

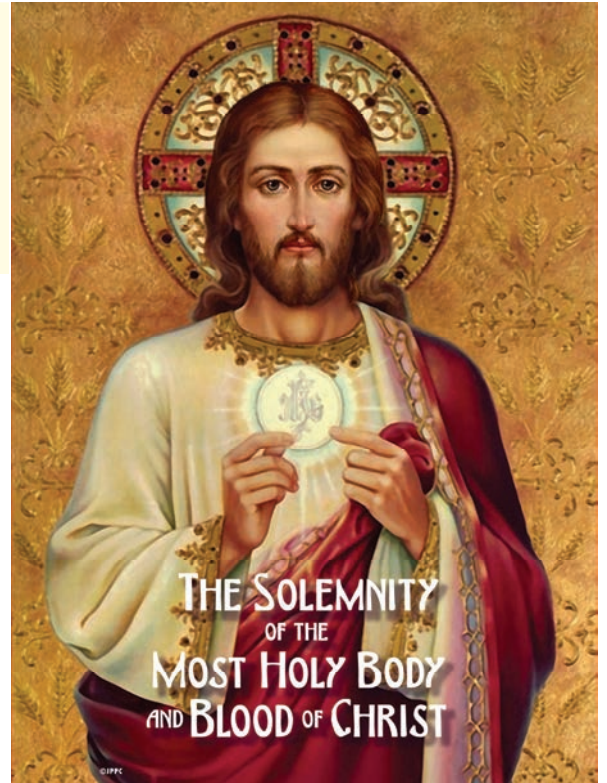

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This Sunday we celebrate the great feast of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In this Year of the Eucharist, it's an appropriate time to ask the Lord to deepen our faith in the Real Presence. We should also step back to reflect on our own reverence for the Eucharist and how well prepared and prayerful we are when we approach communion, especially in terms of the sacrament of reconciliation.

If we haven't given Eucharistic adoration a try in our prayer life, why not start this week or on a First Friday? Let the Holy Spirit lead you.

Speaking of Father's Day.... During a recent session of That Man Is You, I heard the results of a survey done in the Baptist tradition regarding the respective influence of fathers and mothers on the faith of their children. Even though not conducted from a Catholic perspective, the data were very revealing. Here's one of them: "If the mother is the first to become a Christian, there is a 17% probability everyone else in the household will follow. **However, when the father is first, there is a 93% probability everyone else in the household will follow.**" ["The Impact on Kids of Dad's Faith and Church Attendance" (June 20, 2016) at nickcady.org] That surprised me. So, Dads, if you think your Catholic faith and the practice of it doesn't make a difference, give this survey another look.

In the meantime, let's raise our hearts and voices this Sunday in thanksgiving for the Father sending us His Son, whose presence in the Eucharist remains with us in silent love until the end of time. In the words of St. Augustine, let's pray that we as the Body of Christ become more and more the Body of Christ that we receive.

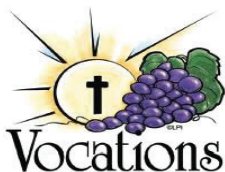

19 CZERWCA 2022 - UROCZYSTOŚĆ BOŻEGO CIAŁA

Jezus opowiadał rzeszom o królestwie Bożym, a tych, którzy leczenia potrzebowali, uzdrawiał. Dzień począł się chylić ku wieczorowi. Wtedy przystąpiło do Niego Dwunastu mówiąc: Odpraw tłum; niech idą do okolicznych wsi i zagród, gdzie znajdą schronienie i żywność, bo jesteśmy tu na pustkowiu. Lecz On rzekł do nich: Wy dajcie im jeść! Oni odpowiedzieli: Mamy tylko pięć chlebów i dwie ryby; chyba że pójdziemy i nakupimy żywności dla wszystkich tych ludzi. Było bowiem około pięciu tysięcy mężczyzn. Wtedy rzekł do swych uczniów: Każcie im rozsiać się gromadami mniej więcej po pięćdziesięciu! Uczynili tak i rozmieścili wszystkich. A On wziął te pięć chlebów i dwie ryby, spojrzawszy w niebo i odmówiwszy błogosławieństwo, połamał i dawał uczniom, by podawali ludowi. Jedli i nasycili się wszyscy, i zebrano jeszcze dwanaście koszów ułamków, które im zostały (Łk 9,11b-17).

Indianie z plemienia Inków w Peru wybudowali wspaniałą świątynię słońca w Cuzco. Świątynia ta miała tylko trzy ściany; północną, południową i zachodnią. Nie było w niej ściany wschodniej i dachu. Wewnętrzna zachodnia ściana wyłożona była złotem, które wypolerowane lśniło jak lustro. Wierni gromadzili się w świątyni przed wschodem słońca. Twarzami byli zwróceny ku zachodowi. Promienie wschodzącego słońca odbijały się od lustrzanej ściany. Świątynia wypełniała się nadzwyczajnym blaskiem. Światło swą intensywnością i złotem oszałamiało wiernych, których twarze opromienione tym blaskiem nabierały nadzwyczajnego wyrazu. Radość i ekstaza na twarzach wiernych zdawały się przenikać ich serca. Spojrzenie w twarz boga słońca przemieniało ludzi.

A w dole chwieją się, chwieją aż do ziemi

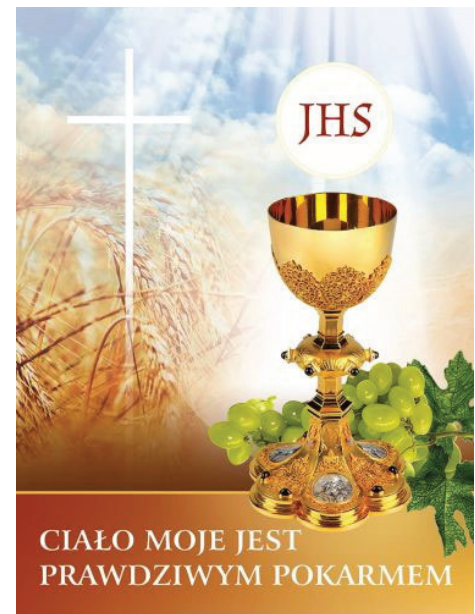

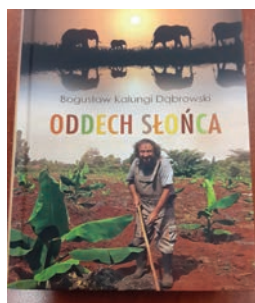

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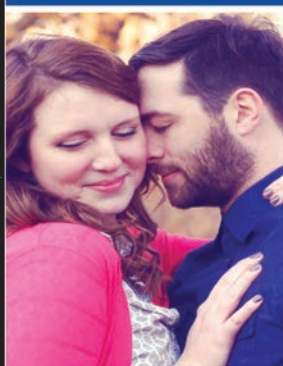
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
