

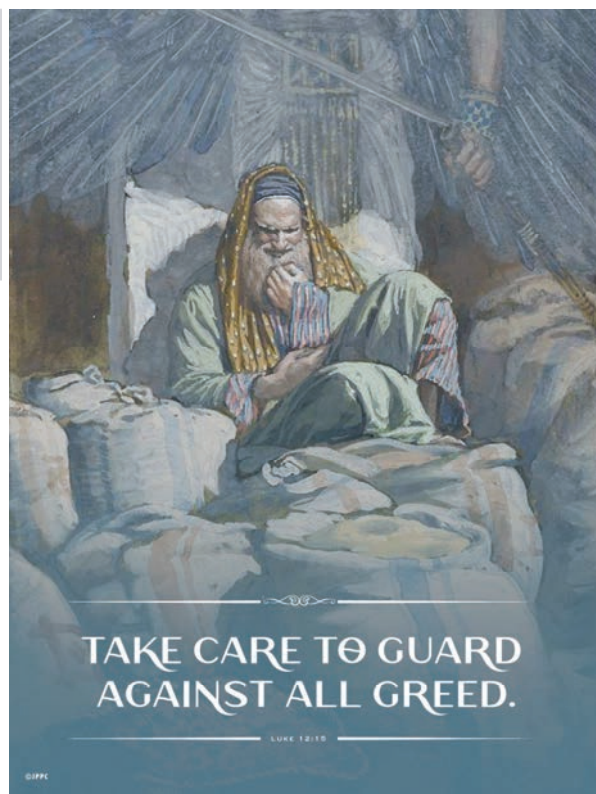

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! The Scripture readings this Sunday confront us with some strong reminders of what it means to be a Catholic Christian. At the end of his parable, Jesus wants to know whether we are “rich in what matters to God.” St. Paul reminds us that following Christ involves “putting to death (!) . . . immorality, impurity, passion, evil desires, greed, and lying”—quite a list. It’s very easy for all of us to recognize these things when they make the news or show up in the life of our least favorite politician. However, these idols lie within all of us, and they all need to die.

This past week I was listening to a YouTube video on confession by the popular social media personality, Fr. Mike Schmitz. He made an excellent point that stuck with me. When we examine our consciences, we don’t evaluate our thoughts, words, and deeds based on the good or bad we see in other people around us or the culture, i.e., the “I’m -basically-a-good-person” syndrome. We evaluate our actions as they measure up against God and his standards, especially as they have been made flesh in Jesus. Wow. A simple but powerful insight. So what needs to be put to death in your soul this week? What needs to thrive and flourish?

One way to ponder these questions and be open to the God of surprises is to spend time in adoration during the parish’s Forty Hours celebration, August 4-7. Set aside some time and let our crucified and risen Lord speak to you from the hidden glory of the Eucharist.

XVIII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Ktoś z tłumu powiedział do Jezusa: „Nauczycielu, powiedz mojemu bratu, żeby się podzielił ze mną spadkiem”. Lecz On mu odpowiedział: „Człowieku, któż Cię ustanowił sędzią albo rozjemcą nad wami?”. Powiedział też do nich: „Uważajcie i strzeżcie się wszelkiej chciwości, bo nawet gdy ktoś opływa we wszystko, życie jego nie jest zależne od jego mienia”. I powiedział im przypowieść: „Pewnemu zamożnemu człowiekowi dobrze obrodziło pole. I



rozważał sam w sobie: »Co tu począć? Nie mam gdzie pomieścić moich zbiorów«. I rzekł: »Tak zrobię: zburzę moje spichlerze, a postawię większe i tam zgromadzę wszystko zboże i moje dobra. I powiem sobie: Masz wielkie zasoby dóbr, na długie lata złożone; odpoczywaj, jedz, pij i używaj«. Lecz Bóg rzekł do niego: „Głupcze, jeszcze tej nocy zażądają twojej duszy od ciebie; komu więc przypadnie to, coś przygotował?”. Tak dzieje się z każdym, kto skarby gromadzi dla siebie, a nie jest bogaty przed Bogiem (Łk 12,13-21).

Ewa po nieudanym i stresującym dniu, aby poprawić sobie humor często wybiera się na zakupy. Kupuje bez pamięci. W czasie kupowania zapomina o wszystkich problemach. Cieszy ją samo kupowanie. Gdy wraca do domu, często stwierdza, że większość rzeczy, które kupiła, prawdę mówiąc nie jest jej potrzebna. Ale to nie problem. Można je oddać i znowu razem wyruszyć na zakupy. Tej historii nie wymyśliłem, opowiedziała mi ją jedna z pań. Jest to zjawisko dosyć często spotykane w dzisiejszym świecie. Zakupy, bogactwo traktowane są jako antidotum na nasze problemy. Co gorsze, usiłujemy na tej drodze zaspokoić potrzeby duchowe lub rozwiązać problemy tej samej natury. Pustki duchowej, utraty sensu życia, poczucia osamotnienia, braku miłości nie rozwiążą zakupy, chociażby najokazalsze, nie rozwiąże gromadzenie dóbr materialnych. Najwyżej można na chwilę od nich uciec, zapomnieć, ciesząc się nabytą rzeczą, zabawką. Ale po chwili problemy powrócą ze zdwojoną mocą. Można je rozwiązać tylko przez nabywanie bogactw, które mają wartość w oczach Boga.

Dobra materialne i przyjemności tego świata mają przemożny wpływ na życie człowieka. Pismo święte nie potępia ani jednego ani drugiego. Ostrzega tylko przed zdominowaniem naszego życia przez te wartości. Człowiek stworzony jest na obraz Boży, a ostatecznym celem jego życia jest chwała wieczna. Ten cel przesłania człowiekowi nieopanowana żądza posiadania dóbr materialnych i nieumiarkowana pogoń za przyjemnościami. Te wartości winny być wprzęgnięte w dążenie człowieka do celu wyznaczonego przez Boga. Doświadczenie śmierci jest nieraz zimnym kubłem wody na rozgorączkowaną różnymi żądzami głowę. Dobrze nieraz usłyszeć: „Głupcze, jeszcze tej nocy zażądają twojej duszy od ciebie”. Świadomość śmierci nieraz w dramatyczny sposób staje na drodze przemiany grzesznika w świętego. Tak było w życiu św. Małgorzaty z Kortony.

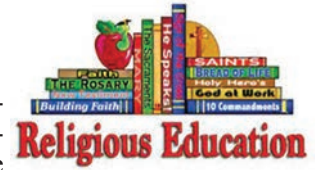

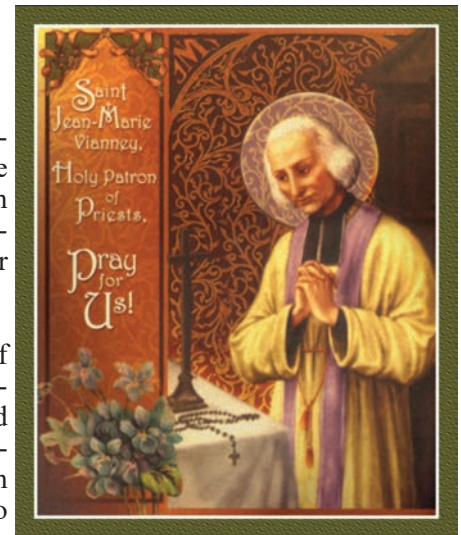

SAINT JOHN VIANNEY

Feast Day: August 4

A man with vision overcomes obstacles and performs deeds that seem impossible. John Vianney was a man with vision: He wanted to become a priest. But he had to overcome his meager formal schooling, which inadequately prepared him for seminary studies. His failure to comprehend Latin lectures forced him to discontinue. But his vision of being a priest urged him to seek private tutoring. After a lengthy battle with the books, John was ordained.

Situations calling for "impossible" deeds followed him everywhere. As pastor of the parish at Ars, John encountered people who were indifferent and quite comfortable with their style of living. His vision led him through severe fasts and short nights of sleep. With Catherine Lassagne and Benedicta Lardet, he established La Providence, a home for girls. Only a man of vision could have such trust that God would provide for the spiritual and material needs of all those who came to make La Providence their home.



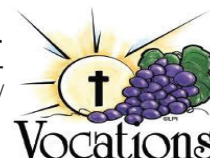
His work as a confessor is John Vianney's most remarkable accomplishment. In the winter months he was to spend 11 to 12 hours daily reconciling people with God. In the summer months this time was increased to 16 hours. Unless a man was dedicated to his vision of a priestly vocation, he could not have endured this giving of self day after day.

Many people look forward to retirement and taking it easy, doing the things they always wanted to do but never had the time. But John Vianney had no thoughts of retirement. As his fame spread, more hours were consumed in serving God's people. Even the few hours he would allow himself for sleep were disturbed frequently by the devil. Who, but a man with vision, could keep going with ever-increasing strength? In 1929, Pope Pius XI named him the patron of parish priests worldwide.

Reflection: Indifference toward religion, coupled with a love for material comfort, seem to be common signs of our times. A person from another planet observing us would not likely judge us to be pilgrim people, on our way to somewhere else. John Vianney on the other hand, was a man on a journey, with his goal before him at all times.
