

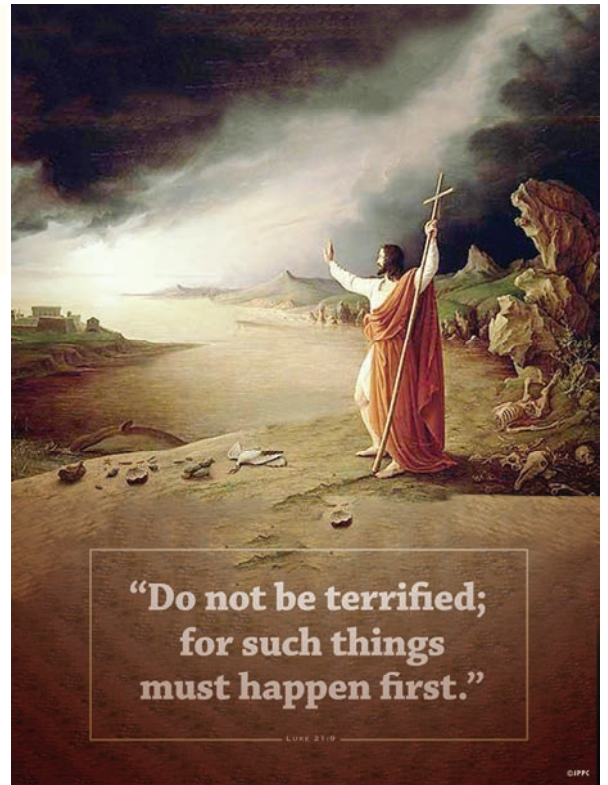

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This time of the year naturally has us thinking about the approaching holidays. Thanksgiving is around the corner, which means that Advent and Christmas aren't far behind. And here we are in church this weekend listening to foreboding words about the end of the world: "Lo, the day is coming, blazing like an oven...." Jesus speaks of the future destruction of the Jerusalem temple and persecution of his followers, not to mention "earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place." Yet the deacon or priest proclaims at the end of the passage, "The Gospel—the *Good News*—of the Lord." And we say, "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ." Are we crazy?

The truth is that Jesus' teaching about the end times is not supposed to cause fear or dread but hope and joy. Today's psalm puts it all in perspective: "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice." No matter how bad we human beings mess up the world, we hold fast to the hope that the Lord will set it right. For those who are working unrepentantly against God's purposes, Jesus' return will not be good news. For true disciples of Jesus, however, the end promises a lasting heavenly city where God's ways fully reign. No wonder even the rivers will clap their hands and the mountains shout with joy.

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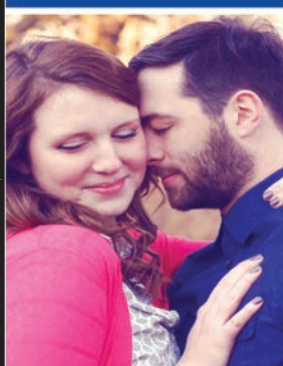


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
