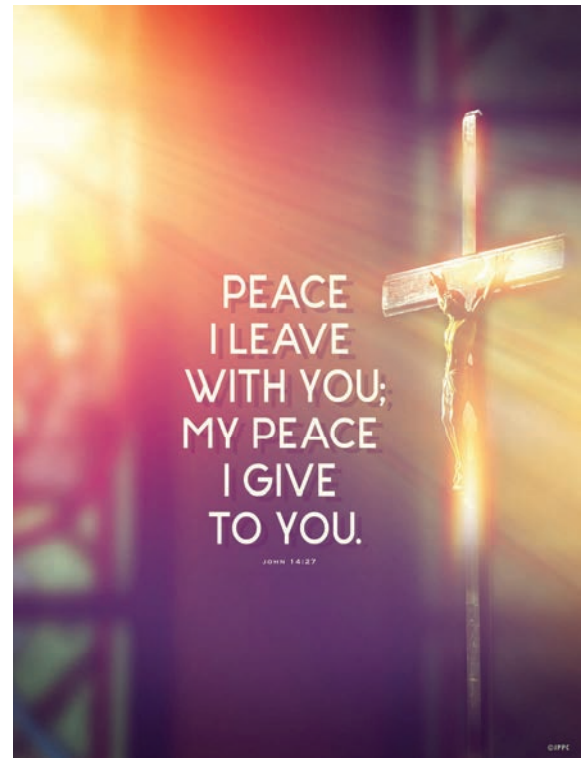

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things! The other friars and I humbly ask your prayers for the Holy Spirit's gifts to come upon the first session of our provincial chapter, to be held May 23 – 27 in Baltimore, Maryland. St. Francis of Assisi adopted the monks' tradition of the "chapter" as a way for the friars to come together, encourage one another, and make necessary decisions to deal with challenges and chart the future. Consequently, we have chapters on the friary level (monthly), provincial level (every four years), and general level for the whole Order (every six years). This week the elected delegates to the provincial chapter of the Our Lady of the Angels Province will come together to install a new Minister Provincial and vote on various offices of leadership in OLA Province.

Our new Minister Provincial, Fr. Michael Heine, was elected by mail ballot in February and will officially take office this week. Between this session and the second one in July (11 – 15) is when final decisions are made regarding friars' assignments and the nomination of local superiors ("guardians" in the friars' tradition) for each friary.

As it turns out, the Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph and the Franciscan Missionary Sisters of Assisi also hold their chapters this summer. I know they too would appreciate your fervent prayers for the Spirit to work in and among them for the good of the Church. St. Francis, St. Clare, and all the holy men and women of the Franciscan family, pray for us!

VI NIEDZIELA WIELKANOCNA



Jezus powiedział do swoich uczniów: „Jeśli Mnie kto miłuje, będzie zachowywał moją naukę, a Ojciec mój umiłuje go, i przyjdziemy do niego, i będziemy w nim przebywać. Kto Mnie nie miłuje, ten nie zachowuje słów moich. A nauka, którą słyszycie, nie jest moja, ale Tego, który Mnie posłał, Ojca. To wam powiedziałem przebywając wśród was. A Poczyszyciel, Duch Święty, którego Ojciec pośle w moim imieniu, On was wszystkiego nauczy i przypomni wam wszystko, co wam powiedziałem. Pokój zostawiam wam, pokój mój daję wam. Nie tak jak daje świat. Ja wam daję. Niech się nie trwoży serce wasze ani się nie lęka. Słyszeliście, że wam powiedziałem: Odchodzę i przyjdę znowu do was. Gdybyście Mnie miłowali, rozradowalibyście się, że idę do Ojca, bo Ojciec większy jest ode Mnie. A teraz powiedziałem wam o tym, zanim to nastąpi, abyście uwierzyli, gdy się to stanie” (J 14,23-29).

Marcin spotkał Roberta w samolocie, lecącym do Nowego Jorku. Obydwaj po raz pierwszy wybierali się do Stanów Zjednoczonych. Robert zostawił w Polsce żonę i dwójkę dzieci. W Nowym Jorku mieszkała jego siostra z rodziną. Miał zatem gdzie zamieszkać. Zapewne dlatego miał lepszy humor niż Marcin, który leciał tutaj na fikcyjne zaproszenie i miał tylko słowne zapewnienie, dalekiego znajomego, że pomoże mu w załatwieniu mieszkania i pracy. Zdecydował się na ten wyjazd z tych samych powodów jak wielu innych; chciał trochę zarobić i wrócić do żony i syna. W samolocie, po opróżnieniu kilku lotowskich buteleczek z alkoholem stali się weselsi, a na lotnisku rozstawali się jak dobrzy przyjaciele. Na pożegnanie Marcin powiedział: „Może się jeszcze zobaczymy”.

5 listopada 2000 roku, w czasie rozważań przed modlitwą Anioł Pański papież Jan Paweł II powiedział: „Przed końcowym błogosławieństwem pragnę podziękować wszystkim, którzy przyczynili się do przygotowania tego jubileuszowego spotkania. Wszystkich raz jeszcze zachęcam, aby starali się pogłębiać i szerzyć wiedzę o świętym Tomasz Morusie, nowym patronie rządzących i polityków. Wybór tej postaci jest naprawdę niezwykle trafny: Tomasz Morus wyrażał bowiem w pełni swą chrześcijańską tożsamość żyjąc w świecie – jako mąż, przykładny ojciec i światły mąż stanu. Ten człowiek o nieskazitelnej postawie moralnej, aby dochować wierności Bogu i własnemu sumieniu, wyrzekł się wszystkiego: zaszczytów, więzi rodzinnych, nawet samego życia. Zyskał jednak dobro najcenniejsze – Królestwo Niebieskie i stamtąd czuwa nad tymi, którzy służą ofiarnie ludzkiej rodzinie, pracując w instytucjach państwowych i politycznych”.

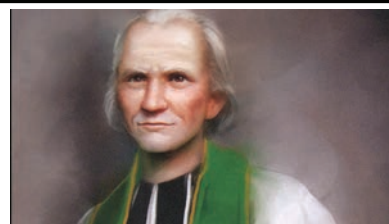

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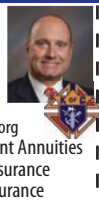
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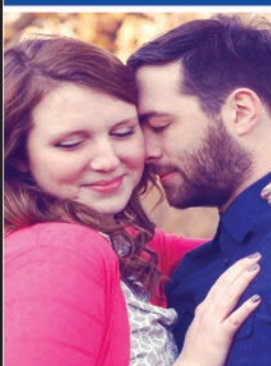
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
