

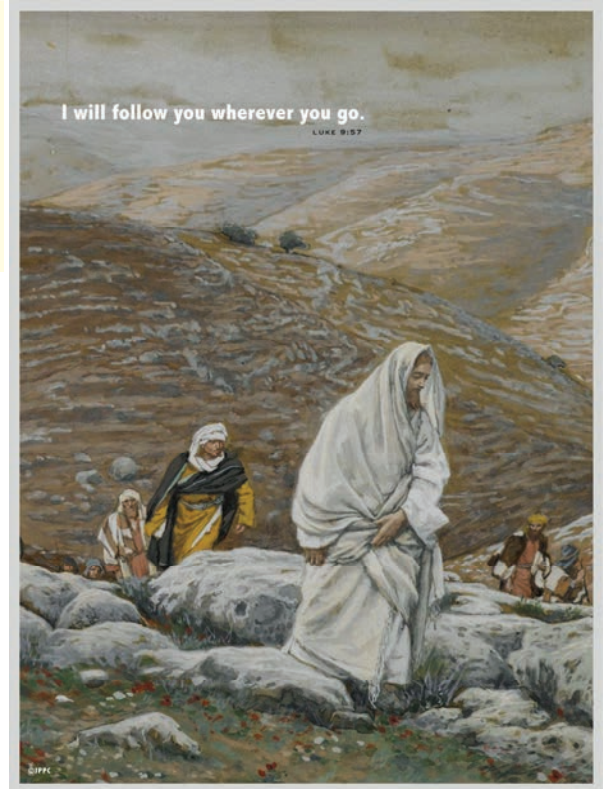

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good! After weeks of celebrating Easter and the special feasts of these last two weekends, we settle into the Sundays of Ordinary Time until Advent begins on November 27th. Although the word *ordinary* refers to the ordinal numbers that designate our Sundays from now until the end of the year, it's difficult not to hear *ordinary* as the opposite of "extraordinary" or "special." However, Jesus' words in this Sunday's gospel remind us that truly following Jesus as Catholic Christians is anything but ordinary. To be a baptized Catholic Christian is tough stuff, much more than "just" going to Sunday Mass or turning in the collection envelopes, although these are good starts.

As I finish my first year as your pastor at St. Stanislaus, I'm continually reflecting on what we need to do as a parish family to move forward. Participation in community and school events, fundraisers, parish organizations, liturgical ministries, faith formation opportunities—they're all so important for the life of any parish. **However, what matters most is whether I'm growing daily in my relationship with Jesus Christ through the sacramental life of the church and daily prayer, and then sharing the fruits of that faith with family, friends, and those most in need.** (Read that bold sentence again.) Pope Francis would call this being a "missionary disciple." Our Catholic faith, especially the Eucharist and the rich tradition of theology and spirituality over two thousand years, has much to offer the world. Our faith, however, also challenges the world's secularism and dangerous, unhealthy attempts to live without God as revealed in Jesus Christ. How will we live our faith vibrantly and with good zeal, especially here at St. Stan's? A lot depends on how you who are reading this question decide to answer it. Happy Ordinary Time!

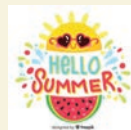

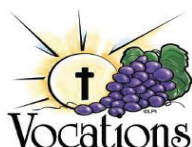

BIULETYN Parafialny

26 CZERWCA 2022 - XIII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA



Gdy dopełniał się czas wzięcia Jezusa z tego świata, postanowił udać się do Jerozolimy i wysłał przed sobą posłańców. Ci wybrali się w drogę i przyszli do pewnego miasteczka samarytańskiego, by Mu przygotować pobyt. Nie przyjęto Go jednak, ponieważ zmierzał do Jerozolimy. Widząc to, uczniowie Jakub i Jan rzekli: „Panie, czy chcesz, a powiemy, żeby ogień spadł z nieba i zniszczył ich?”. Lecz On odwróciwszy się zabronił im. I udali się do innego miasteczka. A gdy szli drogą, ktoś powiedział do Niego: „Pójdę za Tobą, dokądkolwiek się udasz”. Jezus mu odpowiedział: „Lisy mają nory i ptaki powietrzne gniazda, lecz Syn Człowieczy nie ma miejsca, gdzie by głowę mógł wesprzeć”. Do innego rzekł: „Pójdź za Mną”. (Łk 9,51-62).

Siedemnaście lat temu ukazała się w Polsce moja pierwsza książka pt. „Ku wolności”. Do takiego tytułu zainspirowały mnie słowa z listu św. Pawła do Galatów, który zacytowałem na wstępie tych rozważań. Na okładce zamieściłem fotografię mojej mamy przed Statuą Wolności. Rok przed swoją śmiercią przyjechała do Nowego Jorku w odwiedziny do mnie. Chciała zobaczyć, jak mi się tu powodzi, czy mam przyjaciół i życzliwych ludzi, zobaczyć kraj, gdzie w świadomości wielu tak łatwo spełniają się ludzkie sny i marzenia, w tym także odwieczny sen o wolności. Dla przybywających do Stanów Zjednoczonych, do Nowego Jorku symbolem tego spełnionego snu była Statua Wolności. W październiku tego roku minie równo 130 lat od odsłonięcia tego monumentu. Był to dar rządu francuskiego dla USA w stulecie uchwalenia Deklaracji Niepodległości Stanów Zjednoczonych. Projekt Statuy wykonał francuski rzeźbiarz Frédéric August Bartholdi. Inspiracją dla niego był obraz Eugène'a Delacroix zatytułowany „Wolność wiodąca lud na barykady”. A zatem w pierwotnym zamyśle twórców Statuy Wolności była wolność, jaką zrewolucjonizowany proletariatus wywalczy na barykadach. Dobrze wiemy jak wyglądała ta wolność. W czasie rewolucji francuskiej „lud barykady” otworzył bramy więzienia paryskiej Bastylli, aby w niedługim czasie uwięzić tam jeszcze więcej ludzi i trzymać ich w jeszcze potworniejszych warunkach. Krew spod gilotyn zabarwiła ulice Paryża jak nigdy dotąd. Rewolucja bolszewicka zamieniła Rosję w największe więzienie świata, gdzie milionami, w największych katuszach byli mordowani obywatele tej ziemi. Krwawi oprawcy też nie zaznali wolności. Paraliżował ich strach o własne życie. I słusznie, bo współnicy dawnych mordów, czując lęk przed utratą władzy zabijali bez pardonu swoich towarzyszy. Rewolucje nosły jeszcze większe zniewolenie człowieka, zarówno ofiar, jak i oprawców.

Wołanie Chrystusa „Pójdź za Mną” przybiera różną formę i dociera do nas na różne sposoby. A nasza pozytywna odpowiedź raz dana musi być potwierdzana i weryfikowana każdego dnia. Czasami jest ona prosta i jasna. Niesie radość spełnienia. Czasami jest tak trudna, że z wielkim móżolem i bólem odkrywamy drogę kroczenia za Chrystusem. Kilka tygodni temu byłem świadkiem takiego trudnego szukania. Zostałem wezwany do chorego na raka mózgu w beznadziejnym stanie. Był podłączony do aparatury podtrzymującej życie, bez której nie przeżyłby minuty. W tym czasie Tadeusz przechodził ataki serca. Lekarze wiedzieli, że tak drastyczne pobudzanie serca do działania nie ma większego sensu. Przedłuży tylko agonię i zwiększa cierpienie chorego i jego rodziny. Jednak mieli lekarski obowiązek ratowania życia. W najbardziej dramatycznej sytuacji znalazła się żona chorego, ponieważ lekarze bezpardonowo nalegali, żeby podpisała dokument pozwalający na odłączenie aparatury podtrzymującej życie męża. Wiedziała ona, że taka decyzja nie byłaby wbrew nauce Kościoła. Znała słowa umierającego papieża Jana Pawła II: „Pozwólcie mi odejść do domu Ojca”. Jednak nie była w stanie podjąć takiej decyzji. Mówiła, że gdyby mąż za życia, chociaż wspomniał, że nie chce, aby sztucznie podtrzymywano jego życie, to może brałaby pod uwagę taką decyzję. Powiedziała także do mnie, aby księża z ambony uwrażliwiali wiernych na takie sytuacje. Dlatego między innymi piszę o tym.

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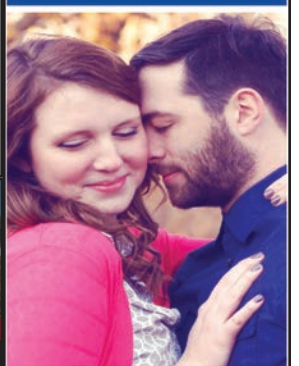


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
