych modlitwach.

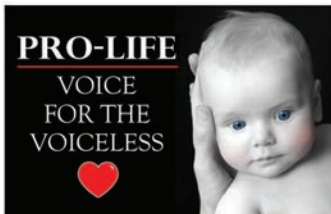

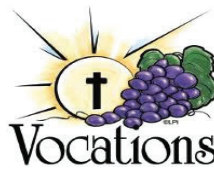
