

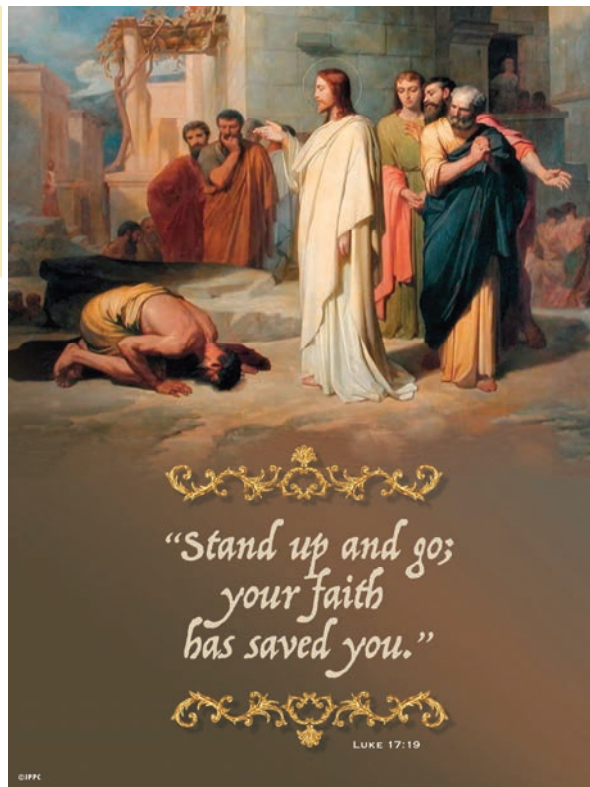

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This weekend's gospel is a familiar one and often chosen for Thanksgiving Day Mass. Ten lepers encounter Jesus and are healed, but only one of them returns to say thank you. To top it off, the one who expresses gratitude is a Samaritan, a member of an ethnic group with which we know ancient Jews did not get along. Even Jesus expressed amazement. Why did the nine others not return? There's no way to tell. Maybe they felt entitled or were simply ungrateful people.

Well before Thanksgiving approaches, let's try to cultivate the healthy spiritual habit of taking time to give thanks to God throughout the day for even the smallest things. Such a habit can be a powerful antidote against the media barrage of negativity, polarization, and secularization. "Thank you," especially to the Giver of all good gifts, is powerful.

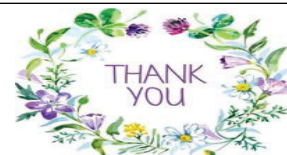

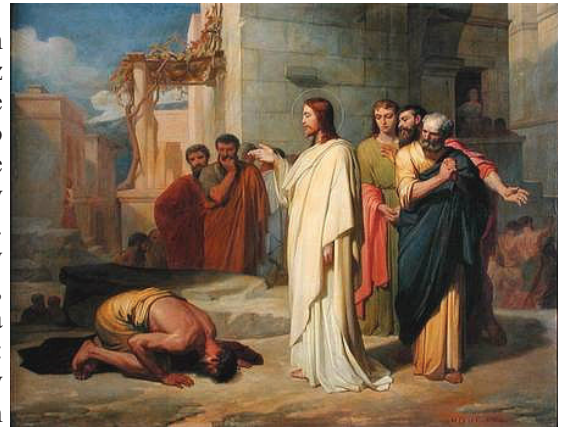

BIULETYN Parafialny

Wśród słów, które mają coraz mniej miejsca w naszym codziennym życiu, jest krótkie „dziękuję”, które jednoznacznie kojarzy się z wdzięcznością. Często słyszymy słowa, że wdzięczność mobilizuje, że jest potrzebą człowieka. Ale, sami wiemy z własnego życia, że często słowo „dziękuję” nie chce nam przejść przez gardło. Być może zatracamy w sobie naturalny odruch na otrzymane dobro? Wtedy stajemy się podobni do dziewięciu trędowatych z dzisiejszej Ewangelii. A w naszych uszach brzmiały wtedy Chrystusowe słowa, które zostały wypowiedziane o potrzebie wdzięczności: „Wtedy jeden z nich, widząc, że jest uzdrowiony, wrócił, chwając Boga donośnym głosem, padł na twarz u Jego nóg i dziękował Mu. A był to Samarytanin. Jezus zaś rzekł: «Czyż nie dziesięciu zostało oczyszczonych? Gdzie jest dziewięciu? Czy się nie znalazł nikt, kto by wrócił i oddał chwałę Bogu, tylko ten cudzoziemiec?»”.



Poczucie wdzięczność to nie tylko przejaw dobrych manier, ale postawa, która jest miernikiem wielkości człowieka, jego bezinteresowności i szlachetności. Człowiek wdzięczny to ten, który dostrzega, że nie wszystko zawdzięcza sobie samemu, że jest częścią społeczności, której niemal wszystko zawdzięcza, w jakiś sposób powinien zdawać sobie sprawę z tego, że jest dłużnikiem innych, że powinien za wszystko być wdzięczny. I z tego rodzi się poczucie szczęścia.

Kiedy patrzymy na uzdrowionych w dzisiejszej Ewangelii, to możemy w nich odkryć także motywy naszego postępowania. Samarytanin – cudzoziemiec jako jedyny docenił łaskawość Boga, Jego obdarowanie i miłość. Pozostałych dziewięciu – nie dostrzegło obdarowania i skupiło się tylko na fakcie odzyskania zdrowia, jak małe dziecko na otrzymanym prezencie. Uzdrowieni z trądu zachowali się jak wielu takich, którzy nie potrafią być wdzięczni innym, gdyż są chciwymi egoistami i sądzą, że wszystko im się należy za darmo.

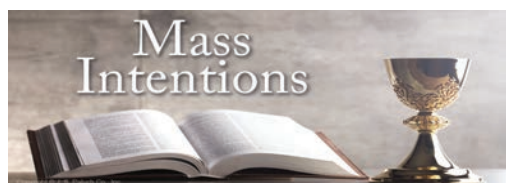

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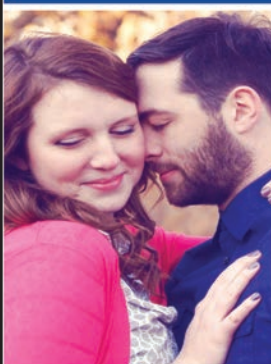
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
