

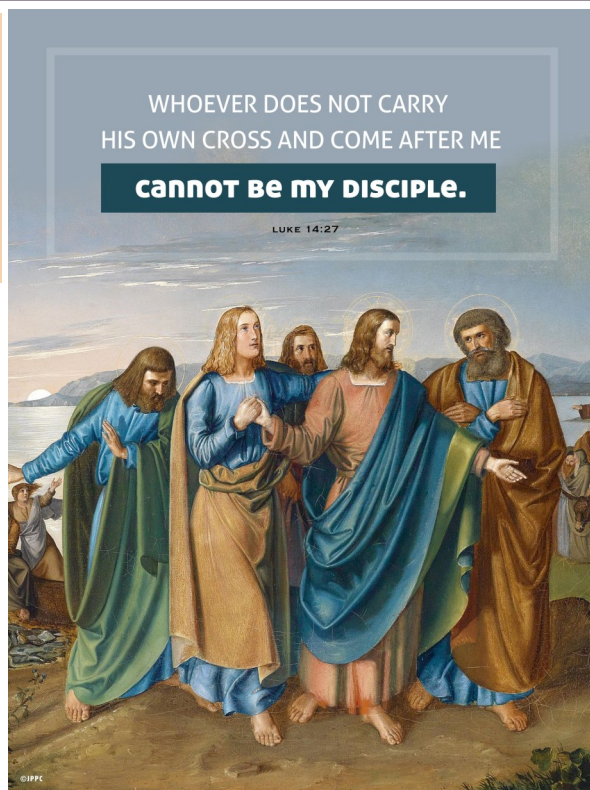

XXIII NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Wielkie tłumy szły z Jezusem. On zwrócił się i rzekł do nich: „Jeśli kto przychodzi do Mnie, a nie ma w nienawiści swego ojca i matki, żony i dzieci, braci i siostr, nadto i siebie samego, nie może być moim uczniem. Kto nie nosi swego krzyża, a idzie za Mną, ten nie może być moim uczniem. Bo któż z was, chcąc zbudować wieżę, nie usiądzie wpierw, a nie oblicza wydatków, czy ma na wykończenie? Inaczej gdyby założył fundament, a nie zdołałby wykończyć, wszyscy patrząc na to zaczęliby drwić z niego: »Ten człowiek zaczął budować, a nie zdołał wykończyć«. Albo który król, mając wyruszyć, aby stoczyć bitwę z drugim królem, nie usiądzie wpierw i nie rozważy, czy w dziesięć tysięcy ludzi może stawić czoło temu, który z dwudziestu tysiącami nadciąga przeciw niemu? Jeśli nie, wyprawia poselstwo, gdy tamten jest jeszcze daleko, i prosi o warunki pokoju. Tak więc nikt z was, kto nie wyrzeka się wszystkiego, co posiada, nie może być moim uczniem” (Łk 14,25-33).



Alina była uczennicą liceum medycznego. Wśród swoich koleżanek wyróżniała się nie tylko urodą, ale także aktywnością i doskonałymi ocenami w nauce. Była przy tym dziewczyną głębokiej wiary. Potrafiła duchem apostołskim zarazić swoje koleżanki z klasy. To było powodem nieporozumień z kierownictwem szkoły, które z urzędu miało obowiązek wychowywać młodzież w duchu ateistycznym. Alina, ryzykując wiele, pozostała wierna swym przekonaniom.

Gale Sayers jeden z najlepszych piłkarzy amerykańskich nosił na szyi medal z napisem; „Jestem trzeci”. Pod takim też tytułem ukazała się, niezwykle popularna, jego autobiografia. Gale wyjaśnia w niej między innymi, dlaczego te słowa stały się dla niego tak ważne. To zawołanie było mottem jego trenera, Eastona z Uniwersytetu w Kansas. Pewnego razu Gale widząc ten napis na biurku Eastona zapytał go o znaczenie tych słów. Easton odpowiedział: „Bóg jest pierwszy, przyjaciele zajmują drugie miejsce, a ja jestem na trzecim”. Od tego dnia Gale uczynił te słowa filozofią swego życia. W swojej autobiografii Gale napisał: „Staram się żyć według słów wypisanych na medalu. Nie zawsze udaje się to, ale noszenie tego napisu chroni mnie przed odejściem zbyt daleko od tej zasady”.

W jedenastym wieku, cesarz Henryk III Bawarski zmęczony życiem dworskim i sprawowaniem władzy udał się do miejscowego klasztoru i poprosił opata o przyjęcie do zakonu kontemplacyjnego, gdzie zamierzał spędzić resztę swojego życia. Opat powiedział: „Czy Wasza Wysokość zdaje sobie sprawę, że posłuszeństwo jest jednym, że ślubów zakonnych? Zachowanie tego ślubu nie będzie łatwe, dla kogoś kto sprawował władzę cesarską”. „Zdaję sobie z tego sprawę. Jednak jestem gotów dochować posłuszeństwa tobie, który w imieniu Chrystusa kierujesz tą wspólnotą”- odpowiedział cesarz. „W takim razie- powiedział opat – wróć na twój tron i służ wiernie w miejscu, gdzie Bóg cię postawił”. Cesarz Henryk usłuchał opata. Zasiadając na tronie cesarskim do końca swoich dni uczynił wiele dobrego dla swoich podanych, jak i też Kościoła, którego reformy skutecznie wspierał. Między innym zorganizował w 1046 r. synody w Sutri i Rzymie. Skutecznie zwalczał występujące wśród kleru nadużycia. Wzmocnił papieżstwo, pozbawiając rzymskie stronnictwa arystokratyczne wpływu na wybór papieża.

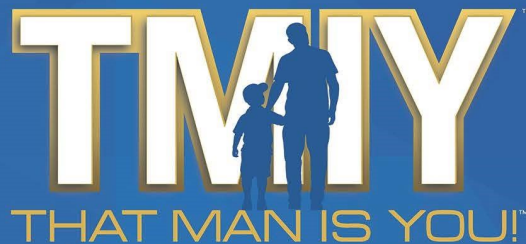

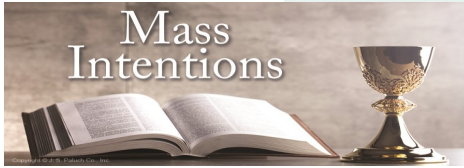
