Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Peace and all good things! From the first reading and gospel passage this Sunday, it's clear that the key word is "humility." Whenever I want to understand a word or concept better, I usually start with its etymology. The word *humility* comes from the Latin word *humus*, meaning "earth" or "ground" --not to be confused with the Arabic word *humus* that means "chickpea."

We can see how the origins of the word *humility* have led Christians in different directions in their efforts to understand this sometimes-elusive virtue. Some have wrongly interpreted humility as the deliberate effort to put oneself down or to think of oneself as of little worth or value, a meaning which comes closer to "dirt" than "earth." A second interpretation moves us toward the truth. The humble person always has his or her feet on the ground. We even use the word "well-grounded" to describe a person who has a realistic and integrated sense of self, aware of giftedness as well as sins, defects, or liabilities. This is the genuinely Christian approach to this virtue. We are finite creatures whom God loves, and yet our misuse of freedom often gets us into trouble. A humble person knows this and lives accordingly.

Pride, the opposite of humility, leads us to reach beyond our grasp or pretend we are someone we're not. (This was Adam and Eve's problem.) Jesus offers a perfect example in today's parable. Why not be content just to have been invited to the party rather than lunge for a seat at the head table?

We are so aware of our sinfulness and that of others, but we are so incredibly loved by the Lord who created us and redeemed us in Christ. That should keep our humble feet firmly and confidently planted on the ground as we live the gospel of Jesus and walk joyfully and confidently toward the glory that will one day be ours.

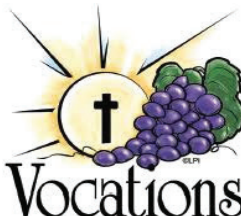

XXII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA



Gdy Jezus przyszedł do domu pewnego przywódcy faryzeuszów, aby w szabat spożyć posiłek, oni Go śledzili. I opowiedział zaproszonym przypowieść, gdy zauważył, jak sobie wybierali pierwsze miejsca. Tak mówił do nich: „Jeśli cię kto zaprosi na ucztę, nie zajmuj pierwszego miejsca, by czasem ktoś znakomitszy od ciebie nie był zaproszony przez niego. Wówczas przyjdzie ten, kto was obu zaprosił, i powie ci: »Ustąp temu miejsca«; i musiałbyś ze wstydem zająć ostatnie miejsce. Lecz gdy będziesz zaproszony, idź i usiądź na ostatnim miejscu. Wtedy przyjdzie gospodarz i powie ci: »Przyjacielu, przesiądź się wyżej«; i spotka cię zaszczyt wobec wszystkich współbiesiadników. Każdy bowiem, kto się wywyższa, będzie poniżony, a kto się poniża, będzie wywyższony”. Do tego zaś, który Go zaprosił, rzekł: „Gdy wydajesz obiad albo wieczerzę, nie zapraszaj swoich przyjaciół ani braci, ani krewnych, ani zamożnych sąsiadów, aby cię i oni nawzajem nie zaprosili, i miałbyś odpłatę. Lecz kiedy urządzasz przyjęcie, zaprosz ubogich, ułomnych, chorych i niewidomych. A będziesz szczęśliwy, ponieważ nie mają czym tobie się odwdziżyć; odpłatę bowiem otrzymasz przy zmartwychwstaniu sprawiedliwych” (Łk 14,1.7-14).

Przed laty opublikowano w gazecie „St. Petersburg Time” historię, jaka się przydarzyła Donowi Shula, znanemu trenerowi drużyny „Miami Dolphins”. W czasie wakacji odpoczywał on wraz z rodziną w niewielkiej miejscowości stanu Maine. Pewnego deszczowego popołudnia wybrali się wszyscy do miejscowego kina. Weszli do oświetlonej sali kinowej. Na widowni było tylko sześciu widzów, którzy na widok wchodzących powstali, zaczęli się do nich uśmiechać i machać rękami. Don odwrócił się do żony i powiedział: „Mimo, że jesteśmy tysiące mil od Miami, oni nas tutaj znają. Pozdrawiają nas na stojąco. Zapewne oglądają w telewizji grę naszego zespołu”. A gdy już usiedli, podszedł do Shula jeden z widzów, aby mu uściśnąć rękę. A wtedy Shul zadał mu pytanie: „Jak ty mnie rozpoznałeś”. „Ja nie wiem, kim pan jest. Wiem tylko, że gdybyście nie przyszli, nie obejrzelibyśmy dzisiaj tego filmu. Kierownik kina powiedział, że gdy nie przyjdzie jeszcze przynajmniej czterech widzów, to film będzie odwołany” – odpowiedział zapytany.

W roku 1937 w Lisieux na wzgórzu w pobliżu klasztoru karmelitanek bosych poświęcono bazylikę ku czci św. Teresy od Dzieciątka Jezus. Złożono w niej znaczą część relikwii Świętej. Nad wejściem do świątyni wyryto słowa z zacytowanego na wstępie fragmentu Ewangelii: „Każdy bowiem, kto się wywyższa, będzie poniżony, a kto się uniaża, będzie wywyższony”. Ta prawda wyznaczała drogę świętości Teresie od Dzieciątka Jezus. W swoim pamiętniku „Dzieje Duszy” napisała: „Uznać swoją małość, wszystkiego oczekiwać od dobrego Boga, nie smucić się za bardzo swoimi biedami. W końcu: nie chceć gromadzić żadnych szczególnych zasług... Zawsze pozostałam małą i nie znam żadnego innego zajęcia, jak to, by zrywać kwiaty miłości i ofiary, i ofiarowywać je dobremu Bogu dla Jego przyjemności. Pozostać małym znaczy dalej: nie przypisywać sobie cnót, które się praktykuje, jak gdyby się było zdolnym do czegokolwiek dobrego, lecz uznać, że są one skarbem, który dobry Bóg włożył w rękę swojego małego dziecka, aby się nim posłużyć gdy go potrzebuje!”.



Witamy w naszej parafii O. John Koziol. Nie jest on obcy tej okolicy. Urodził się w Holyoke, mieszkał w Chicopee Falls i uczęszczał do kościoła i szkoły Mater Dolorosa w Holyoke. Rodzina jego ojca była naszymi parafianami. Ojciec Jan złożył śluby zakonne jako Franciszkanin w 1981 r., służył jako diakon tutaj w St. Stan's latem 1987 r., został wyświęcony na kapłana w St. Stan's w 1988 r. i służył jako wikariusz parafialny do sierpnia 1989 r. Ojciec John spędził wiele lat w posłudze parafialnej oraz formacji naszych młodych braci. Ostatnio był proboszczem parafii św. Filipa Benizi w Jonesboro, GA. Przybędzie do nas 1 września i będzie służył jako gwardian („przełożony”) klasztoru oraz wikariusz parafialny.

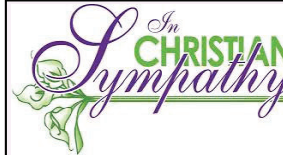

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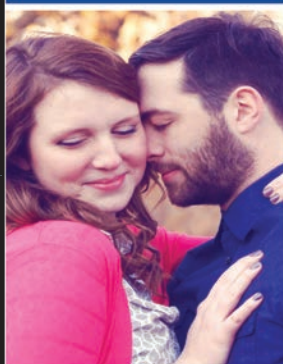
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
