13 MARCA 2022 - II NIEDZIELA WIELKIEGO POSTU

Bracia, bądźcie wszyscy razem moimi naśladowcami i wpatrujcie się w tych, którzy tak postępują, jak tego wzór macie w nas. Wielu bowiem postępuje jak wrogowie krzyża Chrystusowego, o których często wam mówiłem, a teraz mówię z płaczem. Ich losem – zagłada, ich bogiem – brzuch, a chwała – w tym, czego winni się wstydzić. To ci, których dążenia są przyziemne. Nasza bowiem ojczyzna jest w niebie. Stamtąd też jako Zbawcy wyczekujemy Pana naszego Jezusa Chrystusa, który przekształci nasze ciało poniżone na podobne do swego chwalebnego ciała, tą potęgą, jaką może On także wszystko, co jest, sobie podporządkować. Przeto bracia umiłowani, za którymi tęsknię, radości i chwała moja, tak stójcie mocno w Panu, umiłowani (Flp 3,17-4 1).

Święty Ignacy Loyola doświadczył w swoim życiu tego, co było udziałem apostołów na Górze Tabor. W czasie swojej choroby doznał zachwycającej wizji spotkania z Bogiem. To spotkanie rozpało jego wiarę tak, że w jej mocy wiele dokonał w Kościele Chrystusowym. Życie Ignacego wypadło w bardzo burzliwym i trudnym okresie historii Kościoła. Wystąpił wtedy Luter, Zwigli i Kalwin, dając początek protestantyzmowi. Król Henryk VIII oderwał Anglię od Kościoła. Zaś sam Kościół został dotknięty upadkiem moralnym, który nie ominął nawet hierarchii Kościoła. Reakcją na zaistniałą sytuację był ruch na rzecz odnowy i reformy. Kościół na nowo odzyskał swoją ewangeliczną autentyczność i świętość. W ten ruch odnowy wpisał się złotymi zgłoskami Św. Ignacy Loyola i założone przez niego Towarzystwo Jezusowe (Jezuici), które na odnowicielskim Soborze Trydenckim w latach 1545-1563 odegrało znaczącą rolę.

Jeden z następców św. Piotra, papież Paweł VI zmarł w uroczystość Przemienienia Pańskiego, 6 sierpnia 1978 roku. Wcześniej, na ten dzień przygotował przemówienie, które miał wygłosić po modlitwie Anioł Pański. Słowa i kontekst w jakim zostały napisane mogą być jednym z impulsów lepszego wykorzystania czasu w wielkopostnej przemianie: „Przemienienie Pańskie, które wspominamy w dzisiejszej liturgii, rzuca jasne światło na naszą codzienność i zaprasza do skierowania naszych myśli ku nieśmiertelnym przeznaczeniom, o których nam ono przypomina. Na Taborze Chrystus na chwilę odsłonił swój boski blask i objawił się wybranym świadkom jako Ten, którym rzeczywiście jest: jako Syn Boży, ‘Ten Syn, który jest odbłaskiem Jego chwały i odbiciem Jego istoty’. On odsłania również transcendentne przeznaczenie naszej ludzkiej natury, którą przyjął, aby nas zbawić. Także ta natura, ponieważ jest odkupiona Jego nieodwołalną ofiarą miłości, jest powołana do udziału w pełni życia, ‘w działach świętych w światłości’. To ciało, które przemieniło się przed zdumionymi oczyma apostołów, jest ciałem Chrystusa, Brata naszego, ale jest też ciałem naszym przeznaczonym do chwały. To światło, które nad Nim świeci, jest i chce być naszym promiennym dziedzictwem. Jesteśmy powołani do uczestnictwa w tak wielkiej chwale, ponieważ jesteśmy ‘uczestnikami Boskiej natury’. Czekają nas wyjątkowa przyszłość, jeżeli spełnimy nasze chrześcijańskie powołanie, kiedy nasze słowa i czyny będą logiczną konsekwencją naszych przyrzeczeń chrzcielnych” (z książki W poszukiwaniu mądrości życia).

ROK EUCHARYSTII – MODLITWA

Jezu, wierzę że Jesteś prawdziwie obecny w ciele, krwi, duszy i Bóstwie w Najświętszej Eucharystii. Tobie zawieramy wszystkie nasze rodziny. Uzdrów rany i odnow nasze serca, i umysły byśmy mogli służyć Ci z jeszcze większym oddaniem, poświęceniem i czcią w tym Najświętszym Sakramencie. Nasza Pani, pierwsze tabernakulum Słowa, które stało się Ciałem, wstawiaj się za nami u Twojego Syna, szczególnie za naszą diecezją i jej kapłanami. Przez ich miłość do kapłaństwa i Eucharystii niech inspirować młodych mężczyzn do podążania drogą do Chrystusowego kapłaństwa tak by Msze św. mogły być nadal sprawowane a my posileni Ciałem i Krwią Twojego Syna. Prowadź szczególnie naszych młodych ludzi do Kościoła by mogli wzrastać i rozkwitać poznając prawdę, która wypływa tylko od Jezusa Chrystusa. Trójco Przenajświętsza bądź uwielbiona. Boże mój kocham Cię w tym Przenajświętszym Sakramencie. Amen.

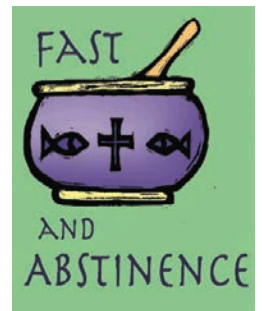

- ☞ Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ☞ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age.
- ☞ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.
- ☞ Although the faithful may excuse themselves for a just cause from these laws of fast and abstinence, there is an obligation to substitute another penance and no Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from this obligation in the Lenten season.
