

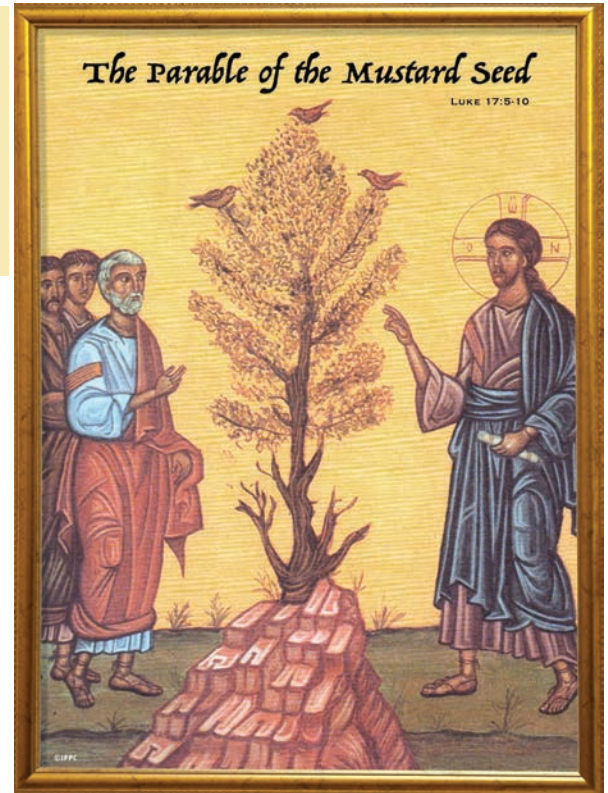

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This week is an especially meaningful one for the Franciscan family as we celebrate the feast of St. Francis on October 4th. Few saints are as well-known as the Little Poor Man from Assisi—in Italian, *il Poverello d'Assisi*. Even non-believers sense an attraction to him because his experience of God in Jesus Christ and His gospel was so real and so deep. Because of that intimate relationship with God—and *only* because of it—St. Francis rediscovered a oneness with the created world and could sincerely and joyfully call every-one brother or sister. This goes much deeper than just being an animal lover.

Ilekoć prosimy Boga o wysłuchanie naszych modlitw; o spełnienie naszych prośb; o wysłuchanie naszych skarg... Często wydaje się nam, że Bóg nie tylko nas nie wysłuchuje, ale jakby wcale nas nie słuchał. Modlimy się, a dzieje się akurat na odwrót!

Maria ma syna alkoholika. Ileż różańców odmówiła za niego. Ile zamówiła Mszy św. Ile wylała łez. A Michał dalej brnie w nałóg; stacza się jeszcze niżej. Wydawać by się mogło, że Pan wcale nie przejmując się ani Marią, ani jej synem, ani ich problemami! A tak nie jest! Bóg kocha nas bardziej, niż to potrafimy sobie wyobrazić! On w nas ma upodobanie. Dlaczego więc Bóg nas nie wysłuchuje, gdy modlimy się do Niego? Ponieważ niedoskonałe są nasze modlitwy. Nie umiemy się dobrze modlić.

To smutna prawda: ciągle nie umiemy się modlić. Dzieje się tak, ponieważ nie modlimy się w ten sposób, w jaki tego pragnie Bóg. Staramy się o to, by On spełniał nasze zachcianki. Chcemy urządzać świat, rodzinę, nas samych według naszych koncepcji czy planów. A Bóg ma inne plany związane z nami. Czasem nie spełnia naszych prośb po to, aby nas nauczyć wytrwałości. Dzisiejszy człowiek bowiem chce mieć wszystko już, natychmiast, w tej chwili. Bóg udzieli dóbr, ale później, gdy człowiek będzie na nie odpowiednio przygotowany.

Jest jeszcze jedna sprawa, o której trzeba wspomnieć. Na nią zwraca uwagę tekst dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Chodzi bowiem o to, o co się modlimy. Najczęściej są to sprawy ziemskie: zdrowie, szczęście, zdanie egzaminu, zgoda w rodzinie..., a kto z nas kiedykolwiek pomodlił się o własne zbawienie? Kto poprosił Boga o to, by On nim kierował? Kto wreszcie błagał Boga o Ducha Świętego? A o takiej modlitwie wyraźnie mówi ewangelista.

Bóg udzieli nam wszystkiego, co dobre i konieczne dla naszego zbawienia. Nie udzieli nam tego, co jest przeciwne naszemu prawdziwemu dobru i świętości. On pragnie, byśmy do Niego kołatali, byśmy Go prosili, byśmy w Nim szukali zbawienia, świętości, pokoju i szczęścia.



Pozostało tylko 2 tygodnie do naszego BAZARU PARAFIALNEGO. **Sacraments are outward signs instituted by Christ to give grace.**

There are seven sacraments: Baptism, Rite of Reconciliation (Confession), Holy Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, and the Anointing of the Sick. Three of these sacraments are known as the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. While many individuals are baptized as children, the Sacrament of Baptism may be received at any age. In some instances, individuals may have been baptized as children, but they may not have received Holy Eucharist or Confirmation. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is received prior to first Holy Eucharist.

Recently some adults have indicated interest in preparing for the reception of one or more of the Sacraments. In response, we are planning to begin offering classes in the coming weeks. We invite anyone who is interested to complete the form below and submit it to the parish office at 40 Cyman Drive or to call the parish office at 594-6669 and provide the necessary information by October 5, 2022.
