

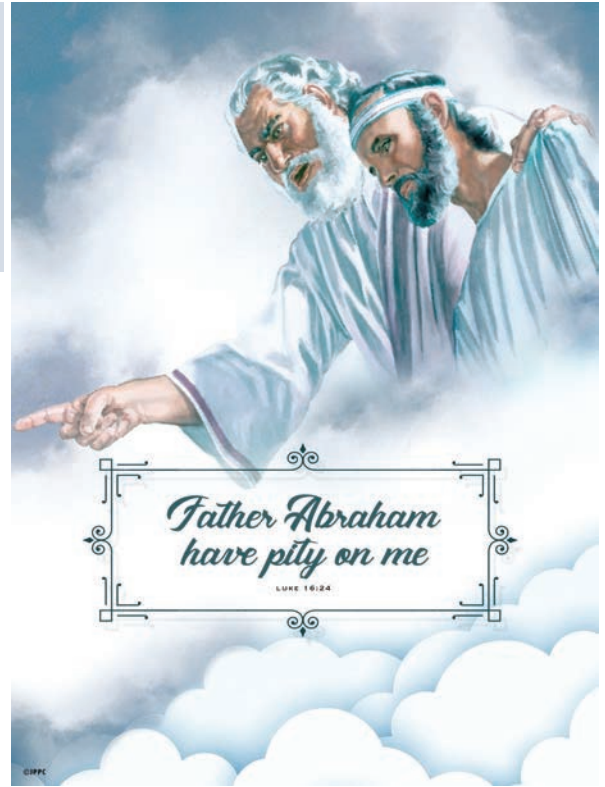

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! Among the days we celebrate on the liturgical calendar this week is the memorial of St. Vincent de Paul on September 27th. His tireless ministry on behalf of the poor gives us pause to examine our own consciences—especially in light of this Sunday's gospel—as well as the opportunity to recognize the work of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the Sunday Sandwich Ministry, the Take & Eat Meal Ministry, and the generous amounts of food donated by parishioners each month to Lorraine's Soup Kitchen & Food Pantry. These acts of mercy and service continue faithfully week after week, and we owe our thanks to those who volunteer their time so generously.

There was a time when we saw this kind of activity and advocacy on behalf of the poor as the domain of specialized "social justice people," while others prayed and just tried to be holy. This is a false dichotomy. Activity and advocacy on behalf of the poor must be nourished by a life of deep prayer and devotion for it to be called Catholic Christian; a life of prayer that doesn't reach out in charity is not genuine. So many of our recent popes have reminded us of this. May the example of St. Vincent de Paul inspire us this week to deeper prayer and conversion as we reach out to those most in need right around us.

Sacraments are outward signs instituted by Christ to give grace.

There are seven sacraments: Baptism, Rite of Reconciliation (Confession), Holy Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, and the Anointing of the Sick. Three of these sacraments are known as the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. While many individuals are baptized as children, the Sacrament of Baptism may be received at any age. In some instances, individuals may have been baptized as children, but they may not have received Holy Eucharist or Confirmation. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is received prior to first Holy Eucharist.

Recently some adults have indicated interest in preparing for the reception of one or more of the Sacraments. In response, we are planning to begin offering classes in the coming weeks. We invite anyone who is interested to complete the form below and submit it to the parish office at 40 Cyman Drive or to call the parish office at 594-6669 and provide the necessary information by October 5, 2022. Kindly share this information with anyone you think would be interested and please keep this intention in prayer. 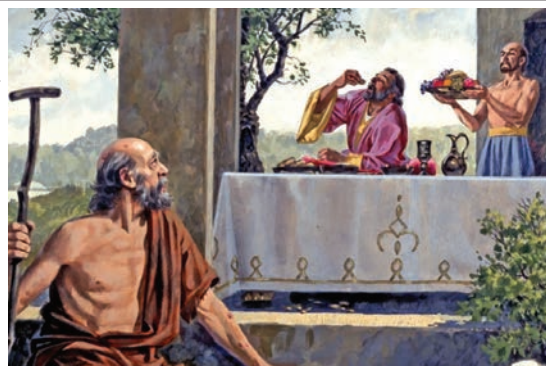

BIULETYN Parafialny

25 WRZESNIA - XXVI NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

Jezus powiedział do faryzeuszów: „Żył pewien człowiek bogaty, który ubierał się w purpurę i bisior i dzień w dzień świetnie się bawił. U bramy jego pałacu leżał żebrak okryty wrzodami, imieniem Łazarz. Pragnął on nasycić się odpadkami ze stołu bogacza; nadto i psy przychodziły i lizały jego wrzody. Umarł żebrak i aniołowie zanieśli go na łono Abrahama. Umarł także bogacz i został pogrzebany. Gdy w Otchłani, pogrążony w mękach, podniósł oczy, ujrzał z daleka Abrahama i Łazarza na jego łonie. I zawołał: »Ojcze Abrahamie, ulituj się nade mną i poślij Łazarza; niech koniec swego palca umoczy w wodzie i ochłodzi mój język, bo strasznie cierpię w tym płomieniu«. Lecz Abraham odrzekł: »Wspomnij, synu, że za życia otrzymałeś swoje dobra, a Łazarz przeciwnie, niedołą; teraz on tu doznaje pociechy, a ty męki cierpisz. A prócz tego między nami a wami zionie ogromna przepaść, tak że nikt, choćby chciał, stąd do was przejść nie może ani stamtąd do nas się przedostać«. Tamten rzekł: »Proszę cię więc, ojcze, poślij go do domu mojego ojca. Mam bowiem pięciu braci: niech ich przestrzeże, żeby i oni nie przyszli na to miejsce męki«. Lecz Abraham odparł: »Mają Mojżesza i Proroków, niechże ich słuchają«. Tamten odrzekł: »Nie, ojcze Abrahamie, lecz gdyby kto z umarłych poszedł do nich, to się nawrócą«. Odpowiedział mu: »Jeśli Mojżesza i Proroków nie słuchają, to choćby kto z umarłych powstał, nie uwierzą«” (Łk 16,19-31).



Wiele lat po wydarzeń zanotowanych w powyższym fragmencie Ewangelii żył inny, bardzo bogaty człowiek imieniem Carl. Rozpierała go nadmierna duma i pycha, gdy bryczką objeżdżał swoje ogromne posiadłości. Pewnego dnia przejeżdżał obok domu biednego rolnika, starego Hansa, który w cieniu zielonego dębu spożywał posiłek. Hans z pochyloną głową odmawiał modlitwę. Kiedy podniósł wzrok ujrzał niespodziewanego gościa: „Przepraszam, nie zauważyłem cię. Dziękowałem Bogu za posiłek”. Carl widząc czarny, chusty chleb i ser, które składały się na posiłek, pogardliwie skrzywił usta i powiedział: „Nie sądzę, aby było, za co dziękować. „Och”, odpowiedział Hans, „to całkiem mi wystarcza. Ale wymowne jest twoje przybycie właśnie dzisiaj, ponieważ miałem dziwny sen, który chcę ci opowiedzieć. Znalazłem się w przepięknym cichym miejscu. I usłyszałem tam głos: „Najbogatszy człowiek w tej dolinie, dzisiejszej nocy umrze”. „Och, sny!” krzyknął Carl. „To nonsens”. Odwrócił się i pośpiesznie odjechał. Jestem najbogatszy w tej dolinie; zapewne to o mnie chodzi. Ale to bzdura; mam umrzeć tej nocy. Nie mogę popaść w panikę. Najlepiej zapomnieć tego starca i jego sen. Im bardziej chciał o tym zapomnieć tym bardziej sen zapadał w jego świadomość. Był całkiem zdrowy, ale teraz nie był i tego pewien. Zawołał swego przyjaciela doktora. Pośpiesznie wytłumaczył mu, w czym rzecz. Doktor odpowiedział: „To głupstwo, ale dla twojego spokoju przebadam cię dokładnie”. Po skończonym badaniu lekarz postawił diagnozę: „Carl jesteś zdrowy jak twoje konie, na których jeździsz. Nie masz najmniejszego powodu, aby obawiać się śmierci tej nocy”.

W lipcu tego roku na łamach chrześcijańskiego magazynu The Christian Century opublikowano artykuł rabina Noah Farkasa. Wspomina on moment, w którym zrozumiał istotę powołania do służby we wspólnocie religijnej. Latem przed rozpoczęciem studiów rabinicznych zgłosił się na ochotnika do pracy misyjnej przy realizacji projektu budowlanego w Ganie. Przez dwa miesiące mieszkał w małej wiosce bez prądu i bieżącej wody. Całe dnie mieszał beton, nosił cegły na budowie szkoły, a wieczorami czytał gazety i rozmawiał z nowymi przyjaciółmi z Gany. W życiu tego młodego człowieka były to najbardziej twórcze i satysfakcjonujące wakacje. Tak wiele nauczył się, doświadczył radości jaką daje pomoc bliźniemu w potrzebie. Ale najważniejsze doświadczenie było jeszcze przed nim.

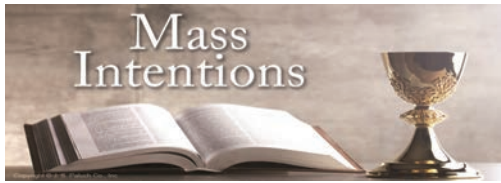

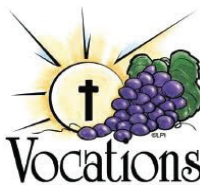

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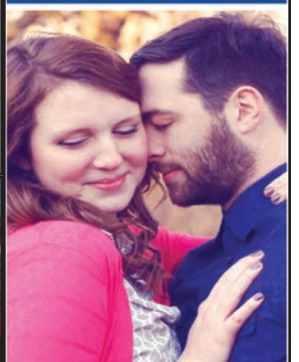
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
