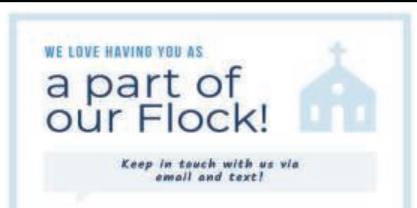

BIULETYN Parafialny



W 1917 roku Matka Boża objawiła się trojgu pastuszkom w portugalskim miasteczku Fatima. Objawienia te, które są jednym z najważniejszych wydarzeń religijnych XX wieku, odbiły się wielkim echem w całym świecie chrześcijańskim. Maryja powierzyła swe orędzie wiejskim dzieciom. W ten sposób Bóg spełnia swe obietnice: „Błogosławieni ubodzy w duchu, albowiem do nich należy królestwo niebieskie... Błogosławieni czystego serca, albowiem oni Boga oglądać będą”. I przypomina wieczne prawdy ewangeliczne, posługując się osobami najbardziej niewinnymi i – mogłoby się wydawać – najbardziej niekompetentnymi.

Ewangeliczne błogosławieństwa to droga, która prowadzi do królestwa niebieskiego. Tę prawdę potwierdza Jezus w dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Wiary nie da się też sprowadzić do kilku banalnych stwierdzeń, dewocyjnych zachowań – dalekich od prawdziwej pobożności – czy pseudoreligijnych wieców z symbolami religijnymi w tle. Nie o to w tym wszystkim chodzi. Chrześcijaństwo to nie historia, folklor czy jakaś przeszłość z czarnymi lub czerwonymi kartami, usiana szeregiem białych plam. Dobrą wskazówką w rozumieniu chrześcijaństwa stanowią słowa św. Jan Pawła II, wypowiedziane w czasie pielgrzymki do Ojczyzny w 1999 roku w przesłaniu do Konferencji Episkopatu Polski. Papież przypominał, że istotą apostołatu wszystkich członków Kościoła jest szerzenie prawdy o miłości Boga: „Kazanie na Górze jest programem dla całego Kościoła. Wspólnota Nowego Przymierza urzeczywistnia się, gdy opiera się na prawie miłości wpisanym w każde ludzkie serce. Ewangeliczne błogosławieństwa stanowią niejako konkretyzację tego prawa, a zarazem dają gwarancję prawdziwego i trwałego szczęścia”.

Chrześcijanin wspina się więc z Chrystusem na Górę Błogosławieństw. To program na całe życie. Nie wystarczą więc tylko intelektualne rozważania czy teoretyzowanie na temat wiary. Potrzebne jest tworzenie więzi z Tym, który jest Miłością, a więc z Trójosobowym Bogiem – Ojcem, Synem i Duchem Świętym. Tylko tyle, albo aż tyle. Jak się okazuje, ten program ośmiu błogosławieństw wcale nie jest taki łatwy i nie zapewnia szybkich sukcesów. Jest natomiast wymagający, ale za to zapewnia prawdziwe szczęście. Co więcej, jest zachętą dla każdego, kto przyjął chrzest, a więc nie tylko dla wybranych i wyselekcjonowanych ludzi z zamkniętego kręgu wtajemniczonych.

NOTATKA OD OJCA PROBOSZCZA - Pokój i wszelkie dobro! Rozpoczynając Tydzień Szkół Katolickich, jako wspólnota parafialna mamy wiele powodów do świętowania. W tym roku przypada 125-lecie Szkoły św. Stanisława. Wszyscy wiemy, że nie jest to święto budynku, ale oddanych wykładowców i pracowników, którzy wykształcili i uformowali dumnych absolwentów, którzy przeszli przez jego drzwi, a także obecnych studentów, którzy korzystają z naszej solidnej katolickiej i franciszkańskiej tradycji edukacyjnej. Nagrodą Reader Raves Award 2023 nasza szkoła została uznana za najlepszą prywatną szkołę w zachodnim Massachusetts. Proszę, przyłączcie się do mnie w tym tygodniu, dziękując obecnym wykładowcom i personelowi, zwłaszcza s. Ceil i Karen Shea, jak również Zarządowi Szkoły, za ich nieustrudzone wysiłki na rzecz naszych uczniów.



Jest to również odpowiedni czas, aby podziękować wszystkim WAM, parafianom, którzy nieustannie wspieracie Szkołę św. Stanisława poprzez wasze modlitwy, wolontariat i wsparcie finansowe. Jak już wcześniej wspomniałem, wielu uczniów pochodzi spoza granic naszych parafii, a nawet spoza naszej wiary katolickiej. Szkoła św. Stanisława stała się środkiem ewangelizacji i mamy nadzieję, że ta misja będzie nadal prowadzić ją daleko w przyszłość. Nasi uczniowie są kształceni i formowani na ludzi wiary i odpowiedzialnych obywateli. Módlmy się szczególnie za nich, którzy stoją przed wyzwaniem zupełnie innego świata niż 125 lat temu. Możemy być pewni, że nasze dzieci, „dziedzictwo Pana”, ukończą St. Stan's dobrze przygotowani na swoją przyszłość. A więc Szkole św. Stanisława życzymy nie „Sto lat” (100 lat), ale „Dwieście lat” – 200 lat!

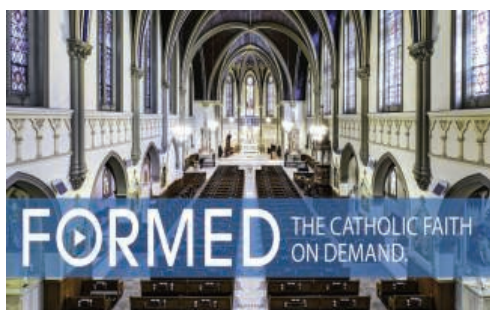

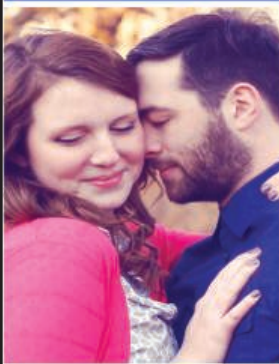
