

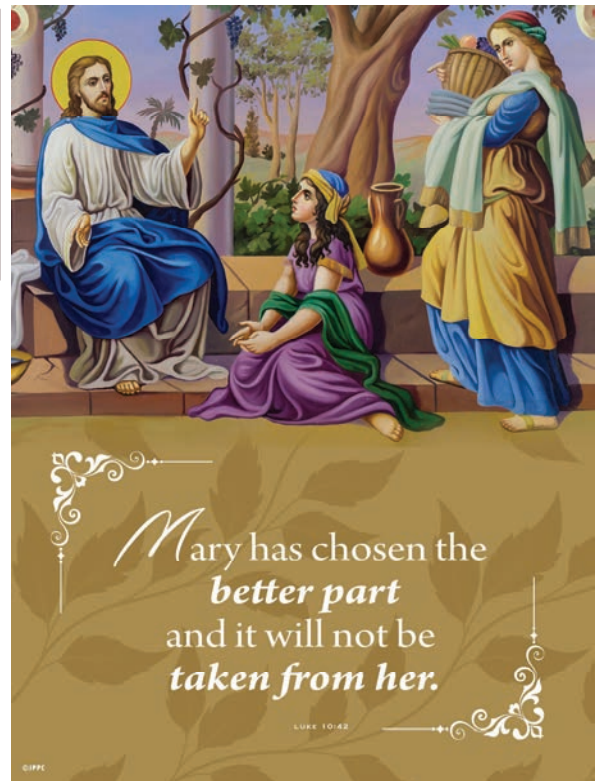

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good! As a Franciscan friar with a founder incredibly well-known throughout the world, St. Francis of Assisi, I'm often surprised by how little known his writings are. Admittedly they are few, and the most famous one attributed to him ("Lord, make me an instrument of your peace") wasn't written by him but comes from the early 20th century. (Don't feel bad. It's still a great prayer that expresses his spirit.)

One of St. Francis' genuine writings, however, has to do with today's gospel passage of Martha and Mary. In the *Rule for Hermitages*, St. Francis wrote a short instruction for those friars who wanted to live a more solitary life. Ironically, the saint from Assisi tells them to live this in community! Some of the friars should take the role of Mary and spend the time in prayer and contemplation; others should take the role of Martha and do all the housework and errands. Then, after a time, they should *switch* roles. The insight is a great one.

We can easily divide ourselves into whether we are Martha's or Mary's, but we are called to be BOTH. Jesus didn't chastise Martha for her hospitality because hospitality was an extremely serious obligation in the Middle Eastern society of Jesus' day, much more so than it is for us. Jesus was more concerned that Martha was "anxious and worried about many things" and that she didn't know how to stop and listen to him, the "better part" that brings divine peace, order, and meaning into our lives. So...let's take the necessary time to stop, listen, and sit at the feet of the Lord Jesus each day. We are called to be people of contemplation AND action, not one or the other.

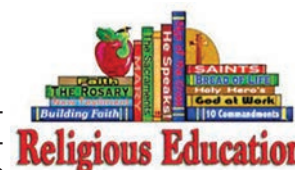

BIULETYN Parafialny

17 LIPCA 2022 - XVI NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA



Jezus przyszedł do pewnej wsi. Tam niejaka niewiasta, imieniem Marta, przyjęła Go do swego domu. Miała ona siostrę, imieniem Maria, która siadła u nóg Pana i przysłuchiwała się Jego mowie. Natomiast Marta uwijała się koło rozmaitych posług. Przystąpiła więc do Niego i rzekła: „Panie, czy Ci to obojętne, że moja siostra zostawiła mnie samą przy usługiwaniu? Powiedz jej, żeby mi pomogła”. A Pan jej odpowiedział: „Marto, Marto, troszczysz się i niepokoisz o wiele, a potrzeba mało albo tylko jednego. Maria obrała najlepszą część, której nie będzie pozbawiona” (Łk 10, 38-42).

W samo południe upalnego dnia Abraham siedział w cieniu dębów Mamre. W oddali dostrzegł trzy ludzkie postacie. Zapewne kierowany odruchem ludzkiej gościnności i bożym natchnieniem wyszedł im naprzeciw, zapraszając w gościnę. Przyniósł wody, aby obmyli sobie ręce i nogi oraz zaproponował odpoczynek w cieniu drzew. W tym czasie żona jego Sara szybko upiekła podpłomyki, zaś Abraham wybrał dorodne cielę, z którego kazał słudze przygotować posiłek dla gości. A gdy spożywali przygotowane dary jeden z tajemniczych gości powiedział, że za rok wróci, a wtedy Sara będzie miała syna. Abraham bardzo pragnął mieć syna, ale ze względu na podeszły wiek, zarówno swój jak i żony nie miał takiej nadziei. Uwierzył jednak przybyszowi, bo był przekonany, że przyszedł do niego w gościnę wysłannik nieba. Po roku rzeczywiście Sara urodziła syna, a Abraham nie miał już żadnych wątpliwości, że przed rokiem, zapraszając w gościnę umęczonych wędrowców, zaprosił samego Boga.

Film „Początek” przedstawia historię Iana Graya, młodego biologa, którego poznajemy w filmie jako pełnego zapału doktoranta. Ten błyskotliwy biolog od dzieciństwa pasjonuje się oczami i uwiecznia je na fotografiach, ponieważ są unikalne tak jak odciski palców. Ian próbuje odtworzyć ewolucję oka i tym samym udowodnić, że teolodzy nie mają racji twierdząc, że na początku stworzenia stoi inteligentna Osoba, zwana Bogiem. Przez swe badania chce wykazać, że jest w stanie od samego początku odtworzyć, tak pozycyjny organ, jakim jest oko. Do eksperymentu wybrał robaki pozbawione wzroku. W trakcie prowadzenia tych badań sfotografował oczy, zamaskowanej twarzy dziewczyny. Nie dawały mu one spokoju, zaczął szukać dziewczyny z tymi oczyma. Po wielu poszukiwaniach odnalazł ją. Była nią piękna, inteligentna i uduchowiona osoba imieniem Sofii. W przeciwieństwie do Iana była osobą wierzącą w Boga, Stwórcę Wszechświata. Pewnego razu Ian zabrał ją do laboratorium, aby pochwalić się nowym osiągnięciem naukowym. Otóż udało się mu zmutować ślepego robaka i odtworzyć oko. Robak zaczął wiedzieć. Ian z dumą demonstrując swoje osiągnięcie chciał powiedzieć Sofii, że za stworzeniem świata nie stoi Stwórca, Bóg, że człowiek może pokierować tak ewolucją, że nawet oko może zbudować od samych podstaw. Na co Soffi powiedziała: Widzisz te wszystkie robaki nie widzą świata, nie widzą słońca, tylko jeden z nich widzi, to co jest zakryte przed pozostałymi. Poprzez swoje wywody dała do zrozumienia Ianowi, że z ludźmi bywa podobnie. Może być „zmutowany” człowiek, który widzi więcej, widzi wszystko. Ian widząc aluzje do siebie zapytał ją czy ona uważa się za takiego zmutowanego robaka. Sofii powiedziała, że tak.

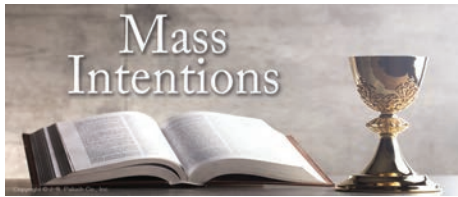

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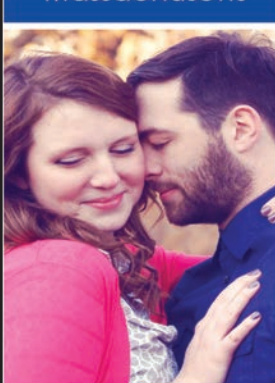
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
