Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

How time flies! It's hard to believe that in just a few days we'll be exchanging the green of Ordinary Time for the purple of Lent. Ash Wednesday always seems to arrive so fast. Pączki will give way to penance. No meat on Fridays. Stations of the Cross and Gorzkie Żale will be priorities these next few weeks. Our parish Lenten retreat (March 5 – 10) will be a good start to this penitential season. Even with all these things in place, it's important to begin some personal prayerful planning for Lent TODAY—right now.

The usual question we Catholics ask each other these days is, “What are you giving up?” Everyone's answer will vary. For many, the giving up of something is accompanied by thoughts of spiritual and physical endurance these 40 days so we can gorge ourselves after the Easter Vigil on whatever the “something” is. This may come as a shock to some, but the Lord isn't impressed by our spiritual muscle flexing. He would rather have us embrace a penance that brings lasting change and continues into the Easter season and beyond. So...don't look for exotic or unusual penances to win the prize for originality. Start by looking at the reality of your life and see where you keep God out of it, where forgiveness needs to take place, and where conversion needs more solid roots. Chances are that the right Lenten penance is staring you in the face. Happy Lent!

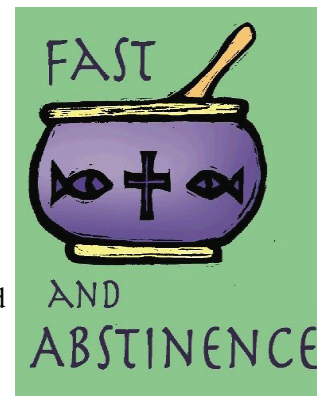

## LENTEN REGULATIONS

- ❧ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- ❧ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ❧ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age.
- ❧ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.
- ❧ Although the faithful may excuse themselves for a just cause from these laws of fast and abstinence, there is an obligation to substitute another penance and no Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from this obligation in the Lenten season.



# BIULETYN Parafialny

## 27 LUTEGO 2022 - VIII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

W jednej z amerykańskiej gazet przeprowadzono ankietę na temat ludzkiego szczęścia. Zadano pytanie: Dlaczego jedni ludzie czują się szczęśliwi, a inni nie? Okazało się, że sekret ludzkiego szczęścia i nieszczęścia najczęściej kryje się w samym człowieku. Czynniki zewnętrzne nie odgrywają zasadniczej roli w tej materii. Wyniki badań poparto konkretnymi przykładami. Poczucie szczęścia zależy od naszej dyspozycji umysłowej i nastawienia psychicznego do otaczającej nas rzeczywistości. Szczęśliwi ludzie są nastawieni bardzo pozytywnie i optymistycznie do otaczającego ich świata. Dostrzegają pozytywną i przyjazną stronę otaczającej ich rzeczywistości, zauważają szczególnie pozytywne cechy drugiego człowieka, jego dobro i szlachetność. Zaś nieszczęśliwcy są negatywnie i wrogo nastawieni do otaczającej ich rzeczywistości. W swoich ocenach bliźniego skupiają się na jego negatywnych cechach i wadach. Skłonni są do krytykowania i wytykania błędów bliźniemu. Czepiają się wszystkiego. Nie dostrzegają dobrej strony bliźniego. I prawie nigdy nie pochwalą drugiego człowieka, nawet gdy jego dobro jest oczywiste dla wszystkich. Najczęściej są to chorobliwi zazdrośnicy. To właśnie do tych nieszczęśliwców, w sposób szczególny odnoszą się słowa Jezusa z dzisiejszej Ewangelii: „Czemu to widzisz drzazgę w oku swego brata, a belki we własnym oku nie dostrzegasz? Jak możesz mówić swemu bratu: ‘Bracie, pozwól, że usunę drzazgę, która jest w twoim oku’, gdy sam belki w swoim oku nie widzisz? Obludniku, wyrzuć najpierw belkę ze swego oka, a wtedy przejrzysz, ażeby usunąć drzazgę z oka swego brata”. Za nim zabierzemy się za robienie porządku w ogródku naszego sąsiada, trzeba wcześniej zrobić go we własnym.

Ks. Bronisław Markiewicz, który z wielką pokorą służył potrzebującym pisał: „Idźmy w ślady Chrystusowe. Przede wszystkim uczmy się od Niego, iż jest cichy i pokornego serca, w sposób niedościgniony. Będąc Panem nieba i ziemi, i najwyższą doskonałością, w całym swoim ziemskim życiu nie wysuwa się naprzód przed ludzi, nie wyróżnia się niczym, nie oddziela się od tłumu i nie przybiera żadnych oznak swojej wielkości. Przeciwnie, zabiega o ostatnie miejsce, ukrywa się i zataja, przyjmując na Siebie skrajne ubóstwo, najmniejsze prace i posługi oraz najbardziej uniżone posłuszeństwo. I tak oddaje swojemu Ojcu Niebieskiemu wszelką cześć i chwałę w sposób najdoskonalszy. Pokora jest jedyną drogą do wielkości prawdziwej, jedyną bezpieczną podstawą wszelkiej cnoty chrześcijańskiej, niezawodną miarą wielkości człowieka, pierwszym zadatkiem łask i darów Bożych, głównym i niezawodnym warunkiem skutecznego udziału w wielkiej sprawie odkupienia rodzaju ludzkiego, a zatem pierwszą potęgą w dziedzinie duchowej oraz w sprawach doczesnych. Pokora poskramia naszego ducha, aby zbytnio nie polegał na własnych siłach i nie wynosił się zbytnio ponad siebie, ale przeświadczony o własnej słabości i skłonności do grzechu, wszelkie dobro przypisywał Panu Bogu, a mało sobie ważył siebie samego. Dopiero tak usposobionemu człowiekowi Pan Bóg daje łaski i dokonuje przez niego wielkich rzeczy, a moc Chrystusowa objawia się w nim w całym blasku”.

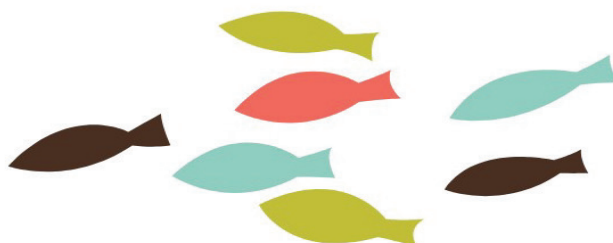

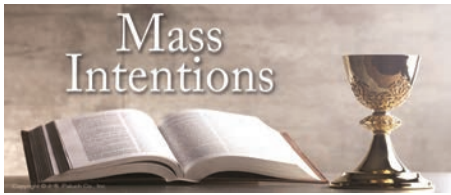
