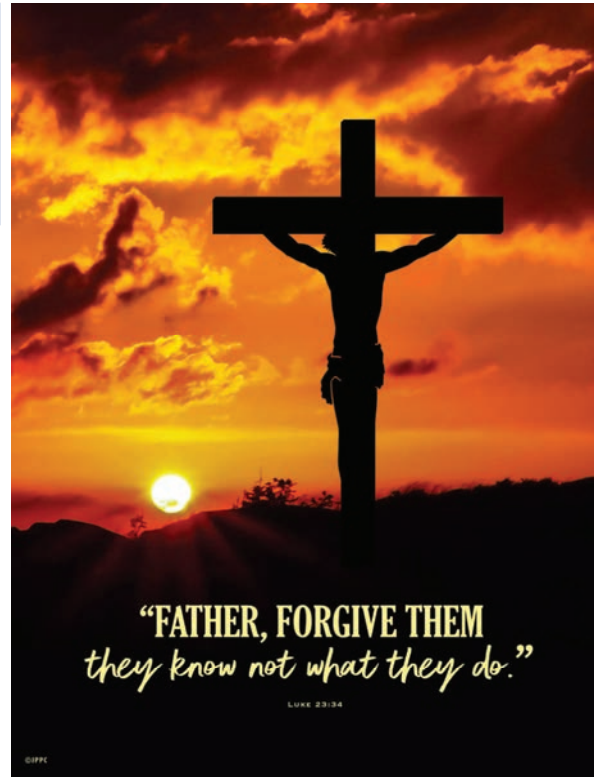

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! In the spring of 1999, I was blessed to have a semester of study in Israel as I was finishing a degree in Sacred Scripture. The timing of that semester enabled me to participate in the Palm Sunday procession where the very first one took place. In Jerusalem thousands of Christians, primarily Palestinian Christians, walk down the Mount of Olives, across the Kidron Valley, and through the gates of Jerusalem to commemorate what we celebrate today throughout the Christian world. Israeli soldiers keep careful watch from the city walls to be sure everyone stays peaceful and orderly. The atmosphere is electric, however, as the crowds carry olive branches and sing at the top of their lungs in both Latin and Arabic. I will never forget that experience.

Imagine yourself in that first crowd that sang “hosanna” to this mesmerizing rabbi named Jesus. Would this be the one, they thought, who would liberate them from the Romans and set up a perfect kingdom on earth? They soon realized that Jesus wanted to establish something more eternal and lasting than any political, earthly reality, and so only a few days later, those same crowds would shout, “Crucify him!” We, however, know the end of the story. It is a story that ends in eternal life. Let’s walk with Jesus this week through our own sufferings joined to his so that we can celebrate one day that life that never ends. Have a blessed Holy Week!

BIULETYN Parafialny

10 KWIETNIA 2022 - NIEDZIELA PALMOWA

Pan Bóg mnie obdarzył językiem wymownym, bym umiał przyjść z pomocą strudzonemu przez słowo krzepiące. Każdego rana pobudza me ucho, bym słuchał jak uczniowie. Pan Bóg otworzył mi ucho, a ja się nie oparłem ani się nie cofnąłem. Podałem grzbiet mój bijącym i policzki moje rwącym mi brodę. Nie zasłoniłem mej twarzy przed zniewagami i opluciem. Pan Bóg mnie wspomaga, dlatego jestem nieczuły na obelgi, dlatego uczyniłem twarz moją jak głaz i wiem, że wstydu nie doznam (Iz 50,4-7).



Siostra Bernardyna umierała w wielkich cierpieniach. Jej ciało pokryły bolesne wrzody. Lekarze robili wszystko, co w ich mocy, aby ulżyć chorej, ale byli bezradni wobec tajemniczych objawów choroby. Po latach spowiednik Siostry Bernardyny, ks. Józef Matlak powiedział, że były to cierpienia wyproszone przez nią samą. „Kiedyś w młodości, w pierwszych latach swego zakonnego życia na widok nędzy przychodzącej do albertyńskiej furty, modliła się do Boga, by na nią zesłał wszelkie cierpienia ciała i duszy, najgorsze, najwyszukańsze, aby tylko ulżyć tej nędzy. A ponieważ najokropniejsze wydawały się jej wrzody, prosiła gorąco, by ją nimi obsypał. Bóg jakby się namyślał wreszcie wysłuchał prośb tej ukochanej duszy. Obsypał ją wrzodami bez liku, jak gdyby bez litości, przez które wyciekło jej życie. Przypominała sobie w chorobie ową łaskę. Dziwili się wszyscy, patrząc na jej bolesne rany jak na dopust Boży, nie dziwiła się tylko ona, uśmiechając się dziwnie tajemniczo a radośnie, bo Bóg był dla niej tak łaskawy i dobry. Niech mi wybaczysz, że ośmieliłem się wyjawiać przed wami tę tajemnicę, a zarazem zagadkę jej spokoju i zadowolenia”. Sens takiego cierpienia i jego moc zbawczą może pojąć tylko ten, kto zawierzy swoje życie Chrystusowi cierpiącemu, który przez swoją mękę, śmierć i zmartwychwstanie otworzył dla nas bramy wieczności.

Ks. kanonika Andrzeja Kurowskiego koledzy kapłani nazywają żartobliwie „żydowskim proboszczem”. A to za sprawą miejsca, w którym pełni posługę duszpasterską. Jest bowiem proboszczem parafii św. Franciszki de Chantal w Borough Park na Brooklynie. Jest to dzielnica w zdecydowanej większości zamieszkała przez ortodoksyjnych Żydów, których możemy „spotkać” na różnych uroczystościach kościelnych. I to dzięki temu „uczestnictwu” niektóre nabożeństwa kościelne nabierają szczególnego kolorytu i znaczenia. Zapewne należy do nich Droga krzyżowa, która jest odprawiana na ulicach tej dzielnicy wieczorem w Wielki Piątek. Bogata i piękna inscenizacja tego nabożeństwa jest wzruszającym przeżyciem, które pomaga wiernym odkrywać głębię bożej Miłości rozpiętej na krzyżu Golgoty. Gdy uczestnicy Drogi krzyżowej idą ulicami towarzyszy im zaciekawione spojrzenie wyznawców religii mojżeszowej. Jedni zatrzymują się na chodniku, inni wyglądają z zapłotu, a jeszcze inni oglądają Drogę krzyżową z okien lub balkonów. Ta niezwykła sceneria przenosi nas do Jerozolimy, gdzie wąskimi uliczkami wspinał się Jezus, dźwigając na ramionach ciężki krzyż.

Na wzór św. Teresy od Dzieciątka Jezus, módlmy się do Boga słowami jej „Aktu ofiarowania się miłosiernej miłości”: „Dziękuję Ci, o mój Boże! za wszystkie łaski, jakimi mnie obdarzyłeś, a szczególnie za to, że mnie przeprowadziłeś przez próbę cierpienia. W dniu ostatecznym z radością będę patrzyła na Ciebie trzymającego berło Krzyża; skoro raczyłeś podzielić się ze mną tym drogocennym Krzyżem, ufam, że w Niebie będę podobna do Ciebie i na moim uwielbionym ciele ujrzę jaśniejące chwałą święte stygmaty Twej Męki. Nie chcę jednak zbierać zasług, chcę pracować jedynie z Miłości ku Tobie, tylko w tym celu, by sprawić Ci radość, pocieszać Twoje Najświętsze Serce i ratować dusze, które będą Cię kochać przez całą wieczność. Pod wieczór życia stanę przed Tobą z pustymi rękoma, bo nie proszę Cię, Panie, byś liczył moje uczynki. Pragnę więc przyodziać się Twoją własną Sprawiedliwością i jako dar Twojej Miłości otrzymać wieczne posiadania Ciebie samego”

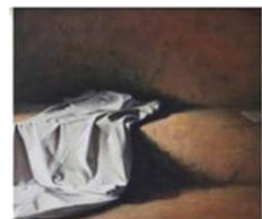

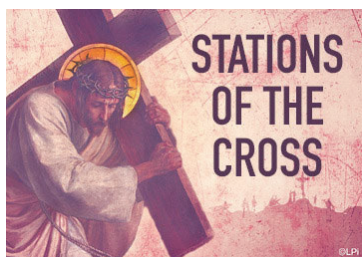

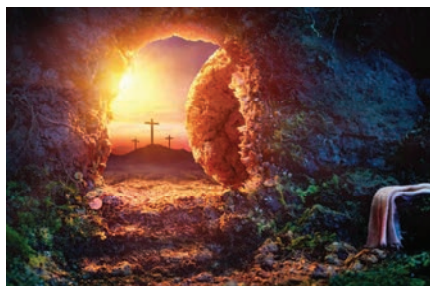

PARISH COUNCIL IS LOOKING FOR NEW MEMBERS!

This year, four of our member's terms of office are drawing to an end and we are looking for new members to fill out the Council. Nomination process will be complete by May 1 and final selection will occur at the May 16 Parish Council Meeting.

The Parish Council is a consultative body Number range CHAPTER (Canon 536, par. 2), which assists the Pastor in his leadership role as shepherd of the Parish. The Parish Council represents the interests and needs of the entire Parish community. The term of office is three years, beginning in September and ending in August.

Qualities we look for in members include:

- Desire to serve the Parish Family.
- Willingness to work with the Pastor
- Ability to work in a group process of prayer, planning and consensus
- Desire to foster the teachings of the Church.
- Commitment to attend meetings and to prepare sufficiently for them.
- Required to serve on at least two of the standing committees of the PPC or Ministry Groups once elected.



The selection process for new members is as follows:

- Parishioners will be invited to submit their own names or the names of others for consideration. The Nominating Committee will also submit names, thus ensuring that there are a sufficient number of candidates to fill the vacancies on the PC.
- All those whose names have been submitted will be reviewed and a member of the Nominating Committee will contact qualified individuals to discuss the nature, purpose & functions of the PC. Those who wish to continue in the selection process will be invited to meet with the full Nominating Committee to further discern their interest.
- The final list of qualified Nominees will be prepared by the Nominating Committee and presented to the PC for their consideration. The PC will then approve the list of Nominees to be seated for the next council year.

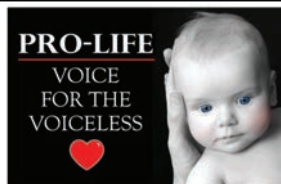

“Worship of the Eucharist. In the liturgy of the Mass we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine by, among other ways, genuflecting or bowing deeply as a sign of adoration of the Lord. The Catholic Church has always offered and still offers to the sacrament of the Eucharist the cult of adoration, not only during Mass, but also outside of it, reserving the consecrated hosts with the utmost care, exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and carrying them in procession. (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1378)

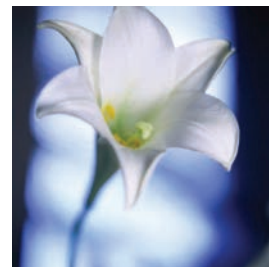

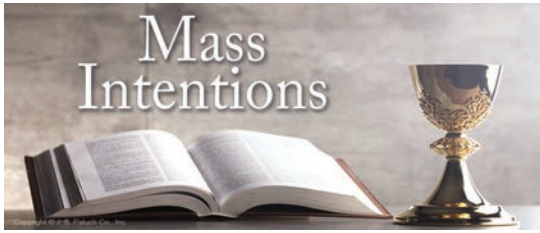
