Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! If you're like me, you've probably heard more than one homily on Trinity Sunday start out like this: "The Holy Trinity is such a deep mystery that we'll never understand it, so I'm going to speak about [x, y, or z] instead...." Such an opening line betrays among other things a negative understanding of *mystery*, i.e., something that I can't figure out. As many saints and theologians have reminded us, however, the religious understanding of *mystery* is positive: something so full of meaning that I can never exhaust it. I will always learn something new about the mysteries of our faith, the mystery of who God is, especially when I go to pray.

The Trinity reflects the heart of who we are as Christians. To be a Christian means that we believe God to be One in a community of Three Persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—and that the Second Person of the Trinity became flesh—Jesus Christ. This goes beyond the simple monotheism of Judaism or Islam, i.e., belief in one God. "God" for us Christians is *essentially* Trinitarian, a community of divine Persons. At each Mass and during the liturgy in general, our prayers are offered to the Father, *through* the Son, and *in* the Holy Spirit. We are in the Trinity, and the Trinity dwells in us. Take *that* to prayer.... That's enough mystery for a lifetime, and then some.

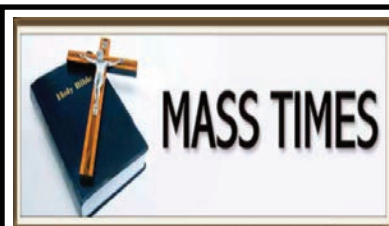

12 CZERWCA 2022 - UROCZYSTOŚĆ TRÓJCY PRZENAJŚWIETSZEJ



Jezus powiedział swoim uczniom: Jeszcze wiele mam wam do powiedzenia, ale teraz [jeszcze] znieść nie możecie. Gdy zaś przyjdzie On, Duch Prawdy, doprowadzi was do całej prawdy. Bo nie będzie mówił od siebie, ale powie wszystko, cokolwiek usłyszycie, i oznajmi wam rzeczy przyszłe. On Mnie otoczy chwałą, ponieważ z mojego weźmie i wam objawi. Wszystko, co ma Ojciec, jest moje. Dlatego powiedziałem, że z mojego weźmie i wam objawi (J 16,12-15).

IV wiek w dziejach Kościoła znany jest jako wiek wielkich herezji i wielkich obrońców Kościoła oraz wiek krystalizowania się niektórych dogmatów wiary, w tym dogmatu Trójcy Przenajświętszej. Święty Atanazy należał do najwybitniejszych postaci tamtych czasów. Nadano mu tytuł Wielki i uważano go za prawdziwą kolumnę Kościoła. Atanazy nieustraszenie i skutecznie walczył z herezjami: gnostycyzmu, manicheizmu oraz najgroźniejszą z nich – arianizmem. Arianie głosili, że Syn Boży jest niższy od Ojca co do natury, bo jest tylko stworzeniem, a zatem nie jest równy Ojcu. Atanazy stając w obronie bóstwa Chrystusa stworzył przesłanki do dalszego rozwoju dogmatu Trójcy Świętej. W oparciu o tę naukę Ojcowie Kapadocy przybliżyli zrozumienie Trójcy Świętej i wykrystalizowali teologię trynitarną.

Oto fragment nauki św. Atanazego o tajemnicy Boga w trójcy jedynego: „Wiara zaś katolicka polega na tym, abyśmy czcili jednego Boga w Trójcy, a Trójcę w jedności, nie mieszając Osób ani nie rozdzielając istoty; inna jest bowiem osoba Ojca, inna Syna, inna Ducha Świętego, lecz Ojca i Syna, i Ducha Świętego jedno jest Bóstwo, równa chwała, współwieczny majestat. Jaki Ojciec, taki Syn, taki Duch Święty: nie stworzony Ojciec, nie stworzony Syn, nie stworzony Duch Święty; niezmierzony Ojciec, niezmierzony Syn, niezmierzony Duch Święty; wiekuisty Ojciec, wiekuisty Syn, wiekuisty Duch Święty, a jednak nie trzech wiekuści, lecz jeden wiekuisty, jak i nie trzech nie stworzeni ani trzech niezmierzni, lecz jeden nie stworzony i jeden niezmierzony. Podobnie wszechmocny jest Ojciec, wszechmocny Syn, wszechmocny i Duch Święty; a jednak nie trzech wszechmocni, lecz jeden wszechmocny. Podobnie Bogiem jest Ojciec, Bogiem Syn i Bogiem Duch Święty; a jednak nie trzech bogowie, lecz jeden jest Bóg. Tak też Panem jest Ojciec, Panem Syn, Panem i Duch Święty a jednak nie trzech panowie, lecz jeden jest Pan. Ponieważ jak każdą z osób osobno Bogiem i Panem prawda chrześcijańska wyznawać nam każe, tak katolicka religia zabrania nam mówić o trzech bogach lub trzech panach”.

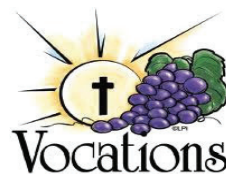

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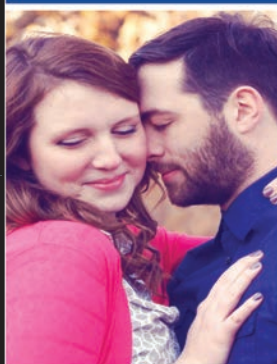
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
