

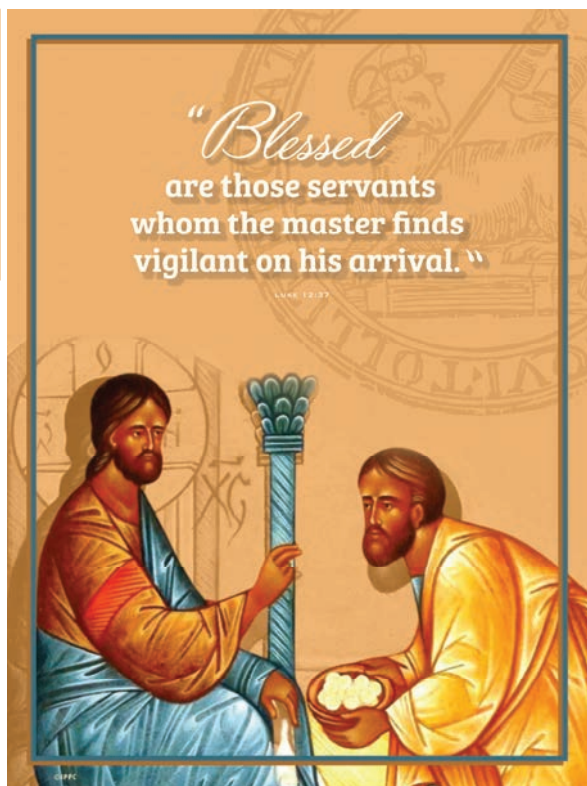

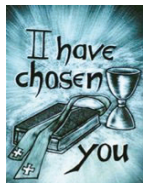

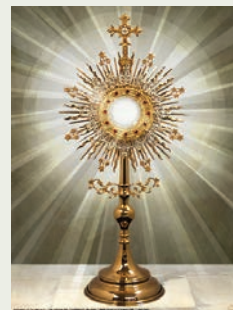

7 SIERPNIA 2022 - XIX NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Nie bój się, mała trzódka, gdyż spodobało się Ojcu waszemu dać wam królestwo. Sprzedajcie wasze mienie i dajcie jałmużnę. Sprawcie sobie trzosa, które nie niszczyją, skarb niewyczerpany w niebie, gdzie się złodziej nie dostaje ani mól nie niszczy. Bo gdzie jest skarb wasz, tam będzie i serce wasze. Niech będą przepasane biodra wasze i zapalone pochodnie. A wy podobni do ludzi, oczekujących swego pana, kiedy z uczty weselnej powróci; aby mu zaraz otworzyć, gdy nadejdzie i zakołaczę. Szczęśliwi owi słudzy, których pan zastanie czuwających, gdy nadejdzie. Zaprawdę powiadam wam: Przepasze się i każe im zasiąść do stołu, a obchodząc będzie im usługiwał. Czy o drugiej, czy o trzeciej straży przyjdzie, szczęśliwi oni, gdy ich tak zastanie. A to rozumieście, że gdyby gospodarz wiedział, o której godzinie złodziej ma przyjść, nie pozwoliłby włamać się do swego domu. Wy też bądźcie gotowi, gdyż o godzinie, której się nie domyślacie, Syn Człowieczy przyjdzie (Łk 12,35-40).



Frank Kendig i Richard Hutton w książce „Life Spans, or How Long Things Last” dokonali ciekawego zestawienia na temat czasu użytkowania pewnych rzeczy. Oto kilka przykładów. Buty zawodnika baseballa krajowej ligi wytrzymują trzy miesiące. Kij hokejowy zawodnika wytrzymuje tylko dwie gry. Buty żołnierskie w czasie pokoju zużywają się w ciągu piętnastu miesięcy, zaś w czasie wojny w czasie trzech miesięcy. Puszka po piwie zostawiona na biwaku w lesie przetrwa 80 lat, zaś skórzane buty pięćdziesiąt. Zaś skała trwa tysiące lat. Na końcu tego zestawienia autorzy konkludują: wszystko przemienie, nawet skały, nic nie może wiecznie trwać. Tu pojawia się pytanie, a jak to jest z człowiekiem? Gdy odwiedzamy cmentarz, to mamy wypisane najczęściej dwie daty: urodzenia i śmierci. A zatem możemy powiedzieć bardzo konkretnie, jak długo trwa ludzkie życie. Jednak większość ludzi sądzi, że takie stwierdzenie jest fałszywe, bo życie człowieka wymyka się tym datom i zmierza ku wieczności.

Pisarz Andrzej Majewski stwierdził: „Życie to taki dziwny teatr, gdzie tragedia miesza się z farsą, scenariusz piszą sami aktorzy, suflerem jest sumienie i nigdy nie wiadomo, kiedy otworzy się zapadnia.” Nie tylko nie wiemy, kiedy otworzy się zapadnia, ale możemy się mylić, kto pierwszy do niej wpadnie, tak jak w poniższej historii. Jedna z rodzin miała zwyczaj od czasu do czasu wypróbować swoje szczęście, grając w lotto. Zazwyczaj ojciec kupował kupony i dawał po jednym żonie, dzieciom i 90 letniemu dziadkowi. W końcu szczęście uśmiechnęło się do nich. Wygrali 20 milionów dolarów. Szczęśliwy kupon otrzymał dziadek. Rodzina obawiała się, że jak on się dowie o wygranej, to może po wpływem emocji nie przeżyje, miał bowiem problemy z sercem. Poprosili zatem zaprzyjaźnionego księdza, aby przygotował dziadka na przyjęcie tej radosnej wiadomości. Ksiądz chętnie się zgodził, licząc, że też coś tam otrzyma. Odwiedził zatem rodzinę. Rozmawiali na różne, aż w końcu ksiądz został z dziadkiem sam na sam. Duchowny sprowadził rozmowę na takie tory, że pytanie, które planował zadać nie wzbudzi żadnych podejrzeń. Jakby od niechcenia zapytał dziadka: „A co by pan zrobił, gdyby pan wygrał na przykład 20 milionów dolarów”. Dziadek odpowiedział: „Co, 20 milionów? To bardzo duża suma”. Zamilkł na chwilę, po czym, uśmiechając się powiedział: „Zrobiłbym tak; 15 milionów dałbym dzieciom i wnukom, a 5 miliony podarowałbym księdzu”. Zaskoczony i uradowany kapłan zakrztusił się i upadł na podłogę. Po przybyciu karetki pogotowia, lekarz stwierdził zgon z powodu zawału serca.

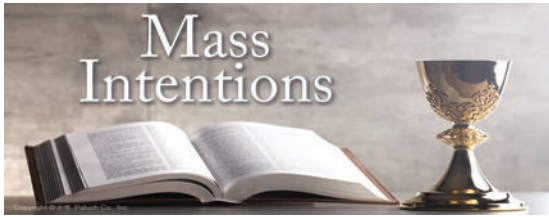

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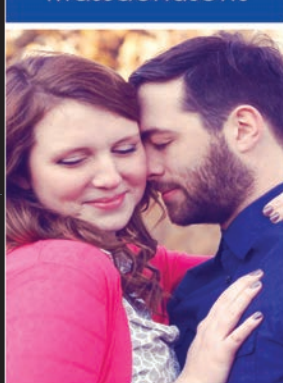
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
