Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things to you! The Scripture readings during the Easter season challenge us to place front and center in our lives certain key aspects of our life in Christ, our daily routine as baptized Catholic Christians. The words of today's gospel are so familiar that we might easily miss how earth-shattering they are. Jesus says: "I give you a new commandment: love one another." Raising the stakes, he adds: "as I have loved you."

If we have drunk in too much of our secularized culture, we can identify love more as a *feeling* I have toward someone else. My degree of love for another depends on how I feel toward that person. You can readily see the clash of cultures here: Christian love has little or nothing to do with how I feel about the other person. Jesus quite clearly says, "I command you...love...." A love that loves until death.

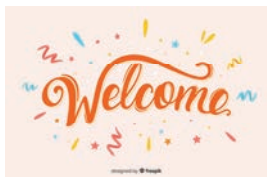
How challenging that is these days, even for committed Christians! How do I love the one who is spewing hate toward me or the faith that sustains me? How do I choose to obey the command to love when I'm met time after time with indifference? Jesus makes it clear that obeying the command to love doesn't depend on how the other person may or may not respond. Each time we make the choice to love as Jesus loves, we cooperate with him in making all things new.

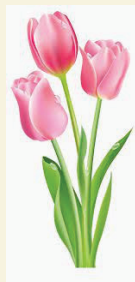

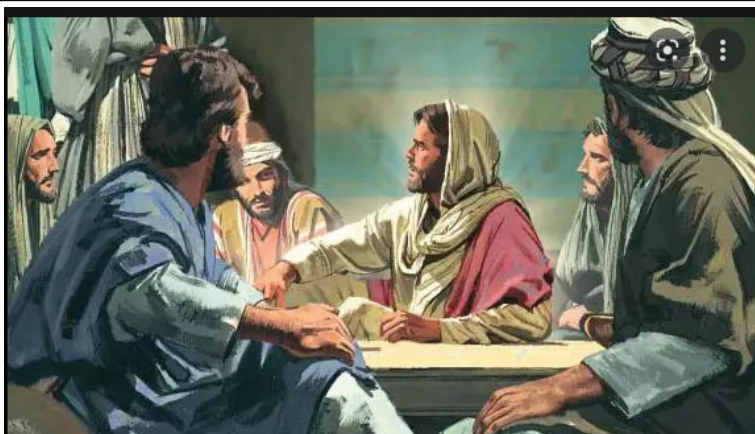

V NIEDZIELA WIELKANOCNA

Po wyjściu Judasza z wieczernika Jezus powiedział: „Syn Człowieczy został teraz uwielbiony, a w Nim został Bóg uwielbiony. Jeżeli Bóg został w Nim uwielbiony, to Bóg uwielbi Go także w sobie samym i zaraz Go uwielbi. Dzieci, jeszcze krótko – jestem z wami. Będziecie Mnie szukać, ale – jak to Żydom powiedziałem, tak i teraz wam mówię – dokąd Ja idę, wy pójść nie możecie. Daję wam przykazanie nowe, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali, tak jak Ja was umiłowałem; żebyście i wy tak się miłowali wzajemnie. Po tym wszyscy poznają, żeście uczniami moimi, jeśli będziecie się wzajemnie miłowali” (J 13,31-33a.34.35).



23 września 1973 r. w czasie modlitwy Anioł Pański, papież Paweł VI powiedział: „Jest to matka, z diecezji mediolańskiej, która chcąc dać życie swojemu dziecku, świadomie złożyła w ofierze własne”. Prawie dwadzieścia jeden lat później, 24 kwietnia 1994 roku w czasie Mszy św. na placu Św. Piotra Jan Paweł II ogłosił Giannę Berettę Molla błogosławioną. Miłość, do której wzywa nas Chrystus przybiera w życiu różny kształt. Dziś chcę opowiedzieć o miłości matczynej, której nie da się porównać z żadną inną. Świadom niedostatku słów w jej wyrażeniu, napiszę o życiu Gianny Molla, które jest najpiękniejszą opowieścią o matczynej miłości.

Nagrodzony Oscarem film Pawła Pawlikowskiego „Ida” wzbudził w polonijnym środowisku wiele skrajnych emocji. Po jednej z prezentacji tego filmu w Nowym Jorku, ktoś zapytał mnie, co o tym sędzę. Obejrzałem ten film i mam swoje zdanie na ten temat. Ale nim do tego przejdę przytoczę opinię dr Stanisława Śliwowskiego, prezesa Kongresu Polonii Amerykańskiej, oddziału New Jersey, który uważa, że jest to film „zdecydowanie antypolski, skierowany przeciwko nam”: „Jak można zrobić film o holokauście bez Niemców! A to taki właśnie film. Nie dziwię się, że Niemcy dają mu nagrody, bo im taki film jest na rękę.

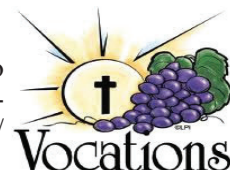

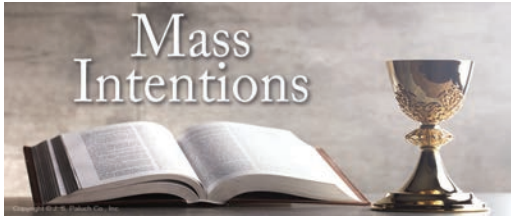

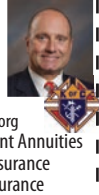
