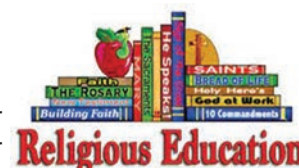

XVII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Gdy Jezus przebywał w jakimś miejscu na modlitwie i skończył ją, rzekł jeden z uczniów do Niego: „Panie, naucz nas się modlić, jak i Jan nauczył swoich uczniów”. A On rzekł do nich: „Kiedy się modlicie, mówcie: Ojcze, niech się święci Twoje imię; niech przyjdzie Twoje królestwo. Naszego chleba powszedniego dawaj nam na każdy dzień, i przebacz nam nasze grzechy, bo i my przebaczymy każdemu, kto nam zawini; i nie dopuść, byśmy ulegli pokusie”. Dalej mówił do nich: „Ktoś z was, mając przyjaciela, pójdzie do niego o północy i powie mu: »Przyjacielu, użyj mi trzech chlebów, bo mój przyjaciel przybył do mnie z drogi, a nie mam co mu podać«. Lecz tamten odpowie z wewnątrz: »Nie naprzykrzaj mi się!



Drzwi są już zamknięte i moje dzieci leżą ze mną w łóżku. Nie mogę wstać i dać tobie«. Mówię wam: Chociażby nie wstał i nie dał z tego powodu, że jest jego przyjacielem, to z powodu jego natręstwa wstanie i da mu, ile potrzebuje. I Ja wam powiadam: Proście, a będzie wam dane; szukajcie, a znajdziecie; kołaczcie, a otworzą wam. Każdy bowiem, kto prosi, otrzymuje; kto szuka, znajduje; a kołaczącemu otworzą. Jeżeli którego z was, ojców, syn poprosi o chleb, czy poda mu kamień? Lub też gdy prosi o jajko, czy poda mu skorpioną? Jeśli więc wy, choć żli jesteście, umiecie dawać dobre dary swoim dzieciom, o ileż bardziej Ojciec z nieba da Ducha Świętego tym, którzy Go proszą” (Łk 11,1–13).

Badania naukowe Harolda G. Koeniga, Michaela E. McCullougha i Davida B. Larsona zamieszczone w książce „Handbook of Religion and Health” zawierają ciekawe informacje na temat oddziaływania wiary i modlitwy na nasze zdrowie. Oto niektóre z nich:

Kuracja pacjentów, którzy nigdy nie modlili się i nie uczęszczali do kościoła średnio trwała trzy razy dłużej niż pacjentów regularnie praktykujących modlitwę.

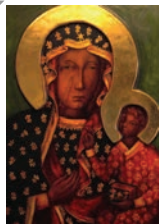
Niebezpieczeństwo śmierci niewierzących pacjentów chorych na serce było wyższe aż 14 razy niż pacjentów wierzących.

Starsi pacjenci, którzy nigdy lub rzadko uczęszczali do kościoła dwa razy częściej byli zagrożeni wylewem krwi do mózgu niż osoby żyjące według zasad swej wiary.

W Izraelu, częstotliwość zachorowani na serce i raka była według tych badań o 40 proc. wyższa wśród osób niewierzących.

Ludzie religijni rzadziej popadali w depresję i szybciej z niej wychodzili.

Ufając słowom Ewangelii możemy mieć pewność, że wytrwała i szczerza modlitwa zawsze dociera do Boga. Bóg nie jest obojętny na wołanie swoich dzieci. Owoc modlitwy dostrzegamy nieraz w doczesności, a czasami trzeba czekać wieczności. Dlaczego? Pismo święte mówi, że nasze drogi nie są drogami bożymi. Dorastanie do „dróg bożych” pozwala coraz pełniej dostrzec owoc spełnionej modlitwy. Najpiękniejszym owocem skutecznej modlitwy jest zapewne nawrócenie i wewnętrzna przemiana człowieka. Przykładem tego może być wytrwała modlitwa św. Moniki, która wyblagała nawrócenie swojemu synowi. Dziesiątki lat zanosila gorące modlitwy do Boga za syna, który przynależał do sekty, prowadził rozwiązły tryb życia, żył z kobietą bez ślubu. Jednak w końcu dożyła chwili, gdy jej syn, Augustyn w 33 roku życia nawrócił i zyskał koronę świętości.

SAINTS JOACHIM AND ANNE

Feast Day: July 26

In the Scriptures, Matthew and Luke furnish a legal family history of Jesus, tracing ancestry to show that Jesus is the culmination of great promises. Not only is his mother's family neglected, we also know nothing factual about them except that they existed. Even the names "Joachim" and "Anne" come from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus died.



The heroism and holiness of these people however, is inferred from the whole family atmosphere around Mary in the Scriptures. Whether we rely on the legends about Mary's childhood or make guesses from the information in the Bible, we see in her a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons, herself steeped in the religious traditions of her people.

The strong character of Mary in making decisions, her continuous practice of prayer, her devotion to the laws of her faith, her steadiness at moments of crisis, and her devotion to her relatives—all indicate a close-knit, loving family that looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past.

Joachim and Anne—whether these are their real names or not—represent that entire quiet series of generations who faithfully perform their duties, practice their faith, and establish an atmosphere for the coming of the Messiah, but remain obscure.

Reflection: This is the "feast of grandparents." It reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.

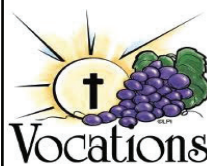

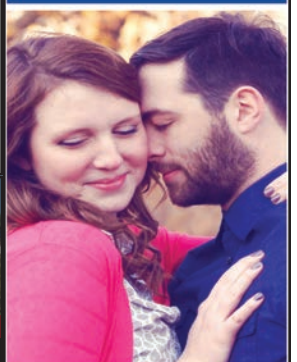
