Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! Cradle Catholics would be hard-pressed to remember the day of their baptism. If we're of a certain age, there *may* be a photo of the day we were washed in the waters that united us to the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. (I have one Polaroid photo of my baptism.)

When Vatican Council II revived the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, known in church parlance as RCIA, those who were baptized as babies could now see the excitement, determination, and joy on the faces of adults who were approaching baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. A double grace—for them and for us—as we cradle Catholics could catch their zeal and be renewed in our own faith.

This Easter we will be blessed to celebrate all three Sacraments of Initiation for four adults: Stephen Daniels, Ronald Doiron, Michael Lyman, and Elizabeth Moran. As one of your Lenten prayer practices, please add them to your daily prayer list. And...if you don't already know it, find out the date of your own baptism and be sure to celebrate it. It's the day you were marked for eternal life with God. On this *Laetare* Sunday—Latin for “rejoice”—that's reason for joy.

BIULETYN Parafialny

27 MARCA 2022 - IV NIEDZIELA WIELKIEGO POSTU

Bracia: Jeżeli ktoś pozostaje w Chrystusie, jest nowym stworzeniem. To, co dawne, minęło, a oto wszystko stało się nowe. Wszystko zaś to pochodzi od Boga, który pojednał nas z sobą przez Chrystusa i zlecił nam posługę jednania. Albowiem w Chrystusie Bóg pojednał ze sobą świat, nie poczytując ludziom ich grzechów, nam zaś przekazując słowo pojednania. Tak więc w imieniu Chrystusa spełniamy posłannictwo jakby Boga samego, który przez nas udziela napomnień. W imię Chrystusa prosimy: pojednajcie się z Bogiem. On to dla nas grzechem uczynił Tego, który nie znał grzechu, abyśmy się stali w Nim sprawiedliwością Bożą (2 Kor 5,17-21).



W roku 2000, św. Jan Paweł powiedział do uczestników Kongresu Światowego Towarzystwa Transplantologicznego: „W takim kontekście, bogatym w wartości ludzkie i w miłość, rodzą się także gesty heroiczne. Są one najbardziej uroczystym wysławianiem Ewangelii życia, ponieważ głoszą ją poprzez całkowity dar z siebie; są chwalebnym objawieniem miłości największej, która każe oddać życie za ukochaną osobę; są uczestnictwem w tajemnicy Krzyża, w której Jezus objawia, jak wielką wartość ma dla Niego życie każdego człowieka i jak realizuje się ono w pełni poprzez bezinteresowny dar z siebie. Oprócz faktów powszechnie znanych, istnieje jeszcze heroizm dnia codziennego, na który składają się małe lub wielkie gesty bezinteresowności, umacniające autentyczną kulturę życia. Pośród tych gestów na szczególne uznanie zasługuje oddawanie organów, zgodnie z wymogami etyki, w celu ratowania zdrowia, a nawet życia chorym, pozbawionym niekiedy wszelkiej nadziei (...). Każdy przeszczep narządu ma swoje źródło w decyzji o wielkiej wartości etycznej, decyzji, aby bezinteresownie ofiarować część własnego ciała z myślą o zdrowiu i dobru innego człowieka. Na tym właśnie polega szlachetność tego czynu, który jest autentycznym aktem miłości.”

Philip Yancey w książce *Rumors of Another World: What On Earth Are We Missing?* ukazuje jak w praktyce można to realizować. Opiswane zdarzenie miało miejsce w Południowej Afryce w czasie trwania apartheidu. Oficer van de Broek i jego kolega zastrzelili młodzieńca a później pocięli jego ciało na kawałki i spalili. Kilka lat później schwytali ojca zamordowanego chłopca. Przywiązali go do drewnianego pala, oblali benzyną i podpalili. Oficerowie przymusili żonę ofiary mordu, aby na to wszystko patrzyła. Po upadku apartheidu oficerowie zostali postawieni przed komisją śledczą. Po skończeniu zeznań oficera, członek komisji zwrócił się do żony zamordowanego: „Jakiej kary żąda pani dla van de Broeka?” Kobieta powiedziała, że najpierw chciałaby, aby oficer wskazał jej miejsce śmierci męża, aby mogła zabrać jego prochy i urządzić pogrzeb. Oficer skinął głową na znak, że jest gotowy to uczynić. Następnie kobieta powiedziała: „Pan van de Broek zabrał mi całą rodzinę, a ja mam w sobie jeszcze tak wiele miłości. Chciałabym, aby dwa razy w miesiącu przychodził do naszego getta i spędził cały dzień ze mną, ja będę dla niego matką. Chciałabym, aby pan van de Broek wiedział, że Bóg mu wybaczył, dlatego i ja mu wybaczam. Chciałabym go uścisnąć, aby przekonał się, że moje wybaczenie jest prawdziwe. Van de Broek po usłyszeniu tych słów, zemdłał.

Wybaczenie jest potrzebne dla nas samych, uwalnia nas od trucizny rozgoryczenia. Niech za ilustrację posłuży poniższa historia. Charles Bracelen Flood w książeczce „Lee: The Last Years” opisuje zdarzenie jakie miało miejsce w czasie wojny secesyjnej w Ameryce. Dowódca wojsk Konfederacji, generał Robert E. Lee w czasie wizytacji stanu Kentucky wstąpił do jednego z domów, gdzie właścicielka zaprowadziła go na podwórze i pokazała resztki po olbrzymim drzewie. Ze złością narzekała, że artyleria konfederatów zniszczyła gałęzie i uszkodziła pień pięknego drzewa. Generał ubolewał nad tym co się stało, okazał zrozumienie dla żalu kobiety. A po krótkim milczeniu powiedział: „Niech pani wytnie to drzewo i zapomni o tym”. Lepiej jest wybaczyć niesprawiedliwość niż pozwolić, aby rozgoryczenie zapuściło korzenie trucizny na resztę naszego życia.
