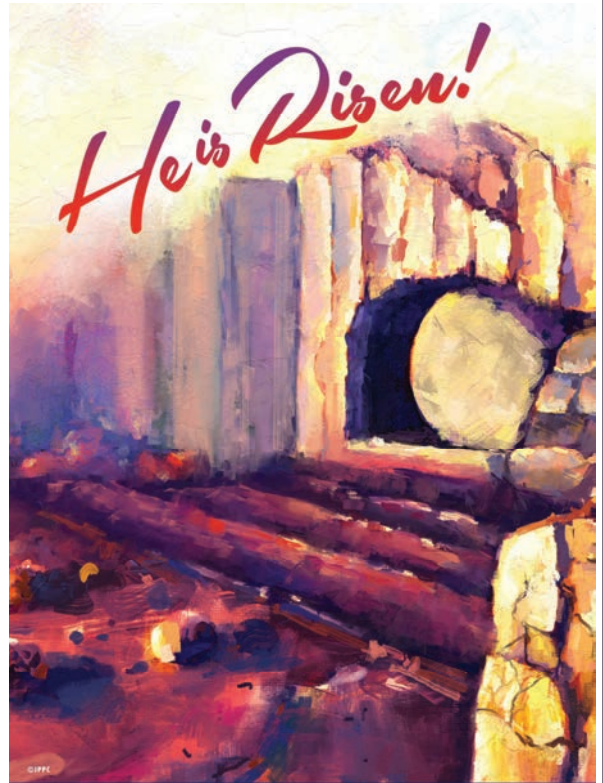

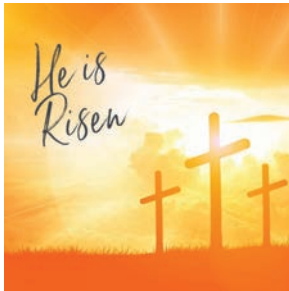

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Grief wounds our hearts in ways that leave permanent marks. Most often the wounds heal over time, but a memory or comment or photo can brush up against the scars and make us wince. These past days have been particularly heavy for our St. Stanislaus family as we mourn the passing of Agnes Olbrys, our lifelong parishioner and faithful volunteer, employee, and listening ear for almost 40 years. The grief will stay with us and manifest itself in different ways for each of us who knew her.



On this Easter Sunday, coinciding with a time of great loss, we need to renew our faith in what Easter is all about. The first disciples (except for St. John) ran from the cross and feared that the humiliating execution of their Master and Teacher would be followed soon by their own. Their grief, made messier when mingled with their own self-centered fears and remorse over their abandonment of Jesus in his hour of need, probably seemed like a deep wound that would never be healed. Then something happened.... The Risen Jesus appeared to them with his healed wounds, sat at table with them, and promised them deep peace, forgiveness, and a life one day in which mourning would have no place. Total life—no death. That's what we celebrate today and for 50 days hereafter.

Whether you're just visiting this weekend or here every Sunday, may you always find in the Eucharist, the very Presence of the crucified and risen Christ, your Easter hope renewed and your faith strengthened. If you're not a regular churchgoer, come back. Your eternal life depends on it.

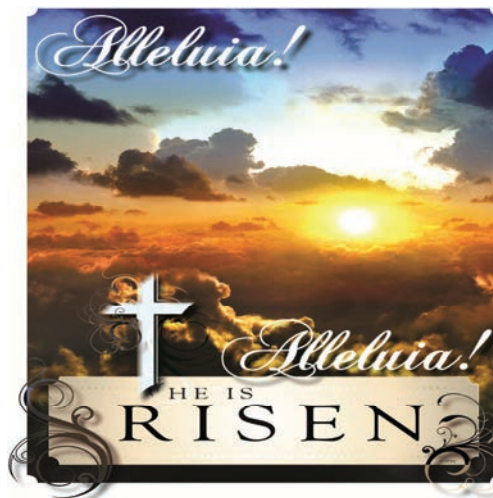

9-DAY DIVINE MERCY NOVENA - Please join us for a 9-day Divine Mercy Novena which began on Good Friday, April 15, and will end on Saturday, April 23. As is our tradition at the Basilica, the Friends of Divine Mercy will continue to recite the Novena at Noon on Saturday, April 16, in the Upper Basilica, on your own on Easter Sunday, after the 9:00 a.m. Mass on April 18, after the Noon Mass in the Lower Basilica Tuesday through Friday, and at Noon on Saturday, April 23. Novena Pamphlets will be available. Please join us and bring a friend!

THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY will be celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. Mass on April 24, the first Sunday after Easter, which is called the Divine Mercy Sunday. Confessions will be heard from Noon to 1:00 p.m., followed by Recitation of the Rosary at 1:00 p.m., and Mass celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. On the day of Sister Faustina's canonization, April 30th, 2000, Pope John Paul II instituted the feast for the whole Church. The institution of the feast was inspired by a desire of Jesus which was conveyed by Sister Faustina. The Lord Jesus told her: *I desire that the*

first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy (Diary 299). I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened (Diary 699).

BIULETYN Parafialny

17 KWIETNIA 2022 - WIELKANOC



Pierwszego dnia po szabacie, wczesnym rankiem, gdy jeszcze było ciemno, Maria Magdalena udała się do grobu i zobaczyła kamień odsunięty od grobu. Pobiegła więc i przybyła do Szymona Piotra i do drugiego ucznia, którego Jezus miłował, i rzekła do nich: „Zabrano Pana z grobu i nie wiemy, gdzie Go położono”. Wyszedł więc Piotr i ów drugi uczeń i szli do grobu. Biegli oni obydwoj razem, lecz ów drugi uczeń wyprzedził Piotra i przybył pierwszy do grobu. A kiedy się nachylił, zobaczył leżące płótna, jednakże nie wszedł do środka. Nadszedł potem także Szymon Piotr, idący za nim. Wszedł on do wnętrza grobu i ujrzał

leżące płótna oraz chustę, która była na Jego głowie, leżącą nie razem z płótnami, ale oddzielnie zwiniętą na jednym miejscu. Wtedy wszedł do wnętrza także i ów drugi uczeń, który przybył pierwszy do grobu. Ujrzał i uwierzył. Dotąd bowiem nie rozumieli jeszcze Pisma, które mówi, że On ma powstać z martwych (J 20,1-9).

W czasie agonii Brat Albert utracił przytomność, wtedy lekarz, aby ulżyć choremu polecił przenieść go na miękkie łóżko. Jednak po odzyskaniu świadomości chory stanowczo zażądał, aby położono go z powrotem na twardym drewnianym tapczanie, przy wnoszeniu którego obłamano dwie nogi, dlatego bracia podłożyli starą skrzynkę od węgla. Brat Albert na widok tego ubóstwa, uśmiechając się, powiedział: „O, teraz mi dobrze”. Wieczorem 23 grudnia 1916 r. nastąpiło pogorszenie. Chory kilkakrotnie tracił z bólu przytomność. Pokonując ogromne cierpienie Brat Albert z wysiłkiem udzielił jeszcze ostatnich rad Siostrze Bernardynie. W niedzielę 24 grudnia Brat Albert przyjął Wiatyk i ucałował krzyż podany przez spowiednika. Potem usiadł na posłaniu i spoglądając z wielką miłością na zebranych pobłogosławił ich, kreśląc nad nimi wielki znak krzyża św. Pobłogosławił również nieobecnych braci i siostry i tych, którzy w przyszłości będą w zgromadzeniach albertyńskich, a także ubogich i sieroty znajdujące się w przytuliskach. Wszyscy byli świadomi, że jest to ostatnie pożegnanie, że opuszcza ich święty, który był dla nich ojcem i przewodnikiem. Trudno było powstrzymać się od łez. Brat Albert widząc to z całą mocą swojego głosu powiedział: „Co tu płakać!? Z wolą Bożą macie się zgadzać i za wszystko Bogu dziękować! Tak jest! Trzeba Bogu dziękować za chorobę i za śmierć, jak ją zsyła. Zmówić trzeba Magnificat! Co Bóg ześle trzeba Mu za wszystko dziękować. Bo co Bóg działa, święte jest i dobre”. W burzliwych kolejach losu Brat Albert coraz pełniej odkrywał swego Zbawcę i naśladował Go w praktykowaniu heroicznej miłości. Wszystko oddał dla najbardziej potrzebujących. Dlatego z tak wielką pogodą ducha, nadzieją i radością przyjmował śmierć, która w blaskach pustego grobu Jezusa stawała się dla niego bramą prowadzącą do szczęśliwej wieczności.

Wierzmy w Chrystusa, a zatem radujmy się i śpiewajmy, miłością i życzliwością wypełniamy każdą minutę naszego życia, a wtedy nasze radosne Alleluja przebieje niebo i dotrze do samego Boga

Z wielkim smutkiem zawiadamiamy o śmierci wieloletniej pracownicy naszego biura parafialnego Pani Agnes Olbrys. Na zawsze pozostanie w naszej pamięci jako życzliwa, wspaniała Osoba, zawsze pomagająca wszystkim i wszędzie, w każdej organizacji parafialnej. Rodzinie i wszystkim bliskim którzy mieli z nią kontakt składamy wyrazy głębokiego współczucia.



Z okazji Świąt Wielkanocnych pragniemy złożyć wszystkim parafianom i tym którzy modlą się w naszym Kościele, serdeczne życzenia by Zmartwychwstały Chrystus obdarzał Was pokojem, zdrowiem i radością, udzielał potrzebnych łask, wnosił szczęście do każdego domu i sprawiał, by w Waszym życiu zawsze zwyciężały miłość i nadzieja i byśmy mieli odwagę zawsze trwać wiernie w naszej wspólnotie Parafialnej. PARISH COUNCIL IS LOOKING FOR NEW MEMBERS!

This year, four of our member's terms of office are drawing to an end and we are looking for new members to fill out the Council. Nomination process will be complete by May 1 and final selection will occur at the May 16 Parish Council Meeting.

The Parish Council is a consultative body Number range CHAPTER (Canon 536, par. 2), which assists the Pastor in his leadership role as shepherd of the Parish. The Parish Council represents the interests and needs of the entire Parish community. The term of office is three years, beginning in September and ending in August.

Qualities we look for in members include:

- Desire to serve the Parish Family.
- Willingness to work with the Pastor
- Ability to work in a group process of prayer, planning and consensus
- Desire to foster the teachings of the Church.
- Commitment to attend meetings and to prepare sufficiently for them.
- Required to serve on at least two of the standing committees of the PPC or Ministry Groups once elected.



The selection process for new members is as follows:

- Parishioners will be invited to submit their own names or the names of others for consideration. The Nominating Committee will also submit names, thus ensuring that there are a sufficient number of candidates to fill the vacancies on the PC.
- All those whose names have been submitted will be reviewed and a member of the Nominating Committee will contact qualified individuals to discuss the nature, purpose & functions of the PC. Those who wish to continue in the selection process will be invited to meet with the full Nominating Committee to further discern their interest.
- The final list of qualified Nominees will be prepared by the Nominating Committee and presented to the PC for their consideration. The PC will then approve the list of Nominees to be seated for the next council year.

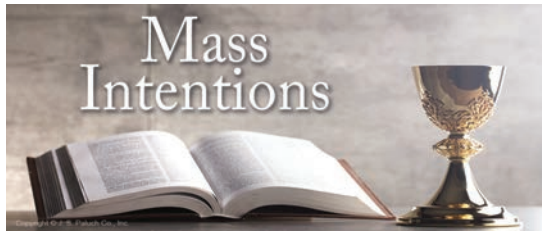

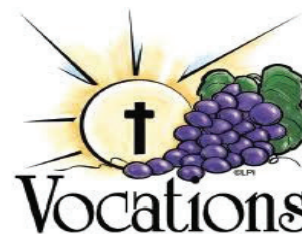

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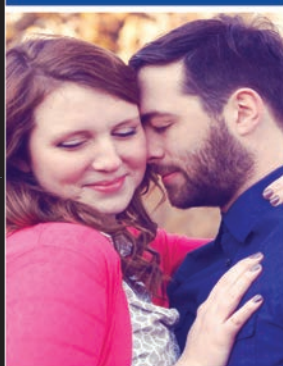
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
