

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good! Several years ago, our friary in Washington, DC, was hosting a European friar who was taking some courses at the theological school where our friars studied. In the first weeks of his stay, I asked if anything surprised him about the U.S.A. He responded that it was so unusual to see American flags everywhere, even in front of private homes. The usual practice in his country, he said, was to see a flag only on a government building. He told me how he had learned from childhood not to be very proud of his country, especially its past.

As with every nation throughout the world, there are parts of our history that we don't want to repeat, and many times we wish they had never happened. But does it do anyone good to hold children responsible for the sins of their ancestors? I don't think so. At least that's not the way God works in the world. Our loving and provident Father calls us to learn from our sins, not be held in bondage by them, and then decide how we can move forward with his grace, having the mind of Christ Jesus and the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit.

We still enjoy so many freedoms not protected in other parts of the world, and many people gave their lives to safeguard them. This is a weekend for gratitude, celebration, and renewed efforts to work toward a culture of life where every human life is valued and can flourish in justice, peace, and genuine freedom.

BIULETYN Parafialny

3 LIPACA 2022 - XIV NIEDZIELA ZWYKLA

„Radujcie się wraz z Jerozolimą, weselcie się w niej wszyscy, co ją miłujecie! Cieszcie się z nią bardzo wy wszyscy, którzy się nad nią smuciliście. Tak bowiem mówi Pan: «Oto Ja skieruję do niej pokój jak rzekę i chwałę narodów – jak strumień wezbrany. Ich niemowlęta będą noszone na biodrach i na kolanach będą pieszczcone. Jak kogoś pociesza własna matka, tak Ja was pocieszać będę; w Jerozolimie doznacie pociechy». Na ten widok rozradują się serca wasze, a kości wasze nabiorą świeżości jak murawa. Ręka Pana da się poznać Jego slugom...“. (Iz 66, 10. 12-14c).

Helen Keller, amerykańska pisarka i pedagog w wieku 19 miesięcy życia straciła wzrok, słuch i częściowo mowę. Mimo tych ograniczeń ukończyła wyższe studia, uzyskała doktorat i nauczyła się kilku języków. Pewnego razu po wykładach ktoś zadał jej pytanie: Gdyby zaistniała możliwość spełnienia jednego życzenia; co by pani wybrała? Możemy się domyślać, jakie może być życzenie człowieka pozbawionego wzroku i słuchu. Lecz w tym wypadku nasze domysły są chybione. Helen Keller odpowiedziała: „Wybrałabym życzenie pokoju dla świata”.



Do jednej z afrykańskich wiosek przyjechał misjonarz. Głosząc Ewangelię starał się także ulżyć mieszkańcom wioski w ich codziennym życiu. Jak w większości wiosek afrykańskich, tak i w tej dużym problemem był dostęp do pitnej wody. Mieszkańcy chodzili po wodę do odległej rzeki. Jednak ta woda nie była wystarczająco czysta, co było nieraz powodem problemów zdrowotnych. Misjonarz postanowił ufundować mieszkańcom studnię głębinową. Znalazł sponsorów, ofiarodawców, którzy pomogli zrealizować to użyteczne dzieło. Gdy pierwsza woda wytrysnęła ze studni we wsi zapanował ogromna radość. Mieli teraz bardzo blisko wodę i to krystalicznie czystą. Po pewnym czasie misjonarz opuścił tę miejscowości i zaczął pracę misyjną w innym regionie. Po kilku latach odwiedził swoją dawną placówkę misyjną, gdzie zbudował studnię. W czasie tych odwiedzin zatrzymał się u starszej, kalekiej kobiety i poprosił o szklankę wody. Kobieta powiedziała, że nie ma pitnej wody w domu. „Przecież macie teraz studnię, w której wody jest pod dostatkiem” – powiedział misjonarz. „Tak, to prawda, ale problem jest z moim wnukiem. Gdy proszę go o przyniesienie wody, to nie chce mnie słuchać, woli biegać, bawić się i grać” – odpowiedziała staruszka. „Widzisz, w wiosce, gdzie nie brakuje może człowiek umrzeć z pragnienia, bo sam nie może jej zaczepić, a nie ma nikogo, kto by przyniósł tej wody. Tak jest ze słowem Bożym, które jest źródłem życia duchowego. Bóg przyszedł ze swoim słowem, jest obecny wśród nas, a niektórzy umierają duchowo bez tego słowa życia, bo brakuje tych, którzy przynieśli by im to słowo” – zakończył misjonarz.

Dziś, Siostry Zakonne „**Little Sisters of the Poor**” z Enfield opiekujące się ubogimi w podeszłym wieku w Rezydencji św. Józefa odwiedzą naszą parafię. Prosimy o pomoc finansową dla nich, by mogły kontynuować ich stuletnią misję i służyć pomocą biednym. Siostry są bardzo wdzięczne za waszą hojność.
