Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Peace and all good things! This Sunday at 7:00 p.m. the Basilica of St. Stanislaus is honored to host the annual 9/11 Memorial Mass for the Deanery. It's hard to believe that twenty-one years have passed since that awful day when thousands lost their lives in senseless acts of terrorism. Like many of you, I remember exactly where I was that day. I was getting ready to begin a normal day of post-graduate classes in Scripture at the University of Notre Dame. Before I left the house, I heard on the radio a preliminary report that a commuter plane had just crashed into one of the towers of the World Trade Center. Probably to have some extra moments of peace and quiet, I didn't turn on the radio in the car. When I drove onto the university campus, I found it eerily quiet and heard the tragic and sad news as I entered the classroom.

Probably nothing in recent history has challenged our Christian consciences like that day. We had to face a whole gamut of emotions and relearn Jesus' command to forgive as we saw the effects of Islamic extremism fly in the face of the peace and unity that religion is supposed to promote. However, we also saw our country at its best as first responders ran right into the midst of disaster with no thought for their own safety. We saw true heroism in action and banded together to reaffirm what was truly important in our lives as families and as a nation. Have we continued to remember and put into action all that we learned? Let's hope so. Many days, I wonder if we remember our lessons from 9/11.

Please plan to come for this important celebration of the Eucharist. Only in reaffirming our faith in the death and resurrection of Jesus and receiving his very Body and Blood can we have the grace to act in self-sacrifice, forgiveness, peace, and genuine love. See you at the Basilica this Sunday at 7:00 p.m.

XXIV NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Gdy Mojżesz przebywał na górze Synaj, Bóg rzekł do niego: „Zstąp na dół, bo sprzeniewierzył się lud twój, który wyprowadziłeś z ziemi egipskiej. Bardzo szybko odwrócili się od drogi, którą im nakazałem, i utworzyli sobie posąg cielca ulany z metalu, i oddali mu pokłon, i złożyli mu ofiary, mówiąc: »Izraelu, oto twój bóg, który cię wyprowadził z ziemi egipskiej«”. I jeszcze powiedział Pan do Mojżesza: „Widzę, że lud ten jest ludem o twardym karku. Zostaw Mnie przeto w spokoju, aby rozpałił się gniew mój na nich. Chcę ich wyniszczyć, a ciebie uczynić wielkim ludem” (Wj 32,7-11).



W Dublinie, 7 czerwca 1925, w drodze do kościoła zasnął starszy mężczyzna. Wezwano kapłana, aby udzielił mu wiatyku. Było jednak za późno. Siedemdziesięcioletni mężczyzna już nie żył. Zmarłego przewieziono do kostnicy szpitalnej, gdzie podczas przygotowań ciała do pogrzebu, odkryto pokutniczy ciężki żelazny łańcuch, który zmarły nosił pod ubraniem. Okazało się, że tym nieznanym mężczyzną jest Matt Talbot, który nawrócił się i przez szczerą pokutę oraz umartwienie chciał zadośćuczynić Bogu za swoje grzeszne życie. W jego nawróceniu dopełniła się ewangeliczna scena, w której Chrystus mówi o radości w niebie, gdy grzesznik się nawraca.

Po piętnastu latach życia w nieformalnym konkubinacie Anielka została sama, bez dachu nad głową. Jej chłopak, czy raczej stary chłop odszedł z inną, młodszą. Było to dla niej traumatyczne przeżycie. Spoglądając w niebo szukała mocy do przetrwania tych trudnych dni. I tam ją odnalazła. Doświadczyła wewnętrznej przemiany, nawrócenia i postanowiła radykalnie zmienić swoje życie. Pogodziła się z zaistniałą sytuacją i zaczęła odkrywać piękno przyjaźni z Chrystusem. Pochłaniała książki i filmy religijne. Powtarzała, że tego pokoju i radości, jaką odnajdywała w bliskości Boga nie oddałaby za nic. Rodziła się nawet myśl wstąpienia do zakonu i służby najbardziej potrzebującym. Od tego zamiaru odwiodła ją najbliższa przyjaciółka, mówiąc, że na podjęcie tej decyzji ma jeszcze czas, a potrzebującym może pomagać na inne sposoby. Niech się rozejrzy dokoła, poczeka i zobaczy, co życie przyniesie. Posłuchała tej rady. Myśl o wstąpieniu do zakonu stawała się coraz bardziej odległa, ale to nie zmieniało jej relacji do Chrystusa. Nadal bliskość Boga była dla niej źródłem radości i pokoju. Była rozmodloną dziewczyną. Prawie codziennie uczęszczała na Mszę św., regularnie chodziła do spowiedzi. Pewnego dnia, jak sama mówiła, los uśmiechnął się do niej. Spotkała Franka, który należał wspólnoty charyzmatycznej. Co więcej, grał na gitarze. Zapewne Anielka uległa czarowi piosenki Karin Stanek „Człowiek z gitarą byłby dla mnie parą”. Jednak to nie gitara, ale pobożność i wiara Franka zdobywały jej serce. Z podziwem mówiła o jego wierze. Nie tyle z miłości, co z lęku przed samotnością zaczęła zabiegać o jego względy. I udało się.

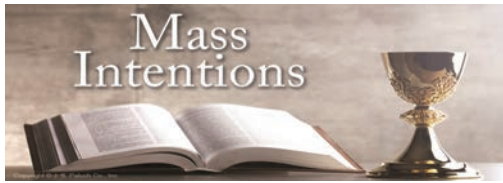

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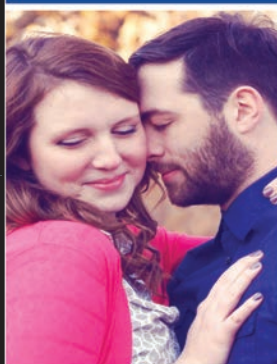
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
