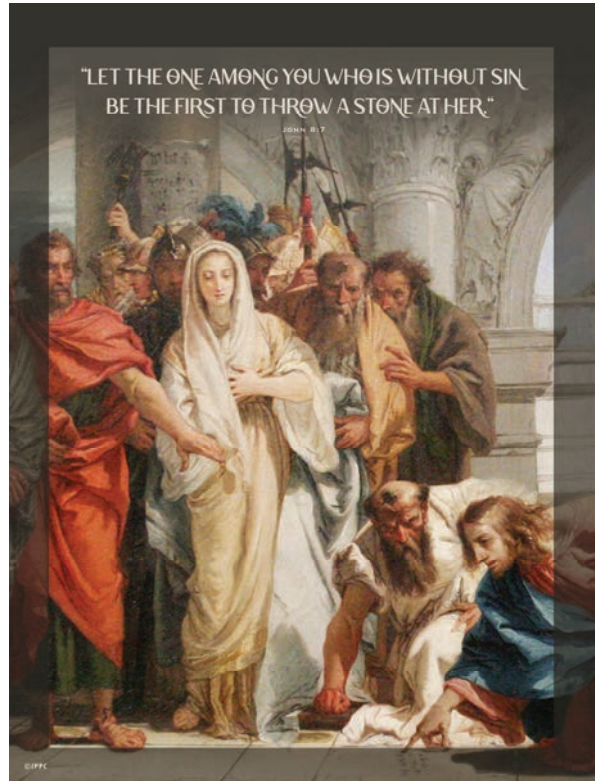

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! I don't know about you, but Lent has flown by for me. Here we are at the Fifth Sunday of Lent, and Palm Sunday is only a week away. How has *your* Lent been? Have you spent that extra time in prayer (personal and communal), gone without the treats you don't really need, and recognized those who have need of your time, presence, or material help? If not, don't give up hope. In fact, God knows that if we had a perfect Lent, we might be tempted to think we achieved it without divine grace—that we did it on our own. As you give thanks for the ways you have come to know God's mercy and love in your life, share the grace and invite someone to confession and Mass this Easter.

3 KWIETNIA 2022 - V NIEDZIELA WIELKIEGO POSTU

Jezus udał się na Górę Oliwną, ale o brzasku zjawiał się znów w świątyni. Wszystek lud schodził się do Niego, a On, usiadłszy, nauczał. Wówczas uczeni w Piśmie i faryzeusze przyprowadzili do Niego kobietę, którą pochwycono na cudzołóstwie, a postawiwszy ją na środku, powiedzieli do Niego: „Nauczycielu, kobietę tę dopiero pochwycono na cudzołóstwie. W Prawie Mojżesz nakazał nam takie kamienować. A Ty co mówisz?”. Mówili to, wystawiając Go na próbę, aby mieli o co Go oskarżyć. Lecz Jezus, nachyliwszy się, pisał palcem po ziemi. A kiedy w dalszym ciągu Go



pytali, podniósł się i rzekł do nich: „Kto z was jest bez grzechu, niech pierwszy rzuci na nią kamień”. I powtórnie nachyliwszy się, pisał na ziemi. Kiedy to usłyszeli, wszyscy jeden po drugim zaczęli odchodzić, poczynając od starszych. Pozostał tylko Jezus i kobieta, stojąca na środku. Wówczas Jezus, podniósłszy się, rzekł do niej: „Niewiasto, gdzież oni są? Nikt cię nie potępił?”. A ona odrzekła: „Nikt, Panie!”. Rzekł do niej Jezus: „I Ja ciebie nie potępiam. – Idź, a od tej chwili już nie grzesz” (J 8,1-11).

Wieczorem ósmego dnia Święta Namiotów Jezus udał się na Górę Oliwną i spędził tam noc na modlitwie. Rano, zanim wzeszło słońce powrócił do świątyni i zaczął nauczać zgromadzone tłumy. Wtedy uczeni w Prawie i faryzeusze przyprowadzili kobietę przyłapaną na cudzołóstwie. Jednak wbrew pozorom to nie cudzołóstwo stało się dominującym motywem tej sceny ewangelicznej. Faryzeusze i uczeni w Piśmie bardziej byli zainteresowani wykorzystaniem zaistniałej sytuacji dla własnych interesów niż troską o stan moralny bliźniego. Chcieli użyć tej sytuacji przeciw Jezusowi. Według nich nadarzyła się doskonała sposobność zastawienia na Jezusa pułapki.

Do Napoleona przysłała matka, aby błagać o łaskę dla swego syna, który dopuścił się bardzo poważnego przestępstwa. Prawo w tym wypadku było dosyć jasne. Kara śmierci. Cesarz był zdecydowany, aby sprawiedliwości stało się zadość. Ale matka nie ustawała w błaganiach: „Wasza cesarska mość, przybyłam tu, aby błagać o miłosierdzie a nie o sprawiedliwość.” „Ale on nie zasługuje na miłosierdzie” – odpowiada Napoleon. „Nie byłoby miłosierdzia, gdyby się na nie zasługiwało” – mówi zrozpaczona matka. „Niech tak będzie. Będę miał miłosierdzie dla twojego syna” – kończy Napoleon.

Konfesjonał ojca Rafała zawsze był oblegany przez wiernych. Zaś w okresie Adwentu i Wielkiego Postu wierni stali już od świtu przed bramą kościoła karmelitów, aby zająć miejsce w kolejce do jego konfesjonału. Penitenci przystępowali do kratek z uszanowaniem i pewnym lękiem z powodu świętości i sławy ojca Rafała. Pierwsze słowa spowiednika rozpraszały lęk i rodziły zaufanie, miłość i nadzieję. Ojciec Rafał okazywał każdemu głębokie zrozumienie i współczucie. Jakby obejmował swymi ramionami cierpiącą i zaleknioną duszę penitenta. Do każdego zwracał się słowami pełnymi ciepła i serdeczności: „Dziecko moje!” Wielu doświadczało w konfesjonale nawrócenia, przemiany wewnętrznej i odchodziło ze łzami wdzięczności w oczach. W swej dobroci i miłosierdziu ojciec Rafał naśladował swego mistrza Jezusa Chrystusa. W konfesjonale wypełniała się ewangeliczna scena z jawno grzesznicą Magdaleną, którą przyprowadzono do Jezusa, aby ją potępił. A Jezus z miłością podniósł ją i powiedział: „I Ja ciebie nie potępiam. Idź, a od tej chwili już nie grzesz”.

Jeśli bić się w piersi- to we własne, a nie cudze. Oczywiście, bicie się w cudze piersi jest wygodniejsze tylko, że nie jest to droga do przemiany siebie i świata

PARISH COUNCIL IS LOOKING FOR NEW MEMBERS!

This year, four of our member's terms of office are drawing to an end and we are looking for new members to fill out the Council. Nomination process will be complete by May 1 and final selection will occur at the May 16 Parish Council Meeting.

The Parish Council is a consultative body Number range CHAPTER (Canon 536, par. 2), which assists the Pastor in his leadership role as shepherd of the Parish. The Parish Council represents the interests and needs of the entire Parish community. The term of office is three years, beginning in September and ending in August.

Qualities we look for in members include:

- Desire to serve the Parish Family.
- Willingness to work with the Pastor
- Ability to work in a group process of prayer, planning and consensus
- Desire to foster the teachings of the Church.
- Commitment to attend meetings and to prepare sufficiently for them.
- Required to serve on at least two of the standing committees of the PPC or Ministry Groups once elected.



The selection process for new members is as follows:

- Parishioners will be invited to submit their own names or the names of others for consideration. The Nominating Committee will also submit names, thus ensuring that there are a sufficient number of candidates to fill the vacancies on the PC.
- All those whose names have been submitted will be reviewed and a member of the Nominating Committee will contact qualified individuals to discuss the nature, purpose & functions of the PC. Those who wish to continue in the selection process will be invited to meet with the full Nominating Committee to further discern their interest.
- The final list of qualified Nominees will be prepared by the Nominating Committee and presented to the PC for their consideration. The PC will then approve the list of Nominees to be seated for the next council year.
