Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

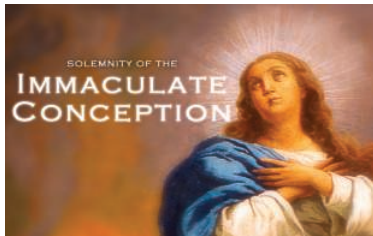

4 GRUDNIA

II NIEDZIELA ADWENTU

Św. Jan Chrzciciel, prorok znad Jordanu, woła do wszystkich, którzy oczekują Mesjasza: „Przygotujcie drogę Panu, prostujcie ścieżki dla Niego; wszyscy ludzie ujrzą zbawienie Boże”. Mamy więc robić to, co możliwe, aby porzucić marazm, bierność i samowystarczalność. Wszystko po to, aby spotkać się z przychodzącym Jezusem, nie przespać czasu Jego przyjścia. Wielu ludzi odczytuje wezwanie do nawrócenia dopiero w trudnych i bolesnych momentach swojego życia, jak choroba czy śmierć najbliższych. Jednak Bóg nawet z trudnej po ludzku sytuacji może wyprowadzić duchowe dobro. Trwa to tym dłużej, im dłużej człowiek próbuje tylko o własnych siłach pokonywać życiowe trudności.

Św. Jan Chrzciciel swoim życiem i słowem wskazuje nam, w jaki to sposób należy przygotować się na przyjście Pana: przez pokutę, zerwanie z grzechem, odrzucenie ciemności a wejście w pełnię blasku zbawczej łaski Chrystusa. Bóg, podobnie jak w Starym i Nowym Testamencie, także i dziś posyła swoich proroków.

Adwent jest czasem, który sprzyja naszym duchowym poszukiwaniom. Papież Franciszek zachęca, aby porzucić wygodną kanapę lenistwa, obojętności i bylejakości. A założyć buty aktywnego wędrowca, pielgrzyma. I wyruszyć w drogę, która wiedzie przez pustynię nawrócenia do nieba. Warto więc podejmować ciągły wysiłek w nawracaniu się. Nie wystarczy usłyszeć głos proroka, trzeba jeszcze na niego świadomie odpowiedzieć, wyznając za Psalmistą: „Będę słuchał tego, co mówi Pan Bóg”. I dostrzegać wokół siebie również innych, którzy czekają na nasze zainteresowanie, przyjaźń, czy konkretny dar serca.

Zwykle najtrudniej rozstać się z błędnymi wyobrażeniami religijnymi. Wyznawanie religii dzieciństwa jest dla nich czymś znacznie wygodniejszym niż odważenie się na głębszy wzrost w wierze i w ufności do Boga. Łatwiej odmówić „paciorek”, „litanijkę”, „pomodlić się do Bożi”, niż sięgnąć po Pismo św., by w świetle słowa Bożego solidnie przeanalizować swoje życie, przygotować się na spotkanie z Bogiem w niedzielnej Eucharystii.

Jeśli chcesz przygotować drogę Panu, musisz prawdziwie uwierzyć w Bożą moc! A prawdziwie uwierzyć, to powierzyć siebie Bogu wraz ze wszystkim, co stanowi moją codzienność, powołanie, świat, w którym żyję i pracuję. Jeśli chcemy autentycznie wierzyć, a nie tylko od czasu do czasu „oddychać powietrzem religijnym”, mamy scalać prawdziwą wiarę w Chrystusa z naszym życiem. Już dziś.

CHORZY - Pragniemy przypomnieć, że chorych w szpitalach lub domach opieki (nursing home), odwiedzamy wtedy, gdy wcześniej zostaniemy poinformowani przez rodzinę chorej osoby lub samego chorego. **Bardzo prosimy by też nie czekać na ostatni moment.** Sakrament chorych (namaszczenie chorych) to nie jest „ostatnie namaszczenie” przed śmiercią. Ten sakrament możemy przyjmować gdy przeżywamy choroby cielesne lub duchowe i ma na celu przywrócić nam pełne zdrowie ciała i duszy i pomóc przezwyciężyć cierpienie.

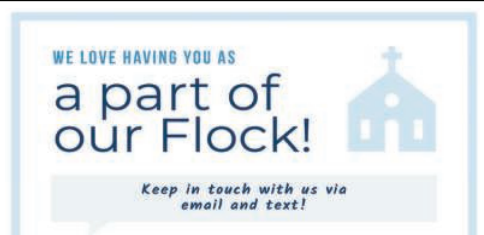

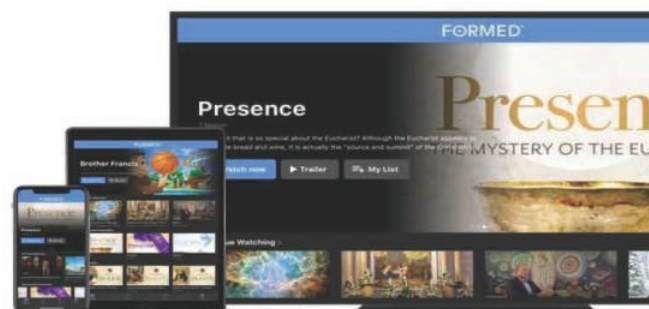

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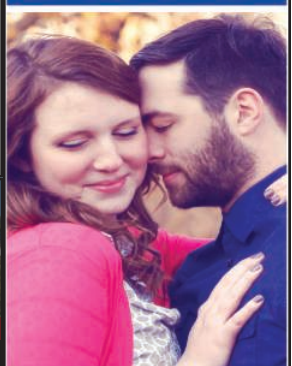
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
