

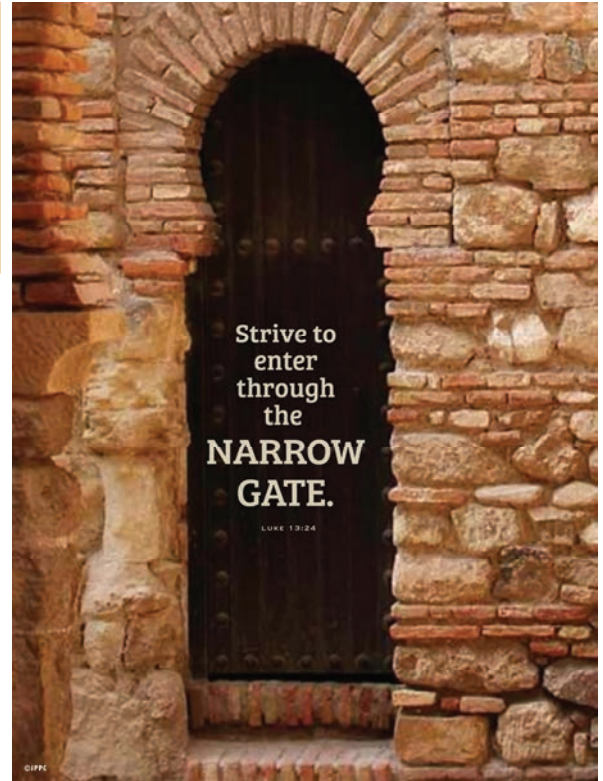

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good! I don't know about you, but Jesus' words this weekend are like a splash of cold water: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate...." To top it off, the Letter to the Hebrews speaks about being prepared to be disciplined by God during our lives to attain "the peaceful fruit of righteousness." The implication is that the road toward heaven may not be as easy as it sounds or as automatically achieved as pop religious culture might characterize it.

As autumn brings more activities and a quicker pace of life, it's important to ask ourselves how we're approaching this narrow gate to true life in Christ. Is prayer a daily part of my life—not just "saying prayers" but honest, heartfelt communication with God who is love? Are there people whom I need to forgive or from whom I need to seek forgiveness? Do I seek ways to not make myself the center of the universe and go out toward others in service, love, and charity? Am I going to confession regularly and being nourished at least every Sunday by the Eucharist? Do I have a healthy self-knowledge regarding my own sins and character defects, and am I willing to let Jesus free me from them and heal me? Do I take opportunities to learn more about my faith, especially in a culture where religious faith and practice of any kind is coming increasingly under attack?

Strive for the narrow gate.

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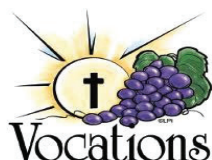

BIULETYN Parafialny



21 SIERPNIA 2022 - XXI NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Jezus nauczając, szedł przez miasta i wsie, i odbywał swą podróż do Jerozolimy. Raz ktoś Go zapytał: „Panie, czy tylko nieliczni będą zbawieni?”. On rzekł do nich: „Usiłujcie wejść przez ciasne drzwi; gdyż wielu, powiadam wam, będzie chciało wejść, a nie będą mogli. Skoro Pan domu wstanie i drzwi zamknie, wówczas stojąc na dworze, zaczniecie kołatać do drzwi i wołać: »Panie, otwórz nam«; lecz On wam odpowie: »Nie wiem, skąd jesteście«. Wtedy zaczniecie mówić: »Przecież jadaliśmy i piliśmy z Tobą, i na ulicach naszych nauczaleś«. Lecz On rzecze: »Powiadam wam, nie wiem, skąd jesteście. Odstąpcie ode Mnie wszyscy dopuszczający się niesprawiedliwości«. Tam będzie płacz i zgrzytanie zębów, gdy ujrzyście Abrahama, Izaaka i Jakuba, i wszystkich proroków w królestwie Bożym, a siebie samych precz

wyrzuconych. Przyjdą ze wschodu i zachodu, z północy i południa i siądą za stołem w królestwie Bożym. Tak oto są ostatni, którzy będą pierwszymi, i są pierwsi, którzy będą ostatnimi” (Łk 13,22–30).

Jeden z marszałków napoleońskiej armii, bezgranicznie ufający swemu wodzowi, w czasie walki został śmiertelnie ranny. Gdy jego stan stawał się coraz poważniejszy usilnie prosił o przybycie Napoleona. Miał nadzieję, że cesarz jest w stanie pomóc mu. W tej sytuacji, zamiast szukać pomocy u Boga zwrócił się do swego wodza. Po przybyciu cesarza, marszałek błagał go, aby ratował jego życie. Napoleon ze smutkiem pokiwał głową, powiedział kilka słów pociechy, odwrócił się i wyszedł. Umierający mężczyzna czując, jak bezlitosna śmierć swym chłodem ogarnia jego ciało nie przestał żałośliwie powtarzać: „Uratuj mnie, Napoleonie! Uratuj mnie!” Zapewne w ostatniej minucie życia, żołnierz ów zrozumiał, że wobec majestatu śmierci nawet potężny Napoleon jest bezradny, nie może mu uratować życia, i że pomocy trzeba szukać gdzie indziej (Our Daily Bread).

Na pytanie: „Czy tylko nieliczni będą zbawieni?”, Chrystus odpowiada: „Usiłujcie przejść przez ciasne drzwi.” Te słowa odbierane są nieraz jako wezwanie do wyboru życia konsekrowanego, gdzie reguły zakonne, dodatkowe prawa, jakby automatycznie czynią człowieka zdolnym do przekroczenia wąskich drzwi. Stan duchowny jawi się niejako pewniejsza droga zbawienia. Potwierdzeniem słuszności takiego myślenia może być fakt, że większość wyniesionych na ołtarze, to osoby duchowne. Nic bardziej mylącego. „Wąskie drzwi” każdy człowiek nosi w sobie. Zaś życie według bożej sprawiedliwości i miłości sposobi człowieka do ich przekroczenia. Jest to niezależne od tego, czy kształt zewnętrzny naszego życia określa surowe reguły zakonne, czy też reguły życia królewskiego. Święta Jadwiga, królowa, żona i matka na drodze życia świeckiego przekroczyła ewangeliczne „wąskie drzwi”. Czarny, gotycki krzyż w północnej nawie katedry wawelskiej od stuleci przyciąga wiernych. Jedna z legend głosi, że w noc przed podjęciem decyzji poślubienia Jagiełły, Jadwiga modląc się zauważyła, że ręka Chrystusa oderwała się od krzyża i pobłogosławiła ją. Było to błogosławieństwo dla planów chrystianizacji Litwy poprzez ślub z wielkim księciem Jagiełłą. Faktem jest, że Jadwiga spędzała wiele czasu przed tym krzyżem, szczególnie w momentach podejmowania ważnych decyzji. Taką ważną decyzją brzemienną w skutkach dla Polski i Litwy była decyzja zaślubin księcia litewskiego Jagiełły.



Jak wielu z was wie, nasza franciszkańska prowincja Matki Bożej Anielskiej obchodziła tego roku swoją czteroletnią kapitułę. Wśród wielu rzeczy, które mają miejsce podczas kapituły, są zmiany wśród braci pracujących w poszczególnych klasztorach. Klasztor św. Stanisława nie jest wyjątkiem. **Niedługo powitamy dwóch „nowych” wikariuszy parafialnych O. Lucjana Szymańskiego i O. Jana Koziola.** O. Lucjan pochodzi z Gryfowa Śląskiego w Polsce i należy do Prowincji Krakowskiej. Śluby zakonne złożył w 1985 roku, i został wyświęcony na kapłana w 1991 roku. Służył w Rockford, IL, Elmhurst, NY, a nawet w Uzbekistanie. Kilka lat temu O. Lucjan spędził krótki czas w naszej parafii gdy uczył się języka angielskiego. Przyjedzie do nas w tym tygodniu.

Gdzie idą O. Paweł i O. Mieczysław? O. Mieczysław wróci z wakacji i rekolekcji w Polsce 31 sierpnia. Pożegnamy go na Mszy św. o godz. 9:00 rano w niedzielę, 4 września. Bardzo prosimy o jak najliczniejsze przybycie by wyrazić mu naszą wdzięczność za jego oddanie, poświęcenie i pracę w naszej parafii. Jego znajomość języka hiszpańskiego jest bardzo potrzebna w Brooklynie NY. Będzie nam go bardzo brakowało. Na szczęście z O. Paul przechodzi tylko do klasztoru St. Hyacinth po drugiej stronie parkingu. Mimo to życzymy mu wszystkiego najlepszego, gdy podejmuje służbę wśród naszych starszych braci, którzy od czasu do czasu mają możliwość asystowania w naszej parafii.

Triduum zakończy się procesją ze świecami w strojach narodowych w piątek wieczorem. Triduum do Matki Bożej to szczególny czas odnowy dla naszej Rodziny Parafialnej. Prosimy o dołożenie wszelkich starań, aby dołączyć do nas we wszystkie trzy wieczory, abyśmy mogli stać się uczniami, do których zaprasza nas Jezus za przykładem i wstawiennictwem Maryi.

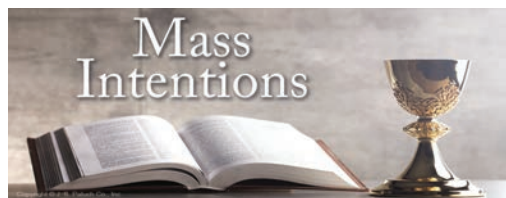

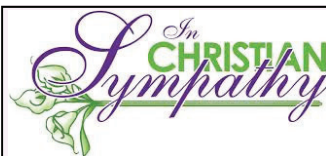

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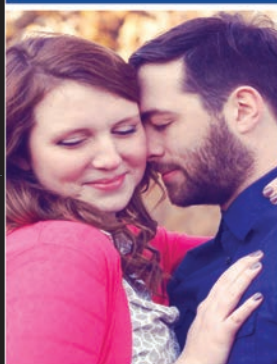
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
