Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is also called the “Sunday of the Word of God.” Announced by Pope Francis in the fall of 2019, this year marks the fourth celebration of this commemoration. The Pope’s aim is to deepen our familiarity with and immerse us more fully in the Sacred Scriptures. Although Catholics of older generations may have felt the Bible to be off limits, there is no excuse for this attitude today. Catholic Scripture scholars, among the best in the world, have opened the Sacred Scriptures to us with countless printed and online resources.

Nevertheless, the primary place of our encounter with the Bible is not in a classroom but in the liturgy, the public prayer of the Church. The *Catechism* tells us that our longstanding Tradition of the Church, from its earliest centuries, holds as much veneration for the Sacred Scriptures as we do for the Lord’s Body (no. 103). If we feed our personal prayer with the daily Mass readings, we can allow the Holy Spirit to deepen our faith and inspire our actions, so they more and more resemble those of *the* Word, our Savior Jesus Christ. What an awesome challenge and an awesome gift from our God!

This weekend, as we march onward to foster respect for the gift of life from conception to natural death, may we foster the life of grace in our own souls as we immerse ourselves more deeply in the Word of God. Let’s accept Pope Francis’ challenge and pick up our Bibles this week. Join in *lectio divina* with Fr. John on Tuesdays after the noon Mass or with Fr. Lucjan after the Sunday 9:00 Mass.

In his apostolic letter instituting this observance, Pope Francis wrote: “It is fitting, then, that the life of our people be constantly marked by this decisive relationship with the living word that the Lord never tires of speaking to his Bride, that she may grow in love and faithful witness.” May we make this prayer our own.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Piotr i Andrzej zarzucali swoje sieci dzień w dzień i w niejedną noc, ale niewiele z tego mieli korzyści. Kiedy Jezus pojawił się na brzegu jeziora, nadał ich życiu nowe perspektywy, nowy sens, i to ich porwało. Tylko Bóg potrafi nadać człowiekowi nowe znaczenie egzystencji. Tylko Bóg czyni życie porywającym i fascynującym, godnym porzucenia natychmiast tego wszystkiego, co dotychczas się czyniło.



To dzięki Jezusowi, Jego obecności przy naszych sieciach, życie może być spełnione nawet w najbardziej przyziemnej postaci, ale Jemu chodzi o coś więcej. Chce uczynić coś wspanialszego dla człowieka. Chodzi o wyłowienie wieczności spod powierzchni doczesności albo o wyłowienie ludzi zatopionych w morzu grzechów i ukazanie im Nowego Świata. W tym krótkim epizodzie rybackim, widzimy jak wspaniały jest Bóg w Jezusie Chrystusie! 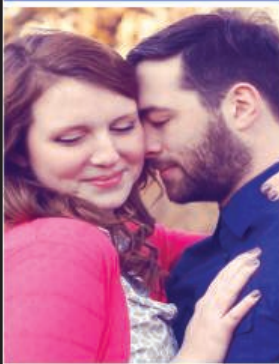
