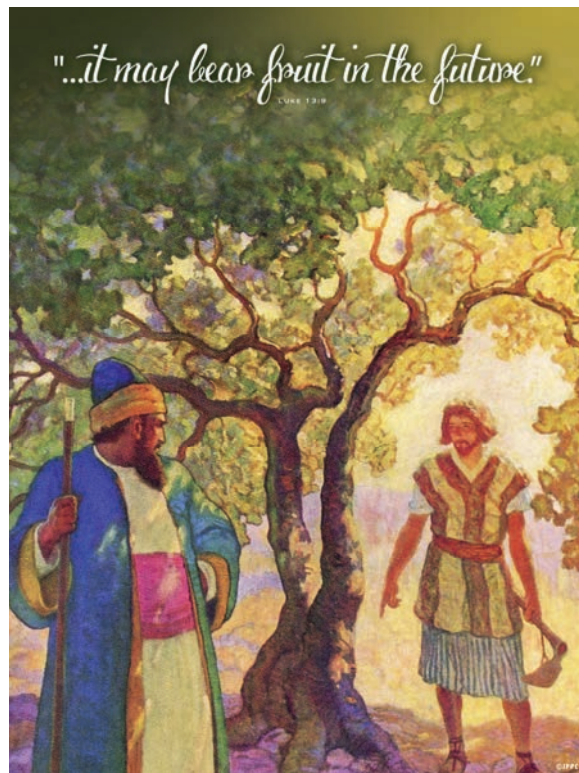

BIULETYN Parafialny

20 MARCA 2022 - III NIEDZIELA WIELKIEGO POSTU

Tomasz Merton, mnich-eremita, poeta, pisarz, duszpasterz, artysta malarz i fotografik, mistyk, znawca duchowości Dalekiego Wschodu, ekumenista, pacyfista, ikona pop kultury doby dzieci-kwiatów w książce „Szukanie Boga” napisał: „Wszyscy bowiem ludzie mają swój cel nadprzyrodzony – widzenie Boga. Mają osiągnąć ten cel posługując się swymi władzami naturalnymi, szczególnie intelektem i wolą, wspomagani łaską Boga. Łaska nigdy nie zawiedzie tego, kto czyni wszystko, co w jego mocy, by znaleźć Boga”. Merton był wychowany przez ojca w duchu indyferentyzmu religijnego i swobody moralnej. Jednak wewnętrzny głos przynaglał go do szukania Boga. W czasie studiów w Columbia University zapoznał się z pracami św. Augustyna, Tomasza a Kempisa, Ignacego Loyoli. Pod ich wpływem nawrócił się i w 1938 przyjął chrzest, a w roku 1949 wstąpił do zakonu trapistów w Gethsemani w stanie Kentucky. O swoim szukaniu Boga napisał w wyżej wspomnianej książce: „Światło udzielane jest nam w takim stopniu, w jakim oddajemy się coraz więcej i doskonałej Bogu, przez pokorną uległość i miłość. To nie jest tak, że najpierw widzimy, potem działamy; najpierw działamy, potem widzimy”.

Do sztandarowych bohaterów Polski Ludowej należał Wincenty Pstrowski, członek PPR uznany za wzór przodownika pracy. Pracując jako rębacz w kopalni napisał list otwarty do wszystkich górników, wzywając ich do współzawodnictwa. Pisał między innymi: „Od maja ubiegłego roku pracuję jako rębacz na kopalni ‘Jadwiga’. W lutym br. wykonałem 240 procent normy, wyrąbując 72,5 m chodnika. W kwietniu wykonałem 293 proc., wyrąbując 85 m chodnika. W maju było to już 270 proc., wyrąbując 78 m chodnika”. Odznaczany był najwyższymi orderami przez samego Bieruta. Cena jaką zapłacił za tę rywalizację była przedwczesna śmierć. Nie wiem, czy miał czas zrozumieć, że w życiu nie jest najważniejsza długość wyrąbanego chodnika w kopalni. Dzisiaj nie ogłupiająca propaganda komunistyczna, ale krwiożerczy kapitalizm i chciwość właścicieli, każą oceniać człowieka tylko przez pryzmat ilości wyprodukowanych dóbr materialnych. Zmuszają oni swoich podwładnych do pracy nawet w niedzielę, bo dla nich wartość człowieka mierzy się ilością wykonanej pracy. A przecież niedziela jest potrzebna nie tylko do odpoczynku, ale i do tego, aby przemyśleć, co jest najważniejszym celem, owocem życia. Ostatecznie jednak, każdy osobiście podejmuje decyzję, płacąc nieraz wysoką cenę za „ratowanie swojej duszy”.

Dorothy Bass w książce *Receiving the Day* pisze: „W wielu rodzinach, rodzice układając swoje dziecko do snu pytają jak minął dzień. Dziecko przytulając się do mamy opowiada co działo się w szkole i na placu zabaw. Zaś jedna z matek zadawała swoim dzieciom przed snem inne pytanie: „Gdzie dzisiaj spotkałeś Pana Boga?” Dzieciaki odpowiadały: „W nauczycielu, który życzliwie pomógł mi, w bezdomnym, któremu dałem w parku drobne pieniądze, w pięknie kwitnącym drzewie”. Po czym matka opowiadała o swoim dniu i o sytuacjach, w których doświadczyła obecności Boga. Następnie, wszyscy świadomi obecności Boga w modlitwie kończyli dzień wspólnym odmówieniem pacierza. Przykład ten ukazuje nam, jak na różnych drogach możemy spotykać Boga. Jednak pod warunkiem, że jesteśmy otwarci na nadprzyrodzoną rzeczywistość.

Spotkanie z Bogiem wyzwala nas z niewoli grzechu i innych złych ograniczeń, które uniemożliwiają właściwe owocowanie. Pierwsze czytanie z niedzieli dzisiejszej mówi o ukazaniu się Boga Mojżeszowi w gorejącym krzewie. W czasie tego spotkania Bóg wezwał Mojżesza, aby wyprowadził Naród Wybrany z niewoli egipskiej. Wsparty potężnym dziełami Boga, Mojżesz wyprowadził swój lud z niewoli. Na pamiątkę tego wydarzenia Izraelici obchodzą najważniejsze święta, święta Paschy. Dla nas chrześcijan te wydarzenia były zapowiedzią Wielkanocy, kiedy to świętujemy śmierć i zmartwychwstanie Chrystusa, w którym jest nasze wyzwolenie z niewoli grzechu i śmierci oraz szansa wydania owocu wieczności.

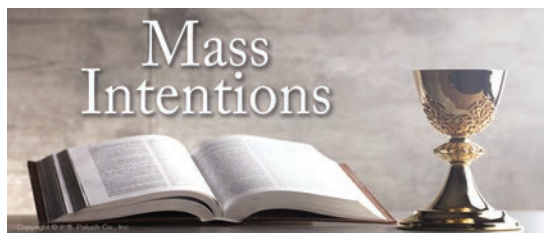

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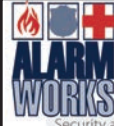


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
