

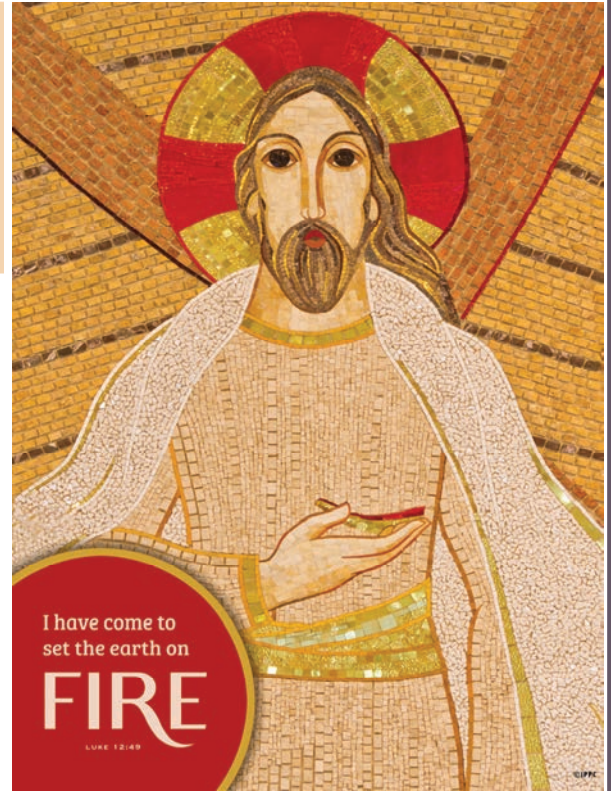

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Peace and all good things! As many of you know, our Franciscan Province of Our Lady of the Angels celebrated its quadrennial chapter this summer. Among the many things that happen at chapter are changes in friars' assignments. St. Stanislaus Friary is no exception.

I'm happy to announce that we will welcome two "new" parochial vicars to the parish staff: Fr. Lucjan Szymanski and Fr. John Koziol. Fr. Lucjan is originally from Gryfów Śląski in Poland and is a member of the Kraków Province of our Franciscan friars. He professed his vows as a Franciscan friar in 1985, was ordained a priest in 1991, and has served in Rockford, IL, Elmhurst, NY, and even Uzbekistan—among other places. Several years ago, Fr. Lucjan spent a brief time here at St. Stan's as he was studying English. He will arrive around August 24th to take up his new ministry here.



Fr. John Koziol is no stranger to the area. He was born in Holyoke, grew up in Chicopee Falls, and attended Mater Dolorosa Church and School in Holyoke. His father's family were parishioners here at St. Stan's. Fr. John professed his vows as a Franciscan friar in 1981, served as a deacon here at St. Stan's in the summer of 1987, was ordained a priest at St. Stan's in 1988, and served as a parochial vicar until August 1989. Fr. John has spent many years in parish ministry as well as formation of our young friars. Most recently he has been Pastor at St. Philip Benizi Parish in Jonesboro, GA. Fr. John will arrive on September 1st and will be serving as Guardian ("superior") of the friary as well as parochial vicar of the parish.

Where will Fr. Paul and Fr. Mietek be going?? Fr. Mietek will return from vacation on August 31st, say farewell to St. Stan's the weekend of September 3rd and 4th, and then on September 6th depart for Most Holy Trinity Friary in Brooklyn, NY, where he will become parochial vicar of the parish there. His giftedness in Spanish is a pressing need in Brooklyn. He will be sorely missed! Fortunately, we don't have to say farewell to Fr. Paul as he is moving only to St. Hyacinth Friary across the parking lot. All the same we wish him the best as he takes up ministry among our senior friars with opportunities to assist at St. Stan's from time to time.

Lastly, I'm relieved to say that I don't have to pack.... I'm quite happy to be staying on as Pastor here at St. Stanislaus. Please pray for all the friars during these days of transition.

BIULETYN Parafialny



14 sierpnia 2022 - 20 niedziela zwykła

Przyszedłem rzucić ogień na ziemię i jakże bardzo pragnę, żeby on już zapłonął! Chrzt mam przyjąć i jakiej doznaję udręki, aż się to stanie. Czy myślicie, że przyszedłem dać ziemi pokój? Nie, powiadam wam, lecz rozłam. Odtąd bowiem pięcioro będzie rozdwojonych w jednym domu: troje stanie przeciw dwojgu, a dwoje przeciw trojgu; ojciec przeciw synowi, a syn przeciw ojcu; matka przeciw córce, a córka przeciw matce; teściowa przeciw synowej, a synowa przeciw teściowej (Łk 12, 49- 53).

Wybitny teolog Teilhard de Chardin tak pisał o tym ogniu: „Pewnego dnia, kiedy zapanujemy nad siłą wiatru, morskimi falami i przyptywami oraz siłą grawitacji, będziemy mogli tę energię wpręgnąć w służbę miłości. Wtedy po raz drugi w historii świata odkryjemy ogień, energię miłości. Ta energia jest jak ogień, który pozwala nam ogrzać się i kroczyć w ciemności. Ta energia jest jak światło, które umożliwia nam dostrzeżenie rzeczy najważniejszych. Ta energia jest jak woda, która nas odświeża i odnawia. Ta energia jest jak powietrze, bez którego nie możemy żyć. Ta energia sprawia, że ziemia staje się miejscem, gdzie Boże Królestwo głęboko zapuszcza korzenie”.

W roku 1985 św. Jan Paweł II mówił: „Z okazji XIX Światowego Dnia Pokoju, w ogłoszonym przez Organizację Narodów Zjednoczonych Międzynarodowym Roku Pokoju, przekazuję wszystkim – jako orędzie nadziei – moje głębokie przekonanie, że ‘Pokój jest wartością, która nie zna podziałów’. Jest wartością, która zaspokaja nadzieje i dążenia wszystkich ludów i wszystkich narodów, ludzi młodych i starych, mężczyzn i kobiet, wszystkich ludzi dobrej woli. Jest to orędzie, które kieruję do każdego, a w sposób szczególny do przywódców politycznych. Sprawa pokoju jako wartości powszechnej winna być traktowana z najwyższą uczciwością intelektualną, szczerością ducha i w głębokim poczuciu odpowiedzialności wobec siebie i wobec narodów świata. Pragnąłbym, aby ludzie odpowiedzialni za decyzje polityczne dotyczące stosunków Północ-Południe, Wschód-Zachód, doszli do przekonania, że możliwy jest tylko jeden pokój. Ci, którzy wytyczają drogi przyszłości świata, niezależnie od swojej filozofii politycznej, systemu ekonomicznego czy wyznania religijnego, są wezwani do udziału w budowaniu jednego pokoju, opartego na sprawiedliwości społecznej oraz godności i prawach każdej osoby ludzkiej”. Pokój, o którym mówi św., Jan Paweł II, jest pokojem, którym obdarza nas: „Pokój zostawiam wam, pokój mój daję wam. Nie tak jak daję świat, Ja wam daję”.

Dzień przed aresztowaniem Prymasa, po wieczornym nabożeństwie zaniepokojonym o jego los, powiedział: „Mówcie różaniec. Znacie obraz Michała Anioła – Sąd Ostateczny. Anioł Boży wyciąga człowieka z przepaści na różańcu. Mówcie za mnie różaniec”

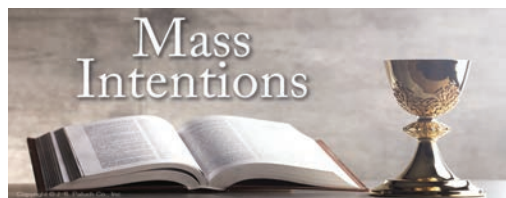

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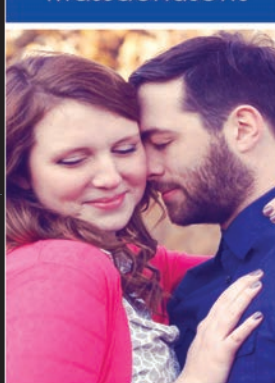
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
